## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

### From the Banner Panel 24-in - Red (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 23" x 33 1/2" rectangle, centered on the gnomes. (A-1)
- (1) 23" x 4 1/2" strip, centered on a row of stripes. (A-2)
- (1) 23" x 4 1/2" strip, centered on a row of stripes. (A-3)

### From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (B), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 3 1/2" strips, (4) 2 3/4" x 3 1/2" strips, and (4) 2 3/4" x 3 1/4" strips for paper piecing.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 23" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 37 1/2" WOF strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 3" strips and (4) 2" x 3" strips for paper piecing.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 4 1/2" strips.

### From the Folio Basics - White on White (C), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3" x 3 1/2" strips, (4) 2 3/4" x 3" strips and (4) 2 1/2" x 3" strips for paper piecing.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 3" strips and (4) 2" x 3" strips for paper piecing.

### From the Speech Bubble - Red (D), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 5" strips, (8) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips, and (4) 2" x 4 1/4" strips for paper piecing.

### From the Houndstooth Basics - Red (E), cut:

- (1) 5" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 5" strips, (8) 1 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips, and (4) 2" x 4 1/2" strips for paper piecing.
- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip, sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

### From the Swirl - Teal (F), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 26" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 36 1/2" WOF strips.

### From the Words - White (G), cut:

- (5) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2" squares.

### From the Bias Plaid Basics - Rose (H), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

### From the Houndstooth Basics - Tangerine (I), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

### From the Bias Plaid Basics - Navy (J), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

### From the Houndstooth Basics - Muted Purple (K), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

### From the Bias Plaid Basics - Green (L), cut:

- (1) 3 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 1/2" squares.

### From the Houndstooth Basics - Lime Green (M), cut:

- (2) 2" x 36 1/2" WOF strips.

### From the Character Tossed Allover - White (N), cut:

- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (3) 4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4" x 45" strips.

### From the Bias Plaid Basics - Purple (O), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

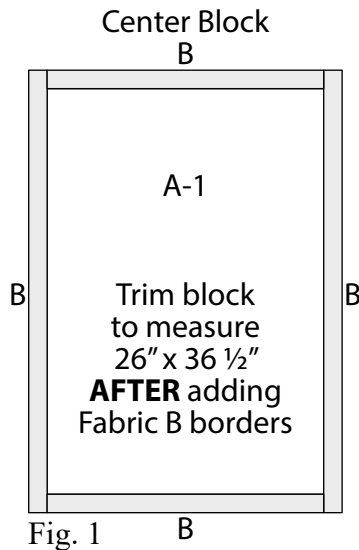
### From the Words - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 53" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 53" x 63" back.

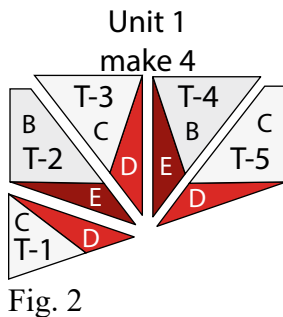
### Block Assembly

*Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.*

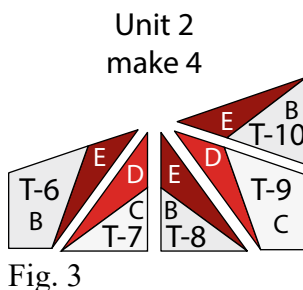
1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 23" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the 23" x 33 1/2" Fabric A-1 rectangle. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 37 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 26" x 36 1/2".**



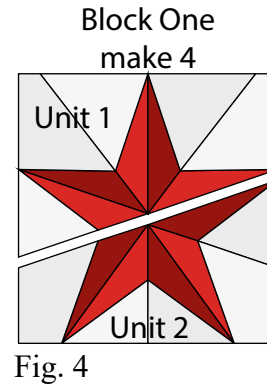
2. Refer to Figure 2 and using your favorite paper piecing method and the provided templates, make (4) Unit 1 segments.



3. Refer to Figure 3 and using your favorite paper piecing method and the provided templates, make (4) Unit 2 segments.



4. Sew (1) Unit 1 segment to the top of (1) Unit 2 segment to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 4). The block should measure 6 1/2" square. Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.



