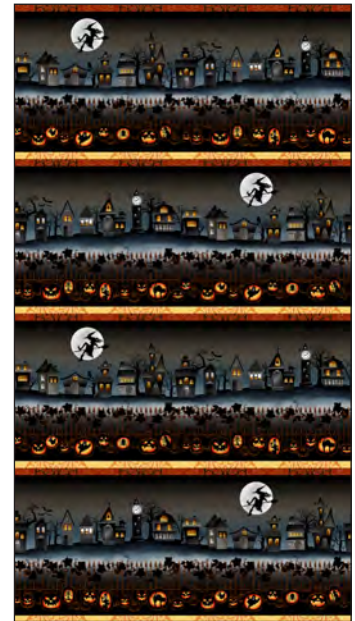

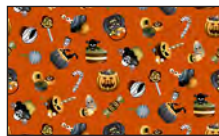

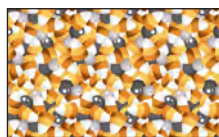

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## Materials

Yardages and cutting instructions are based on 42" of usable fabric width.

One 3055P-99 Halloween Panel 24" - Black  
 1/4 yard 7755-03 Folio - Butter  
 1/4 yard 7755-36 Folio - Orange  
 5/8 yard 3046-35 Jack-o'-lantern Patch - Orange  
 3/4 yard 3050-99 Bat Wing Damask - Black  
 1-7/8 yards 3054-99 Scary Border Stripe - Black  
 3 1/3 yards 3047-35 Scary Treats - Orange  
 for backing

## Cut Fabrics

Note: All strips are cut across the width of the fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise indicated.

### From 3055P-99 Halloween Panel 24" - Black:

\*Trim to 23-1/2" x 39-1/2".

### From 7755-03 Folio - Butter, cut:

\*One 1-1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Eleven 1-1/4" squares (A)
- Eight 1-1/4" x 1-3/4" strips (B)
- Eight 1" x 1-3/4" strips (C)

\*One 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 2-1/2" squares (H) and one 1-1/4" square (for a total of twelve A squares).

### From 7755-36 Folio - Orange, cut:

\*Four 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 1.

### From 3046-35 Jack-o'-lantern Patch - Orange, cut:

\*Four 4-1/2" x WOF strips for border 3.

### From 3050-99 Bat Wing Damask - Black, cut:

\*One 1-3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut:

- Four 1-3/4" x 3-3/4" strips (F)
- Eight 1-1/4" squares (A1)
- Eight 1" x 1-1/4" strips (D)

\*One 2-1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut four 2-1/2" x 2" strips (G) and four 2-1/2" x 3/4" strips (E).

\*Four 1-1/2" x WOF strips for border 2.

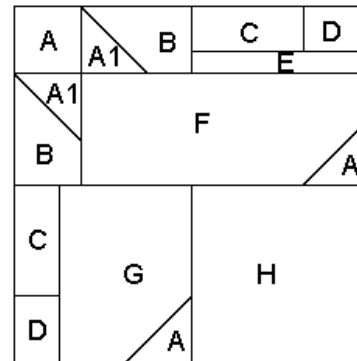
\*Six 2-1/2" x WOF strips for binding.

### From 3054-99 Scary Border Stripe - Black, cut:

\*Four 7-1/2" x LOF strips for border 4.

## Assemble Blocks

Note: Measurements include 1/4" seam allowances. Sew with right sides together unless otherwise stated. If no direction is specified, press the seam toward the darker fabric.



Bat block diagram

1. Draw a diagonal line from corner to corner on the wrong side of the 3050-99 Bat Wing Damask - Black A1 squares. Group the 7755-03 Folio - Butter B strips into two piles of four strips. Noting fabric orientation and stitching direction, sew a Black square to the left side of the units in Pile 1 and to the right side of the units in Pile 2 (figure 1). Trim the seams to 1/4" and press open. The units measure 1-1/4" x 1-3/4".

Figure 1 - Make (4) 1-1/4" x 1-3/4" units of each type.

2. Repeat Step 1 with the 3050-99 Bat Wing Damask - Black F and G strips and the four 7755-03 Folio - Butter A squares to make four units of each type (figure 2).



Y units - 1-3/4" x 3-3/4"



Z units - 2-1/2" x 2"

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3. Sew a 3050-99 Bat Wing Damask – Black D strip to a 7755-03 Folio – Butter C strip. Press the seam toward the darker fabric (*figure 3*). Repeat to make eight 1" x 2-1/2" units.

4. Noting fabric orientation, sew a 3050-99 Bat Wing Damask – Black E strip to the bottom of **four** Step 3 units (*figure 4*). Press the seams toward the bottom.

5. Noting fabric orientation, sew together a 7755-03 Folio – Butter A square, a Step 1 W unit, and a Step 4 unit (*figure 5*). Repeat to make four rows. Press the seams toward the Butter A square.

6. Sew the Step 1 X units to the left side of the Step 2 Y units (*figure 6*). Press the seams toward the Y units. Make four rows.

7. Sew together one Step 3 unit, a Step 2 Z unit, and a 7755-03 Folio – Butter H square. Press the seams in one direction. Repeat to make four rows. Sew the Steps 5, 6, and 7 rows together to make four 4-1/2" blocks (trim if necessary). Press the seams in one direction (*figure 7*).

