1/8 yard	Pretzels and Peanuts - Black (G)	702-99
5/8 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Black (H)	1063-99*
1 yard	Bullseye and Darts - Black (I)	706-99
2 3/4 yards	TV Remote Controls - Black (Backing)	700-99

### Table Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Beer Bottles - Amber (A), cut:

- (1) 9 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 9 1/2" squares.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Brown (B), cut:

- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 10 1/2" strips.

#### From the Chess Set - White (C), cut:

- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Camel (D), cut:

- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 1/2" squares.

#### From the Patchwork - Tan (E), cut:

- (1) 9 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 9 1/2" squares.

#### From the Darts Allover - Black (F), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.

#### From the Pretzels and Peanuts - Black (G), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" square.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (H), cut:

- (2) 1 1/2" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 28 1/2" WOF strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Bullseye and Darts - Black (I), cut:

- (2) 5 1/2" x 28 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5 1/2" x 38 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

#### From the TV Remote Controls - Black (Backing), cut:

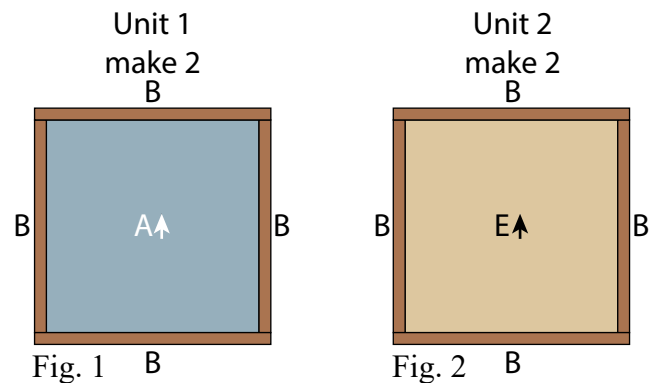
- (2) 46" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 46" x 46" back.

### Table Topper Block Assembly

**Note:** The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

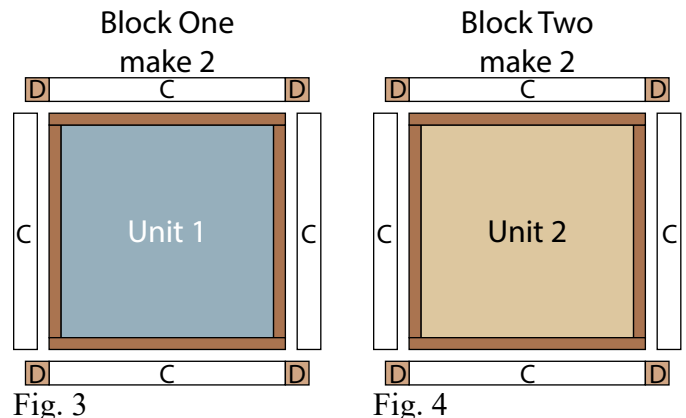
1. Sew (1) 1" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make a second Unit 1 square.

2. Sew (1) 1" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 1" x 10 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Unit 2 square.



3. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block One square.

4. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 2 square to make (1) 12 1/2" Block Two square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Block Two square.



5. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 5).

6. Sew (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to make the middle row (Fig. 5).

7. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 5).

8. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 5-7 lengthwise to make the  $26\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $26\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 5).

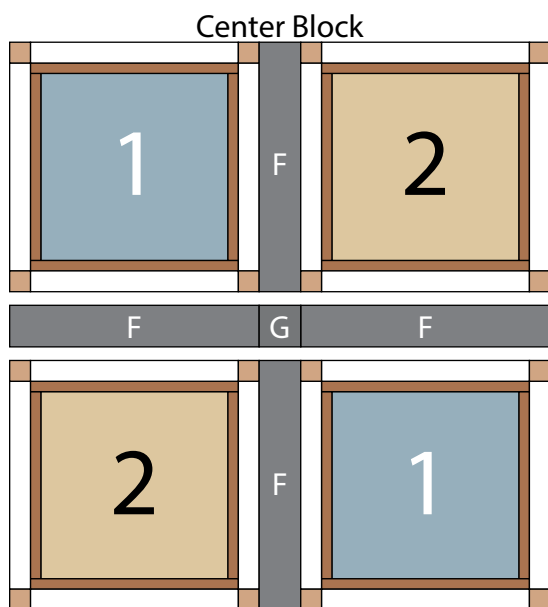

### Table Topper Assembly

*(Follow the Topper Layout in Figure 6 while assembling the topper.)*

9. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $26\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $28\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $28\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1)  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $38\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Topper top.

