Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Block Panel - Cream (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 9" x 12 1/2" small panel for Block One.
- (1) 10 1/4" x 7 1/4" small panel for Block Two.
- (1) 8" x 13" small panel for Block Three.
- (1) 13" x 11" small panel for Block Four.
- (1) 9 3/4" x 10 3/4" small panel for Block Five.
- (1) 13" x 11" small panel for Block Six.
- (1) 8 1/2" square panel for Block Seven.
- (1) 8 1/4" x 10 1/2" small panel for Block Eight.

From the Scissors Allover - White (B), cut:

- (1) 8 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 8 1/2" square and (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (C), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 13" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 12 1/4" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 58 1/2" strips.
- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Lemon (D), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 11 1/2" strips and (2) 2" x 8 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips and (2) 1 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Fuchsia (E), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/4" x 7 1/4" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 11" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 16" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 13 3/4" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - True Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 13" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 12" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 11" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 16" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Lime (G), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 10 3/4" strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 2 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 13 3/4" strips.
- (1) 1 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" strips.

From the Needle and Thread - White (H), cut:

- (4) 4 1/2" x 56 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.

From the Embroidery Thread Allover - Pink (I), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Scissors Allover - Green (J), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Needle and Thread - Blue (K), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Knitting Allover - Blue (L), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Knitting Allover - White (M), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Buttons - Pink (N), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Embroidery Thread Allover - Aqua (O), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Spools of Thread - Yellow (P), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

Cutting Instruction - Continued

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Pin Cushion Allover - Pink (Q), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Buttons - White (R), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 1/2" squares and (4) 3 1/2" squares.

From the Tape Measure Allover - Yellow (S), cut:

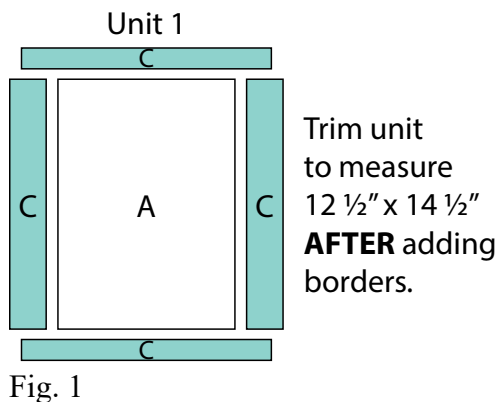
- (2) 3 1/2" x 62 1/2" LOF strips.
- (2) 3 1/2" x 58 1/2" LOF strips.

From the Label Print - Aqua (Backing), cut:

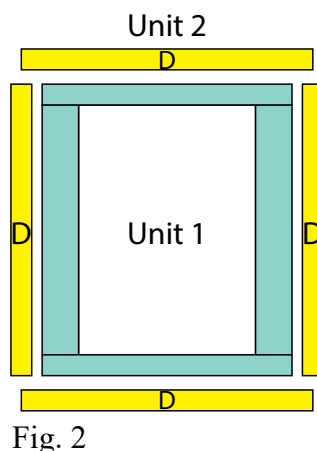
- (2) 76" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72" x 76" back.

Block Assembly

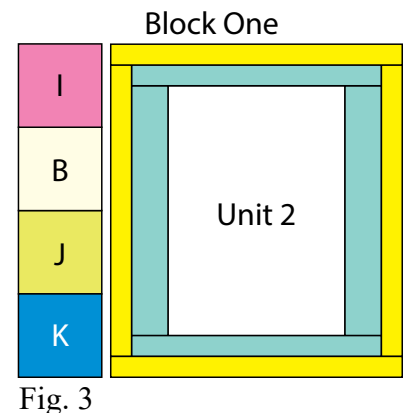
1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 9" x 12 1/2" Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 2" x 13" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel. Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" x 14 1/2" to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 1).



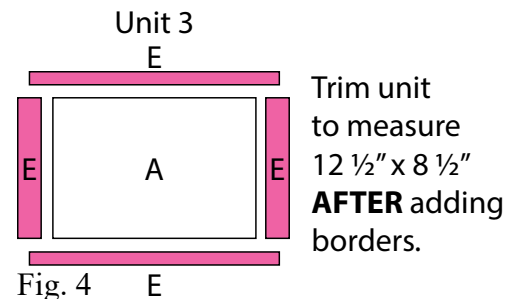
2. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Unit 1 strip. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 14 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 strip to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 2).



3. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric I square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric B square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric J square and (1) 4 1/2" Fabric K square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the left side of (1) Unit 2 strip to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 3).