5. Place (1) 2" Fabric G square on the top left corner of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric E square, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 6).

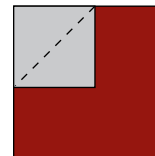

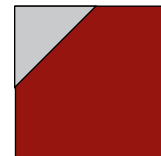

6. Follow Figure 7 for the seam direction to add a 2" Fabric G square to each of the remaining corners of the 3 1/2" Fabric E square to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 8).

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.

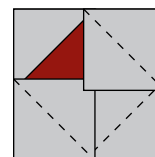

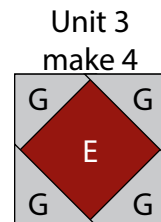

8. Repeat Steps 5-6 and refer to Figures 9-13 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (4) of each unit square for Unit 4 through Unit 8.

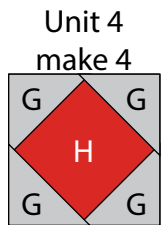

9. Sew together (12) assorted Unit squares together. Sew (1) 2" x 36 1/2" Fabric M strip to the left side of the newly sewn strip lengthwise and (1) 2" x 36 1/2" Fabric F strip to the right side to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 14).

10. Sew together (12) assorted Unit squares together. Sew (1) 2" x 36 1/2" Fabric F strip to the left side of the newly sewn strip lengthwise and (1) 2" x 36 1/2" Fabric M strip to the right side to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 15).

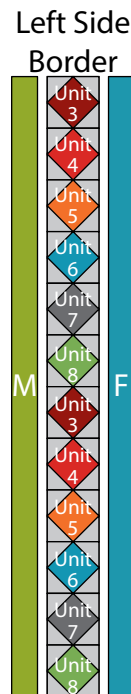

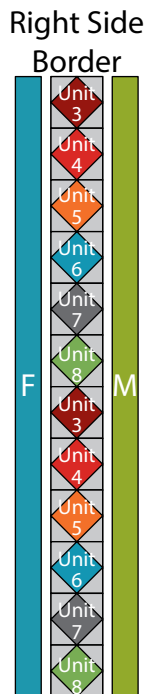

11. Sew (1) 2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B strip to each end of the 23" x 4 1/2" Fabric A-2 strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 26" Fabric F strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 16).

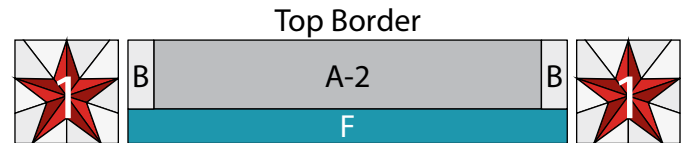

12. Sew (1) 2" x 4 1/2" Fabric B strip to each end of the 23" x 4 1/2" Fabric A-3 strip. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 26" Fabric F strip to the top of the newly sewn strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 17).

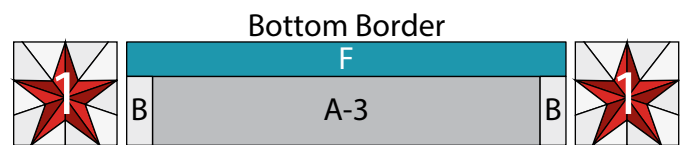

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

13. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.

