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



Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Block Panel - Black (A):

• Fussy cut (6) 8 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" rectangles, each centered on a block.

From the Weave Texture - Black (B), cut:

- (8) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 11 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 1 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" strips.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Allover Accessories - White (C), cut:

• (1) 8 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 8 ¹/₂" x 5 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (D), cut:

(3) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" x 9 ¹/₂" strips.
(2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" x 6 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Stripe - Black (E), cut:

• (2) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Wine (F), cut:

(8) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 1 ¹/₂" x 50 ¹/₂" strips.
(6) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Small Blocks - Red (G), cut:

• (3) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 50 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Red (H), cut:

• (3) 6 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 ¹/₂" x 50 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Tossed Shoes - White (I), cut:

• (1) 8 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" WOF rectangle.

From the Tossed Handbags - Red (J), cut:

• (1) 8 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 8 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" rectangles.


From the Stars - Black (Backing), cut:

• (2) 58" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 73" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 11 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 11 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 10 ¹/₂" x 13 ¹/₂".** Repeat to make (6) Block One rectangles total.



2. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" Fabric I rectangle. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric I rectangle to make (1) 10 ¹/₂" x 13 ¹/₂" Block Two rectangle (Fig. 2).





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
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3. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ¹/₂" x 11 ¹/₂" Fabric J rectangle. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 10 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric J rectangle to make (1) 10 ¹/₂" x 13 ¹/₂" Block Three rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Three rectangle.

4. Sew (1) 1" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip. Sew (1) 1" x 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C strip to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 rectangles.

5. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E square to each end of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the newly sewn strips to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make (1) $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $13\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Four rectangle (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (6) Block Four rectangles total.

6. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip lengthwise to make (1) 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Five strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make a second Block Five strip.









7. Sew together (1) Block One rectangle (white), (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block One rectangle (red), (1) Block Four rectangle and (1) Block One rectangle (white), lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 7).

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figure 7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Two and Row Three.

9. Sew together the (3) pieced rows from Steps 7-8 in numerical order and the (2) Block Five strips, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the $50 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 55 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 7).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


11. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.