11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (4)  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.

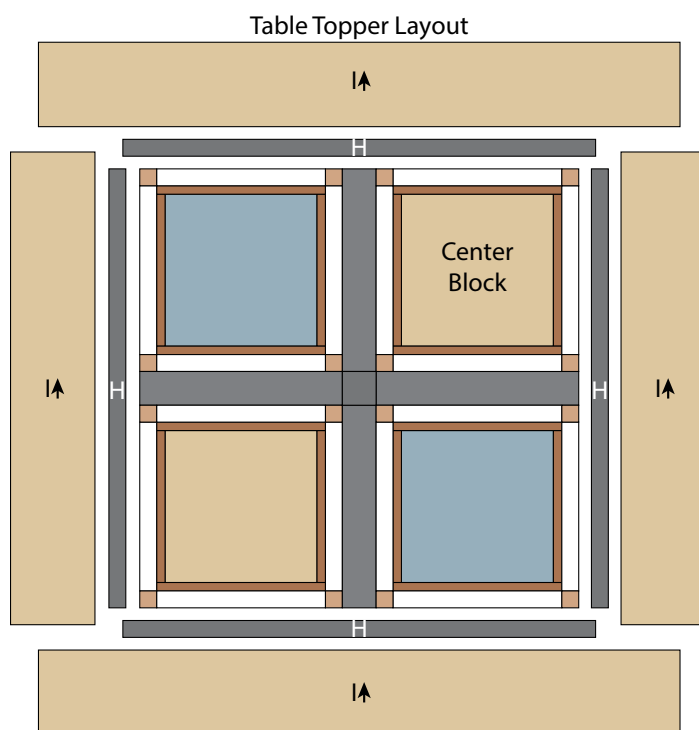

### Place Mat Materials (makes 6)

1 panel	24 Inch Panel - Tan (A)	710P-44
½ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Brown (B)	1063-33
⅜ yard	Throw Darts Allover - Black (C)	705-99
½ yard	Tossed Beer and Snacks - White (D)	704-01
⅞ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Black (E)	1063-99*
2 yards	Pretzel and Peanut - Black (Backings)	702-99

### Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the 24 Inch Panel - Tan (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 9 ½" squares, each centered on a block.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Brown (B), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 11 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Throw Darts Allover - Black (C), cut:

- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.

#### From the Tossed Beer and Snacks - White (D), cut:

- (1) 12 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 12 ½" x 3 ½" strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (E), cut:

- (11) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Pretzel and Peanut - Black (Backings), cut:

- (3) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 16" x 22" rectangles for the backs.

### Place Mat Block Assembly

**Note:** The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

14. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) unit 3 square (Fig. 7). **Trim the unit to measure 10 ½" x 10 ½"**. Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 squares total.

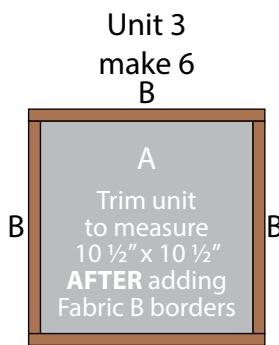

15. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" Fabric B square to each end of (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) 12 ½" Block Three square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Block Three squares total.

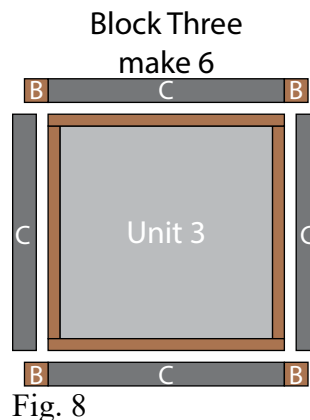

### Place Mat Assembly

(Follow the Place Mat Layout in Figure 9 while assembling the place mats.)

16. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Block Three square to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (6) Place Mat tops total.

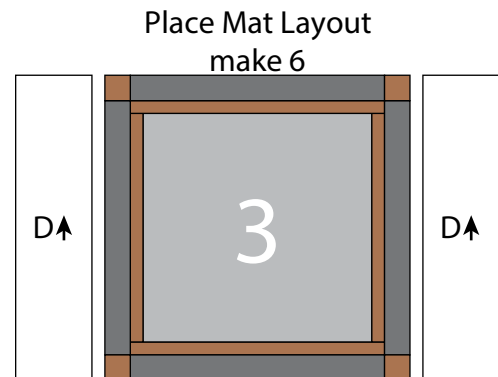

17. Layer and quilt as desired.

18. Sew the (11) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (6) equal length pieces.

19. Bind as desired.

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
