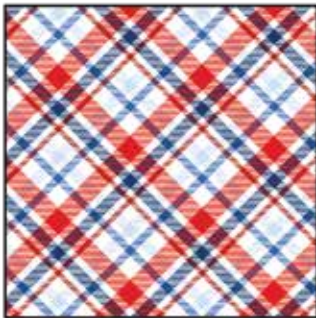

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Gnomes on Rockets - White (A), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 3 ½" squares.

From the Bias Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 2" squares.

From the Folio Basics - Medium Blue (C), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) 2" squares.

From the Eagle Flag Toss - Red (D), cut:

- (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (40) 3 ½" squares.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (E), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 3 ⅞" squares.
- (4) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.

From the Stars - Navy (F), cut:

- (1) 3 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 3 ⅞" squares.

From the Novelty Gnome Stripe - Multi (G):

- Fussy cut (5) 12 ½" x 7 ¼" strips, each centered on white and red stripes.

From the Flag Hearts - Navy (H), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 19 ¼" strips.
- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 64 ½" strips.

From the Diagonal Stripe - Multi (I), cut:

- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Patriotic Gnome Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (1) 31" x 72" strip for the backing.

Runner Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) 2" Fabric B square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 2).

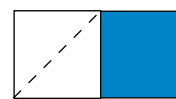

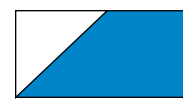

2. Place another 2" Fabric B square on the right side of the 2" x 3 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).

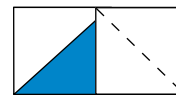

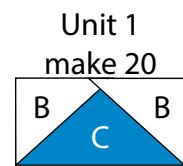

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (20) Unit 1 strips total.

4. Sew (1) 2" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (5) Unit 2 squares total.

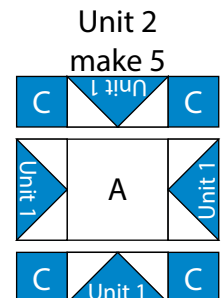

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5. Place (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 6). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 6). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance (Fig. 7).

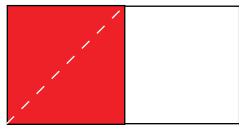

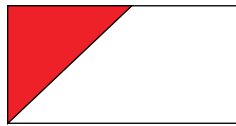

6. Place another $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D square on the right side of the $3\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 9).

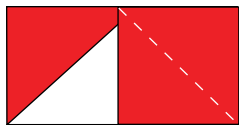

8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 10-12 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (5) Unit 4 strips, (5) Unit 5 strips and (5) Unit 6 strips.

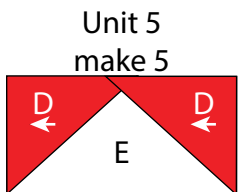

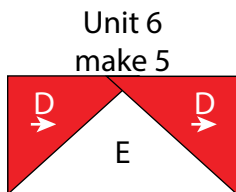

9. Place $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E square on top of (1) $3\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 13). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 13). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 14) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $3\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 7 squares (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (20) Unit 7 squares total.

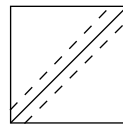

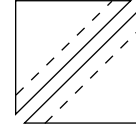

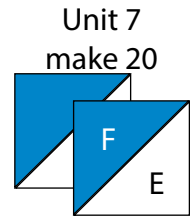

10. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row (Fig. 16).

11. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip, (1) Unit 2 square and (1) Unit 6 strip together in that order from left to right to make the middle row (Fig. 16).

12. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the bottom row (Fig. 16).

13. Sew the (3) rows from Steps 10-12 together lengthwise to make (1) $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 8 square (Fig. 16).

14. Repeat Steps 10-13 to make (5) Unit 8 squares total.

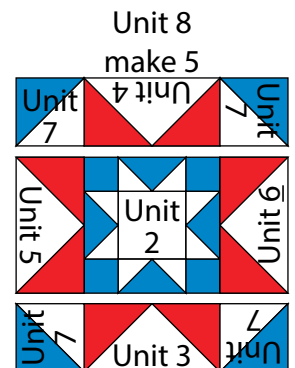

15. Sew (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top of (1) Unit 8 square to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (3) Block One rectangles total.