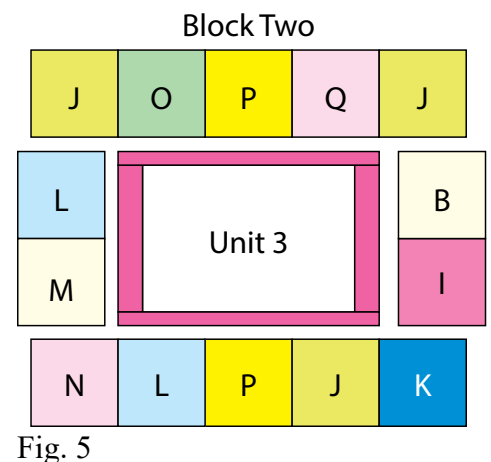
4. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 7 1/4" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 10 1/4" x 7 1/4" Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 13 3/4" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel to make (1) Unit 3 strip (Fig. 4). Trim the unit to measure 12 1/2" x 8 1/2".



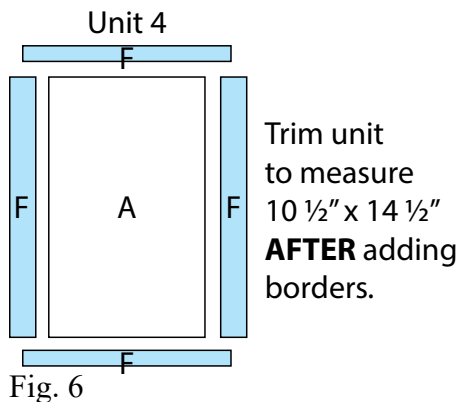
5. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric L square to the top of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric M square. Sew the new strip to the left side of the Unit 3 strip. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric B square to the top of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric I square. Sew the new strip to the right side of the Unit 3 strip (Fig. 5).

6. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric J square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric O square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric P square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric O square and (1) 4 1/2" Fabric J square together in that order. Sew the strip to the top of the Unit 3 strip from Step 5 (Fig. 5).

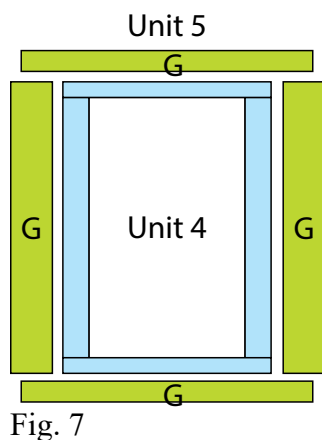
7. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric N square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric L square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric O square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric P square, (1) 4 1/2" Fabric J square and (1) 4 1/2" Fabric K square together in that order. Sew the strip to the bottom of the Unit 3 strip from Step 6 to make (1) Block Two rectangle (Fig. 5).



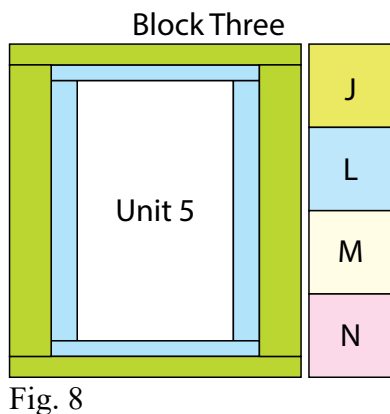
8. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x 13" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 8" x 13" Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 2" x 12" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 6). Trim the unit to measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ ".



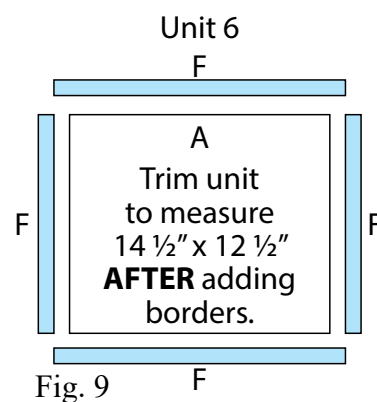
9. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of the Unit 4 strip. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 4 strip to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 7).



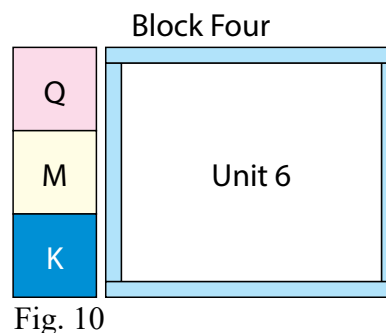
10. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square and (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric N square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the right side of (1) Unit 5 strip to make (1) Block Three rectangle (Fig. 8).



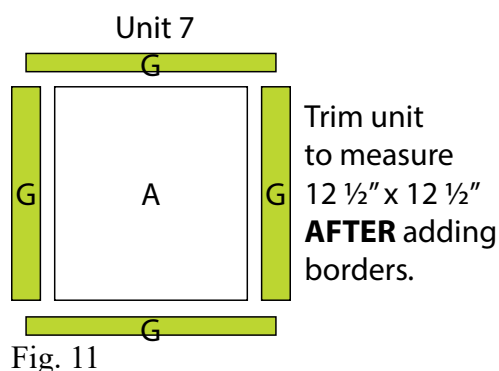
11. Sew (1) 2" x 11" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 13" x 11" Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 2" x 16" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 9). Trim the unit to measure $14\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".



12. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square and (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the left side of the Unit 6 strip to make (1) Block Four rectangle (Fig. 10).



13. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G strip to each side of (1) $9\frac{3}{4}$ " x $10\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 2" x $13\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 11). Trim the unit to measure $12\frac{1}{2}$ " square.



14. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric P square, (1) 4 ½" Fabric B square and (1) 4 ½" Fabric O square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the left side of (1) Unit 7 square. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric Q square, (1) 4 ½" Fabric M square and (1) 4 ½" Fabric K square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the right side of (1) Unit 7 square to make (1) Block Five rectangle (Fig. 12).

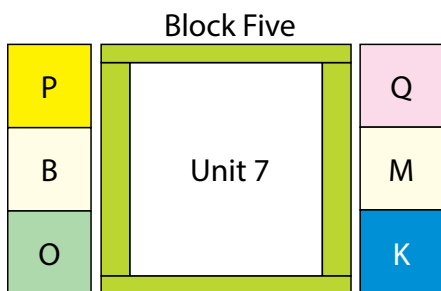

15. Sew (1) 2" x 11" Fabric E strip to each side of (1) 13" x 11" Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 2" x 16" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 13). Trim the unit to measure 14 ½" x 12 ½".

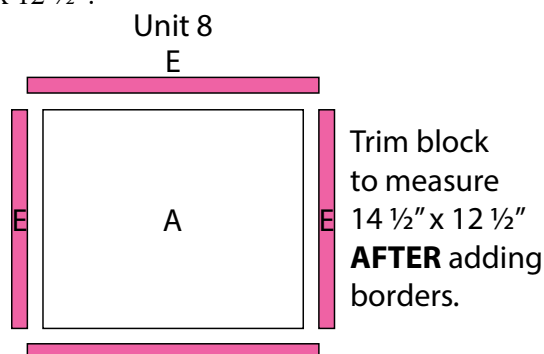

16. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric P square, (1) 4 ½" Fabric B square and (1) 4 ½" Fabric O square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the right side of (1) Unit 8 strip to make (1) Block Six rectangle (Fig. 14).

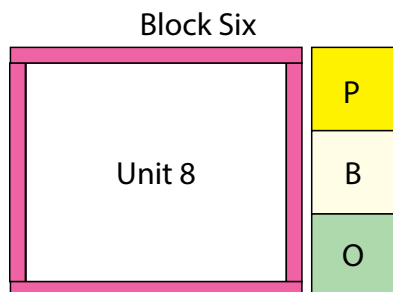

17. Sew (1) 2" x 8 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 2" x 11 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel to make (1) Unit 9 square (Fig. 15). Trim the block to measure 10 ½" square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Unit 9 square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 9 square to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 16).

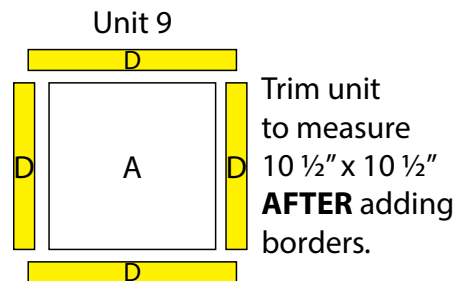

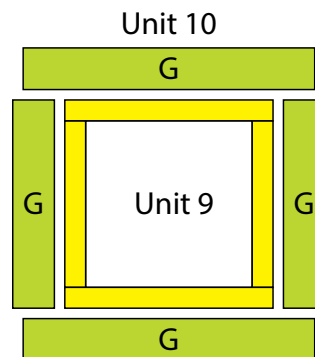

18. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 14 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 10 strip to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 17).

19. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric P square, (1) 4 ½" Fabric O square, (1) 4 ½" Fabric R square and (1) 4 ½" Fabric I square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the left side of (1) Unit 11 strip to make (1) Block Seven rectangle (Fig. 18).

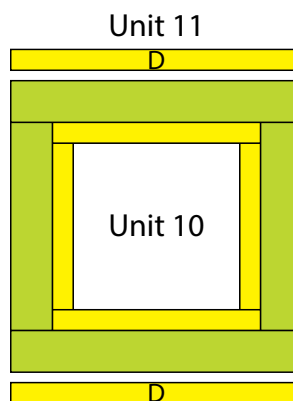

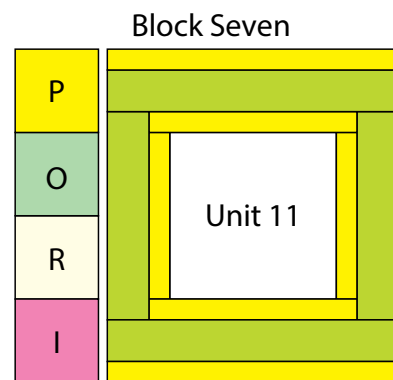

20. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) $8\frac{1}{4}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A small panel. Sew (1) 2 " x $12\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A small panel to make (1) Unit 12 strip (Fig. 19). Trim the unit to measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ ".

