## Materials

$2 / 3$ yard 24 inch Block Print - Red/Blue (A) 9848-78
1 yard Fireworks - Royal (B) 9857-77*
$1 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Stripes and Stars in Small Squares - Multi (C) 9851-78
$1 / 3$ yard Folio Basics - Red Hot (D) 7755-81
$1 / 2$ yard Red and Blue Stars on White Ground - Multi (E)
9850-8
$1 / 2$ yard Ice Pop Allover - Royal (F) 9859-77
$2 / 3$ yard Folio Basics - White on White (G) 7755-01
$3 / 8$ yard Large Patterned Stars on Red Ground - Red (H)
9855-88
$11 / 8$ yards Tossed Flag Allover - Royal (I) 9853-77
$31 / 4$ yards Patriotic Words and Motifs - Multi (Backing)
9856-8

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 inch Block Print - Red/Blue (A):

- Fussy cut (6) $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " squares, each centered on a block.

From the Fireworks - Royal (B), cut:

- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 " x $10 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 " x $131 / 2 "$ strips.
-(6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Stripes and Stars in Small Squares - Multi (C), cut: - (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio Basics - Red Hot (D), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Red and Blue Stars on White Ground - Multi (E), cut:

- (3) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Ice Pop Allover - Royal (F), cut:

- (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (G), cut:

- (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Large Patterned Stars on Red Ground - Red

 (H), cut:- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 481 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 39^{1 / 2}$ " WOF strips.

From the Tossed Flag Allover - Royal (I), cut:

- (3) $5 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 511 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $51 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $51 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Patriotic Words and Motifs - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 57 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 57 " x 69 " back.

Block Assembly
Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 101 / 2 "$

Fabric B strip to each side of
(1) $101 / 2 "$ Fabric A square. Sew (1) $2^{\prime \prime} \times 13^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure
$121 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$. Repeat to make
(6) Block One squares total.

2. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the left side of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 3).

3. Place another $21 / 2$ " Fabric D square on the right side of the $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (24) Unit 1 strips total.

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5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (48) Unit 2 strips.

6. Sew together (2) Unit 2 strips end to end to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (24) Unit 3 strips total.

7. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2$ " Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Unit 4 squares total.

8. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric G square to each end of (1) Unit 3 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 strip to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2 "$ Block Two square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

9. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
10. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
11. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps $9-10$, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the $361 / 2 " x 481 / 2 "$ Center Block.

Quilt Top Assembly
(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
12. Sew (1) 2" $\times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $391 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 511 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $51 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.

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
