$11 / 2$ yards Novelty Animal Stripe - Multi (H) F1952-93
$31 / 4$ yards Tossed Animals - White/Multi (Backing) F1949-93
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tossed Bears - Tan (A), cut:

- (1) $51 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $51 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Fluffy Solid - Mocha (B), cut:

- (4) 3"x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3" squares.

From the Footprint Allover - White/Multi (C), cut:
-(4) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4"x $5 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ strips.
From the Skunk Allover - Gray (D), cut:
-(3) $4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4" squares.
From the Small Squares of Animals - Gray/Brown (E):

- Fussy cut (6) 10" squares each centered on a $3 \times 3$ matrix of small squares.


## From the Fluffy Solid - Black (F), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 2 " \times 10 "$ strips.
- (4) $21 / 1 / 2$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $21 / 2 " \times 14 "$ strips.


## From the Tossed Geometric - Tan (G), cut:

- (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $51 / 2 "$ squares.
- (3) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Novelty Animal Stripe - Multi (H), cut:
-(2) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 521 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ LOF strips.

From the Tossed Animals - White/Multi (Backing), cut:
-(2) 58 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $58 " \times 70 "$ back.

## Block Assembly <br> Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 10 "$ Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 10" Fabric E square. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 14 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square. Trim the block to measure $121 / 2 "$ square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

2. Place (1) 3 " Fabric B square on the lower left corner of (1) 4 " $\times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3).
3. Place another 3 " Fabric B square on the lower right side of the 4" $\times 51 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (24) Unit 1 strips total.

5. Sew (1) 4" Fabric D square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $5^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top. The arrows in the quilt layout represents the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric direction when assembling the quilt top.)
6. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
8. Sew the (4) rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ x $401 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) $5 \frac{1}{2} " \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 "$ Fabric G square to each end of (1) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 40 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
11. Layer and quilt as desired.
12. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
13. Bind as desired.