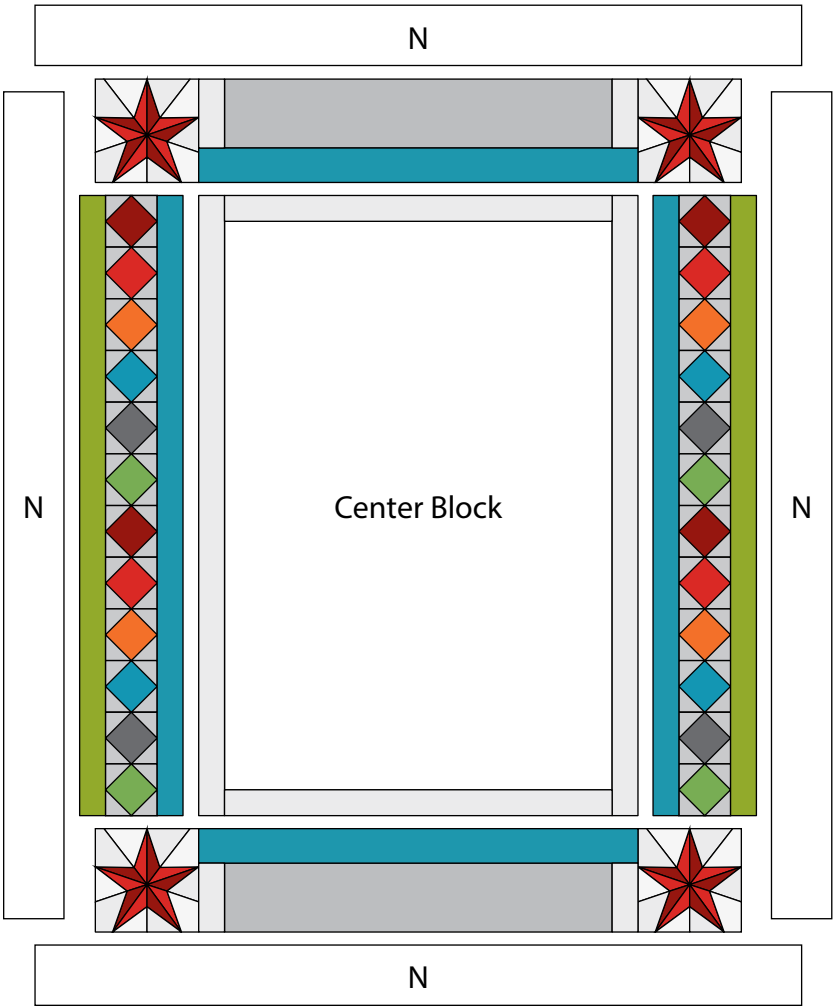
14. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 4" x 48 1/2" Fabric N strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4" x 45" Fabric N strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric O strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.



