Table Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Firework Bursts on White - Multi (A), cut:

• (1) 5" square.

From the Red and Blue Stars on White Ground - Multi

• (1) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ³/₄" squares.

From the Fireworks - Royal (C), cut:

- (1) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ³/₄" x 5" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 14" strips.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 15 1/2" strips.

From the White Stars on Red Ground - Red (D), cut:

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2" x 5" strips and (4) 2" x 3 ½" strips.

From the Folio Basics - White on White (E), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 3 ½" squares and (4) 3"
- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 3" x 5 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ³/₄" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ³/₄" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2" squares.

From the Large Patterned Stars on Red Ground - Red (F), cut:

• (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 3" squares.

From the Ice Pop Allover - Royal (G), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 3 ½" x 20 ½" strips.
- (2) 3 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.

From the Folio Basics - Red Hot (H), cut:

• (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


From the Small USA Squares - Red/Blue (Backing), cut:

• (1) 34" square for the backing.

Table Topper Block Assembly


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- 1. Place (1) 2 3/4" Fabric B square on the bottom half of (1) 2 3/4" x 5" Fabric C strip, right sides together and aligning the bottoms of the fabrics (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 2).
- 2. Place (1) 2 3/4" Fabric E square on the top half of the 2 ¾" x 5" Fabric C strip, right sides together aligning the tops of the fabrics (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 4).
- 3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (4) Unit 1 strips total.
- 4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 5 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) Unit 2 strips.





5. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to the left side of (1) Unit 2 strip lengthwise to make (1) 5" Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.

6. Place 2" Fabric E square on the left side of (1) 2" x 5" Fabric D strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner



(Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 strips total.



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




7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 9 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation while using (4) 2" Fabric E squares and (4) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric D strips to make (4) Unit 5 strips.



8. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to the right side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip to make (1) 5" Unit 6 square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Unit 6 squares total.



9. Sew (1) Unit 6 square to each side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each side of (1) 5" Fabric A square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make the 14" x 14" Center Block (Fig. 11).



10. Place (1) 3" Fabric F square on the left side of (1) 3" x 5 ½" Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 12). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 13).

11. Place another 3" Fabric F square on the right side of the 3" x 5 ½" Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 14). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind

the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 15).

12. Repeat Steps 10-11 to make (12) Unit 7 strips total.

13. Sew together (3) Unit 7 strips end to end to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 16). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

14. Sew together (3) Unit 7 strips end to end. Sew (1) 3" Fabric E square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 17). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.




Table Topper Assembly

(Follow the Table Topper Layout in Figure 18 while assembling the table topper top.)

15. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 14" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 15½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

17. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 20 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Table Topper.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (3) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

20. Bind as desired.



Place Mat Materials (makes 6)

½ yard24 inch Block Print - Red/Blue (A)9848-781 ¼ yardsFolio Basics - Red Hot (B)7755-81*½ yardFirework Bursts on White - Multi (C)9854-81 ½ yardsPatriotic Words and Motifs - Multi (Backing)9856-8

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 inch Block Print - Red/Blue (A):

• Fussy cut (6) 10 ½" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Folio Basics - Red Hot (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 13 ½" strips.
- (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Firework Bursts on White - Multi (C), cut:

• (4) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 3" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Patriotic Words and Motifs - Multi (Backing), cut:

• (3) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 16" x 21" strips.

Table Topper Block Assembly

Note: Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

21. Sew (1) 2" x 10 ½"
Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" Fabric A square.
Sew (1) 2" x 13 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 8 square (Fig. 19). **Trim the unit to measure 12** ½" x 12 ½".
Repeat to make (6) Unit 8 squares total.




22. Sew (1) 3" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 8 square to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (6) Place Mat tops total.



- 23. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 24. Sew the (10) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (6) equal length strips.
- 25. Bind as desired.

Napkin Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Ice Pop Allover - Royal (A), cut:

• (2) 18" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 18" squares.

From the Large Patterned Stars on Red Ground - Red

• (2) 18" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 18" squares.

From the Bias Plaid - Blue (C), cut:

• (1) 18" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 18" squares.

From the Patriotic Words and Motifs - Multi (D), cut:

• (1) 18" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 18" squares.

Napkin Assembly

Note: Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted. Follow the Napkin Layout in Figure 21 while assembling the napkins.)

- 26. Place (2) 18" Fabric A squares right sides together. Stitch around the outside of the square, leaving an opening at the bottom for turning.
- 27. Turn the unit right side out and stitch the opening closed to make (1) Napkin.
- 28. Repeat Steps 26-27 to make (1) napkin using the Fabric A squares, (2) napkins using the Fabric B squares, (1) napkin using the Fabric C squares and (1) napkin using the Fabric D squares.