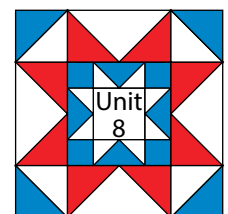
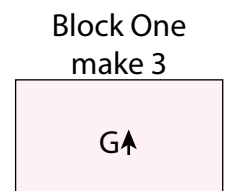

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16. Sew (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 8 square to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 18). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.

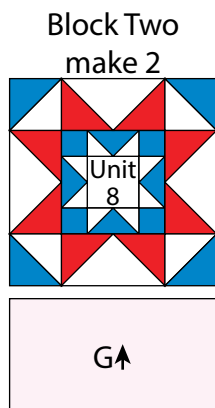

Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 19 while assembling the runner.)

17. Sew the (3) Block One rectangles and (2) Block Two rectangles together lengthwise and alternating them from left to right to make the Runner Center Block (Fig. 19).

18. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $19\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block to make the Runner Top (Fig. 19).

19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (5) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.

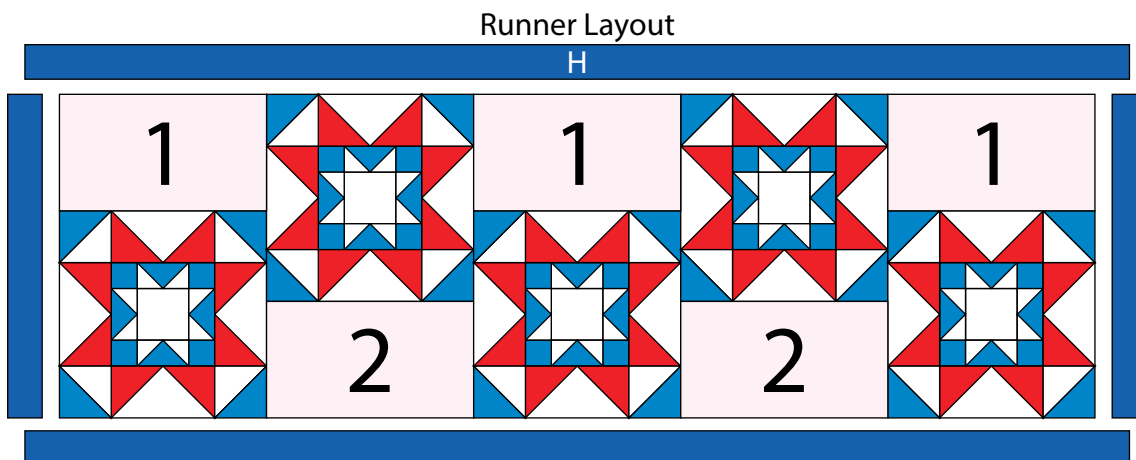

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Gnomes on Rockets - White (A), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 ½" squares.

From the Bias Plaid - Multi (B), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2" squares.

From the Folio Basics - Medium Blue (C), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2" squares.

From the Eagle Flag Toss - Red (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Diagonal Stripe - Multi (E), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (F), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 14 ½" strips.

From the Flag Hearts - Navy (G), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 16 ½" strips.

From the Folio Basics - True Red (H), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 18 ½" strips.

From the Patriotic Gnome Patchwork - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 22" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 18" x 22" rectangles for the backs.

Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

22. Place (1) 2" Fabric B square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 20). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 20). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 21).

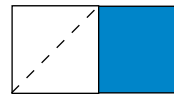

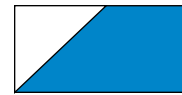

23. Place another 2" Fabric B square on the right side of the 2" x 3 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 22). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 22). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 23).

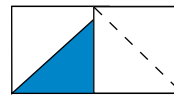

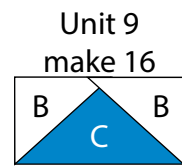

24. Repeat Steps 22-23 to make (16) Unit 9 strips total.

25. Sew (1) 2" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 9 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 9 strip to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Unit 10 square (Fig. 24). Repeat to make (4) Unit 10 squares total.