Quilt Layout

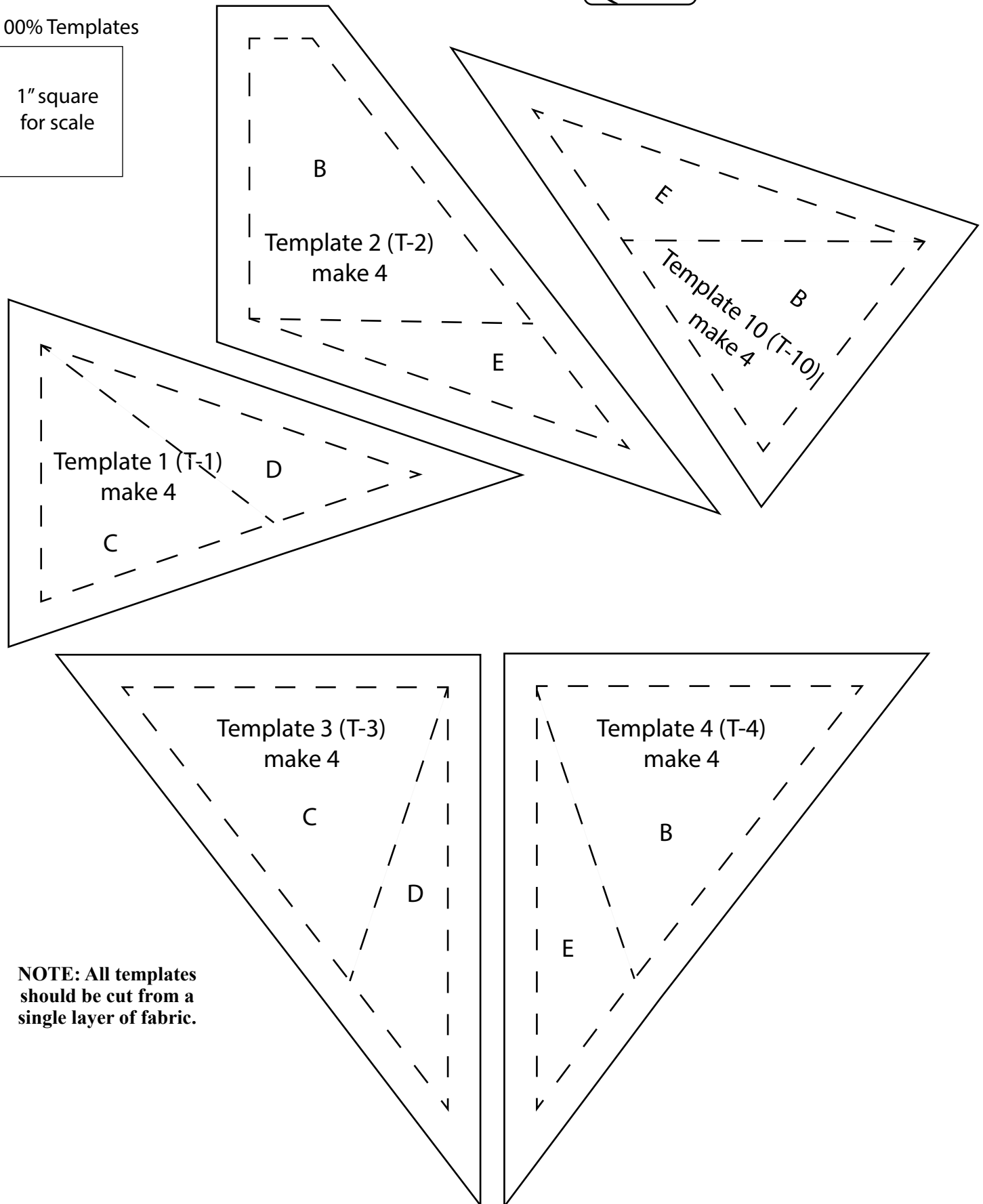

