

#### Materials (makes 4)

⅔ yard	13 In x 9 In Blocks - White Multi (A)	645-09
⅓ yard	Tossed Flowers - Black Multi (B)	637-98
5⁄8 yard	Folio - Red Hot (C)	7755-81*
⅓ yard	Small Flower Packed - Black Multi (D) 640-89	
1 yard	Small Bicycles in a Row - White Multi (Backing)	
		643-09

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the 13 In x 9 In Blocks - White Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (4) 13 ½" x 9 ¾" rectangles, each centered on a block.

#### From the Tossed Flowers - Black Multi (B), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 9 ¾" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 17 ½" strips.

#### From the Small Foulard - Red (C), cut:

• (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Small Flower Packed - Black Multi (D), cut:

- (1) 10" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 9 3/4" x 2 1/2" strips.
- From the remaining fabric cut (4) 2 ½" x 17 ½" WOF strip.

## From the Small Bicycles in a Row - White Multi (Backing), cut:

• (2) 17" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 17" x 21" rectangles for the backings.

#### **Place Mat Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 9 ¾" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 13 ½" x 9 ¾" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 17 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the botto m of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Place Mat #1 top (Fig. 1). The top should measure 17 ½" x 13 ¾". Repeat to make a second Place Mat #1 top.

## Place Mat Layout #1 make 2



2. Sew (1) 9 ¾" x 2 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 13 ½" x 9 ¾" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 17 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Place Mat #2 top (Fig. 2). The top should measure 17 ½" x 13 ¾". Repeat to make a second Place Mat #2 top.

#### Place Mat Layout #2 make 2



- 3. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 4. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.
- 5. Bind as desired.
