From the Packed Ditsy - Red (K), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 721 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 581 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Gnomes - Cream (L), cut:

- (2) $51 / 2 " \times 761 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Floral on Wonky Grid - Red/ Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) $94 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 76 " $\times 94$ " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric B square on the left side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 2).

2. Place another $31 / 2 "$ Fabric B square on the right side of the $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (24) Unit 1 strips total.
4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (24) Unit 2 strips.

5. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $4^{1 / 2 "} \times 6^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric G strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (6) Unit 3 squares total.

6. Sew (1) $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $61 / 2$ " Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2$ " Unit 4 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (6) Unit 4 squares total.

7. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $12^{1 / 2 "}$ Unit 5 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Unit 5 squares total.

8. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric C square on the right side of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 61 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (24) Unit 6 strips total.

9. Repeat Step 8 and refer to Figures 11-13 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (24) of each unit strip for Unit 7 through Unit 9.

10. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 7 strip to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (24) Unit 10 strips total.
11. Sew (1) Unit 8 strip to the left end of (1) Unit 9 strip to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (24) Unit 11 strips total.

12. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 10 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 10 strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $181 / 2 "$ Block One square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to Figure 17 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.

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14. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 18). Repeat to make Row Three.
15. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 18). Repeat to make Row Four.
16. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 14-15, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $541 / 2 " \times 721 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 18).

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
17. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 721 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2$ " $\times 581 / 2$ " Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 761 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
19. Layer and quilt as desired.
20. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
21. Bind as desired.


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