### Assemble Quilt Top

8. For border 1, trim two 1-1/2" 7755-36 Folio – Orange strips to 39-1/2" and sew one strip to each side of the 3055P-99 Halloween 24" – Black panel. Press the seams toward the border. Trim two more 1-1/2" Orange strips to 25-1/2" and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the panel. Press as before.
9. For border 2, trim two 1-1/2" 3050-99 Bat Wing Damask – Black strips to 41-1/2" and sew one strip to each side of the quilt center. Press the seams toward the border. Trim two more 1-1/2" Black strips to 27-1/2" and sew one to the top and one to the bottom of the panel. Press as before.
10. To make border 3, trim two 4-1/2" 3046-35 Jack-o'-lantern Patch – Orange strips to 27-1/2", sew one Step 7 block to each end (note block orientation!) of the strips to make the top and bottom border strips. Press the seams toward the center and set the strips aside. Measure the vertical length of the quilt top through the center and cut two border strips that length. Sew one strip to each side of the quilt top. Press seams toward borders. Finally, sew the top and the bottom strips to the quilt center. Press the seams toward the borders.
11. For border 4, mark the quilt center along the sides, top, and bottom. Mark the center of each

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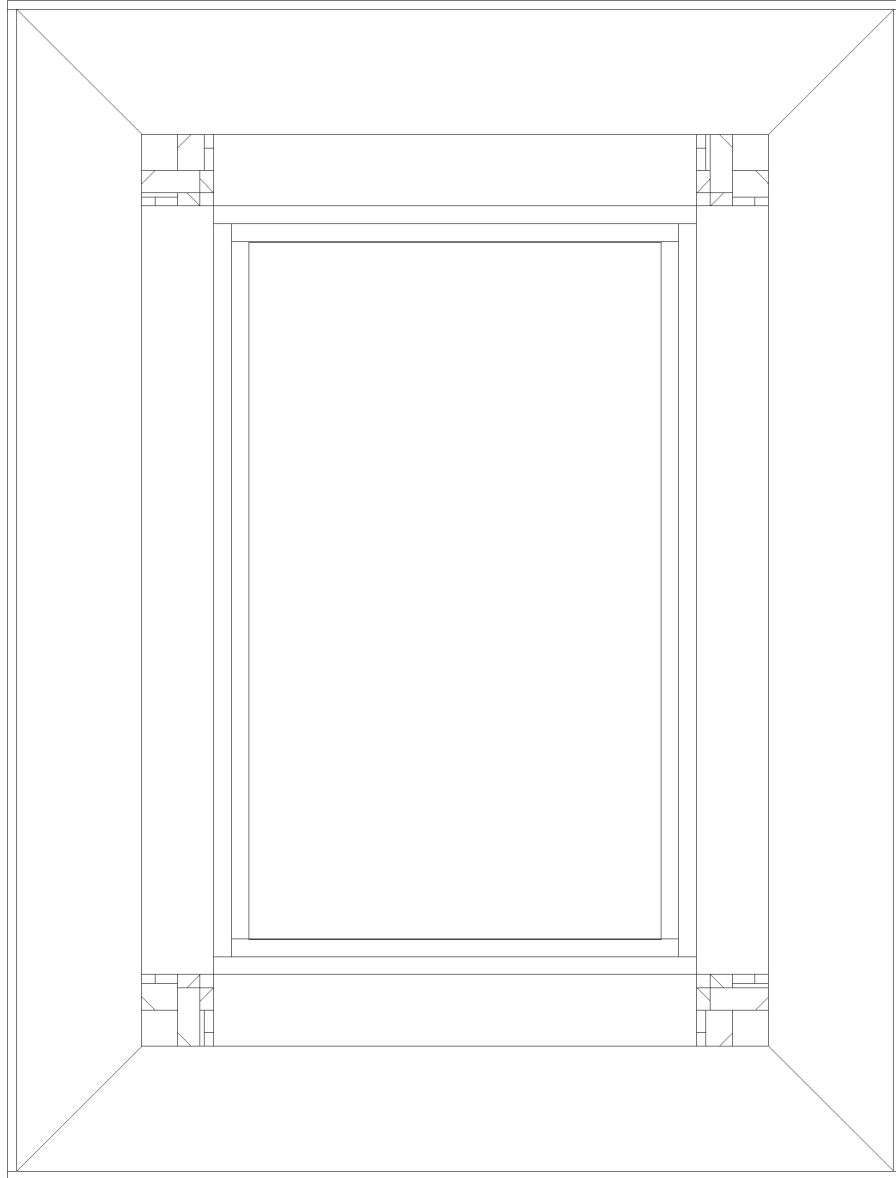
7-1/2" 3054-99 Scary Border Stripe – Black border strip. Matching the centers, sew each border strip in place beginning and ending exactly 1/4" from the corners. DO NOT trim the extra length.

12. To miter the borders, fold one corner of the quilt at a 45° angle so that the border strips are directly on top of one another and the seams nest together. Place your rotary ruler on the fold of the quilt so that the long edge is against the fold and the 45° line is on the side of the seam. Draw a line from the corner of the quilt top to the outside edge of the border. Pin the borders together. Position your needle on the inside corner where the border meets the quilt. Stitch directly on the line you have drawn to the outside edge of the border. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam allowance. Press. Repeat the process for the remaining three corners of the quilt.

## Finishing

13. Create a quilt sandwich with the batting between the quilt top and the backing. Pin or baste layers together, mark the quilting design, and quilt by hand or machine. When quilting is complete, remove pins or basting, and trim batting and backing even with raw edges of the quilt top.
14. Join the six 2-1/2" 3050-99 Bat Wing Damask – Black binding strips together end to end using a diagonal seam to make one long strip. With wrong sides together, fold in half lengthwise and press. Sew binding to the edges of the quilt, mitering corners, and overlapping ends. Fold binding to the back of the quilt and stitch it in place by hand to finish.