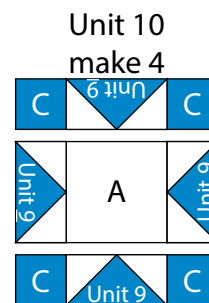

26. Sew together (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip and (1) 2 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric B strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Unit 11 rectangle (Fig. 25). Repeat to make (4) Unit 11 rectangles total.

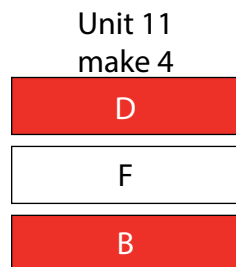

27. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric F strip to the top of (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 12 strip (Fig. 26). Repeat to make (4) Unit 12 strips total.

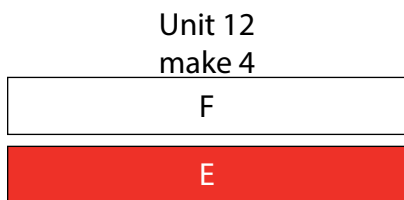

28. Sew (1) Unit 10 square to the left end of (1) Unit 11 rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 12 strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 13 rectangle (Fig. 27). Repeat to make (4) Unit 13 rectangles.

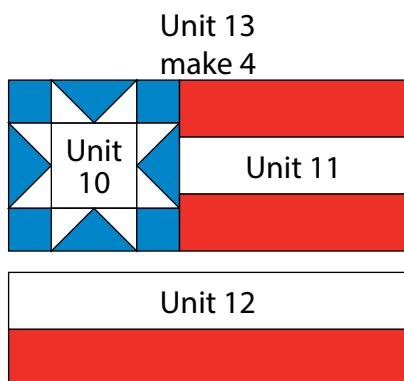

29. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of (1) Unit 13 rectangle. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 13 rectangle to make (1) Unit 14 rectangle (Fig. 28). Repeat to make (4) Unit 14 rectangles total.

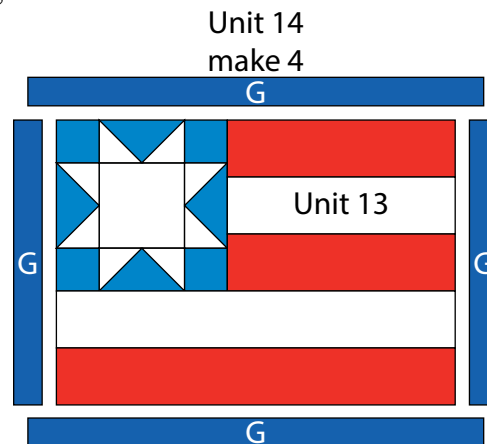

30. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of (1) Unit 14 rectangle. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 18 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 14 rectangle to make (1) Place Mat Top (Fig. 29). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat Tops total.

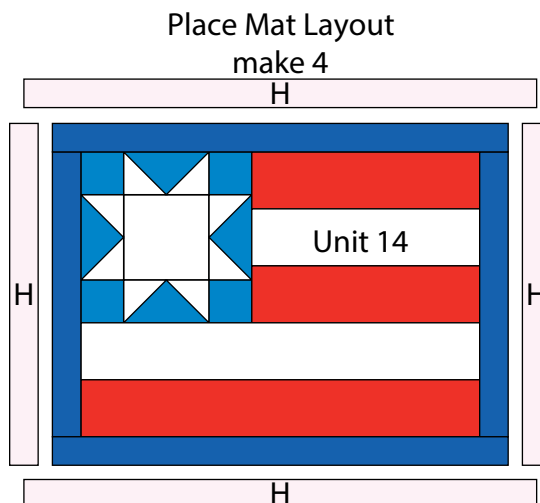

31. Layer and quilt as desired.

32. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.

33. Bind as desired.

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
