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

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tossed Bears - Tan (A), cut:

• (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 5 ½" squares.

From the Fluffy Solid - Mocha (B), cut:

• (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3" squares.

From the Footprint Allover - White/Multi (C), cut:

• (4) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4" x 5 ½" strips.

From the Skunk Allover - Gray (D), cut:

• (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4" squares.

From the Small Squares of Animals - Gray/Brown (E):

• Fussy cut (6) 10" squares each centered on a 3 x 3 matrix of small squares.

From the Fluffy Solid - Black (F), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 10" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 14" strips.

From the Tossed Geometric - Tan (G), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" squares.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 40 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Novelty Animal Stripe - Multi (H), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x 52 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 5 ½" x 40 ½" LOF strips.

From the Tossed Animals - White/Multi (Backing), cut:

• (2) 58" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 70" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 10" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 10" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 14" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square. Trim the block to measure 12 ½" square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares



- 2. Place (1) 3" Fabric B square on the lower left corner of (1) 4" x 5 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 2). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3).
- 3. Place another 3" Fabric B square on the lower right side of the 4" x 5 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Flip open the triangle formed and press to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (24) Unit 1 strips total.

5. Sew (1) 4" Fabric D square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 5 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top. The arrows in the quilt layout represents the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric direction when assembling the quilt top.)

- 6. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
- 7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- 8. Sew the (4) rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.
- 9. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 10. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" Fabric G square to each end of (1) 5 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 11. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 12. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 13. Bind as desired.



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