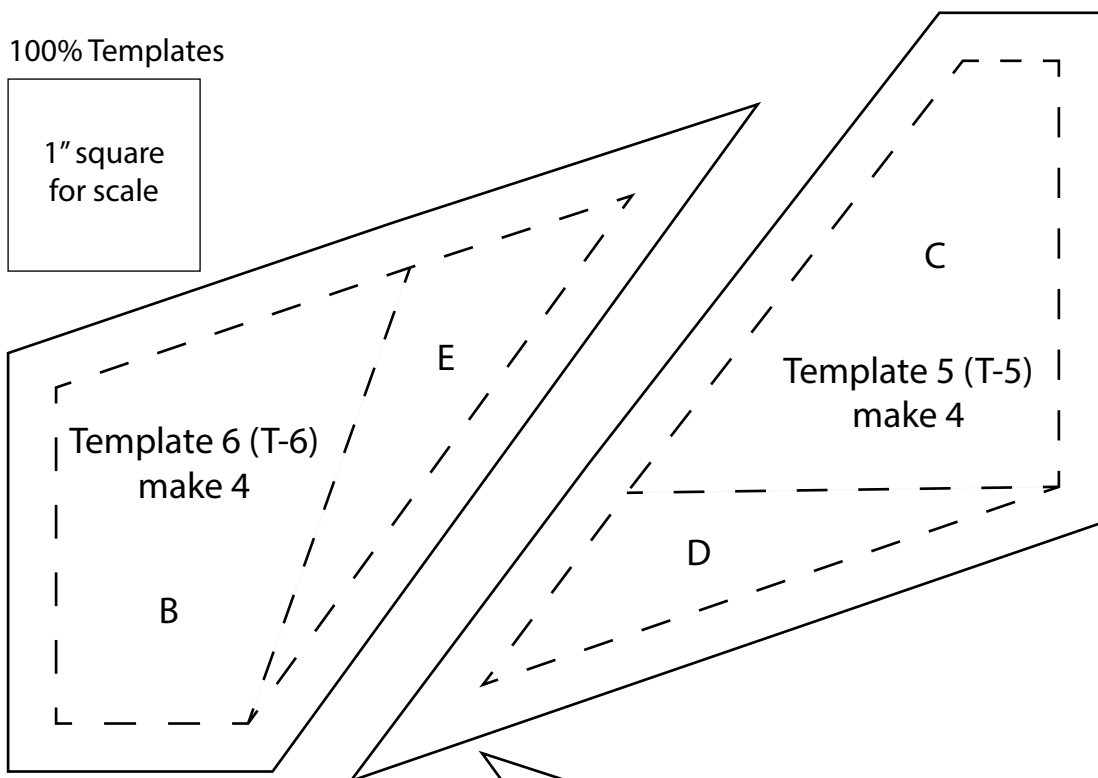

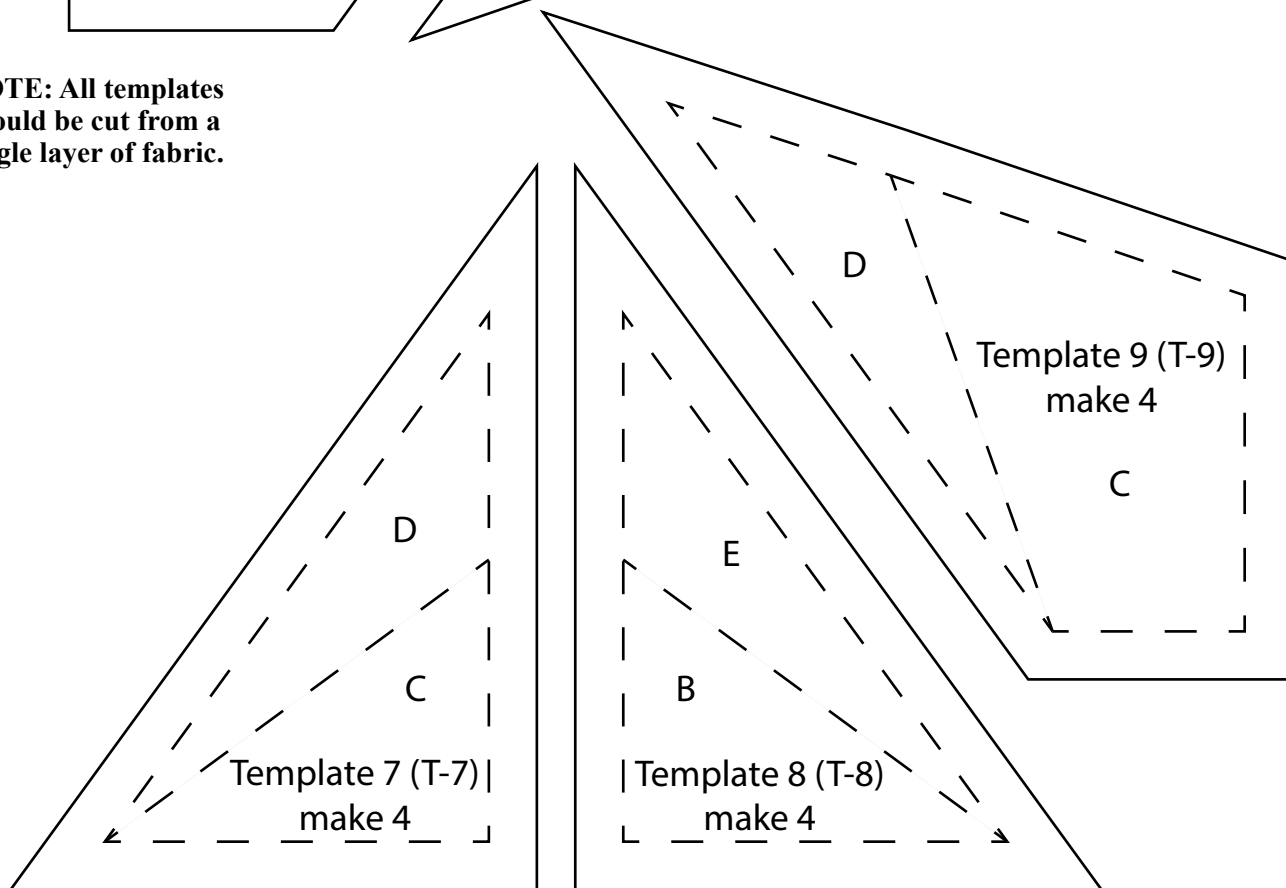