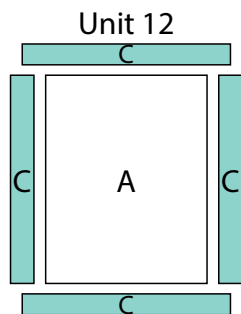

Trim unit to measure $10\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " **AFTER** adding borders.

21. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to each side of (1) Unit 12 strip. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $12\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 12 strip to make (1) Unit 13 strip (Fig. 20).

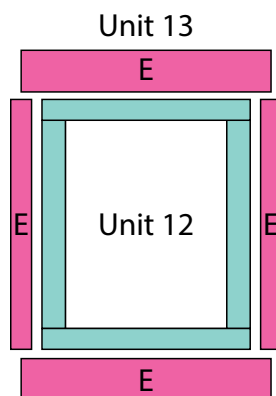

22. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square and (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the left side of (1) Unit 13 strip (Fig. 21).

23. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric P square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric R square and (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric I square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the right side of (1) Unit 13 strip from Step 22 to make (1) Block Eight rectangle (Fig. 21).

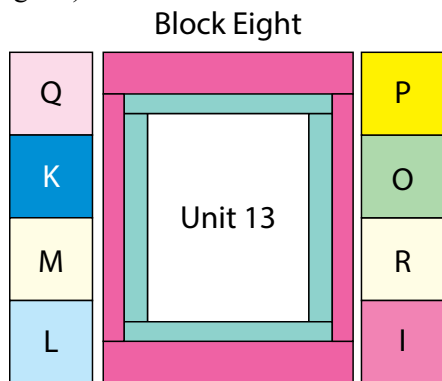

24. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to each side of (1) $8\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B square. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric B square to make (1) Unit 14 strip (Fig. 22).

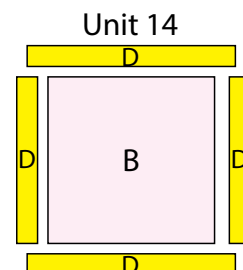

25. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $10\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of the Unit 14 strip. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 14 strip to make (1) Unit 15 strip (Fig. 23).

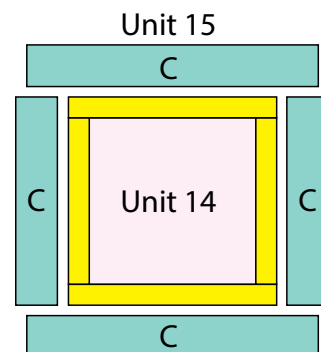

26. Sew (1) $1\frac{1}{2}$ " x $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 15 strip to make (1) Unit 16 strip (Fig. 24).

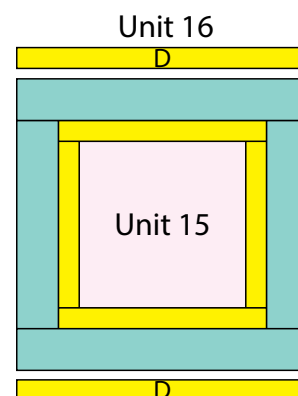

27. Sew (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric Q square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric K square, (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric M square and (1) $4\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric L square together in that order. Sew the new strip to the right side of (1) Unit 16 strip to make (1) Block Nine rectangle (Fig. 25).

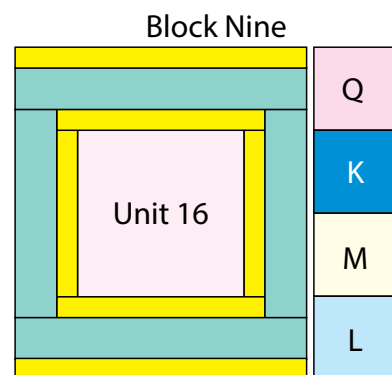

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

28. Sew (1) Block One rectangle, (1) Block Two rectangle and (1) Block Three rectangle together in that order to make Row One.

29. Sew (1) Block Four rectangle, (1) Block Five rectangle and (1) Block Six rectangle together in that order to make Row Two.

30. Sew (1) Block Seven rectangle, (1) Block Eight rectangle and (1) Block Nine rectangle together in that order to make Row Three.

31. Sew (4) 4 ½" x 56 ½" Fabric H strips and the (3) block rows together, alternating them, to make the Center Block.

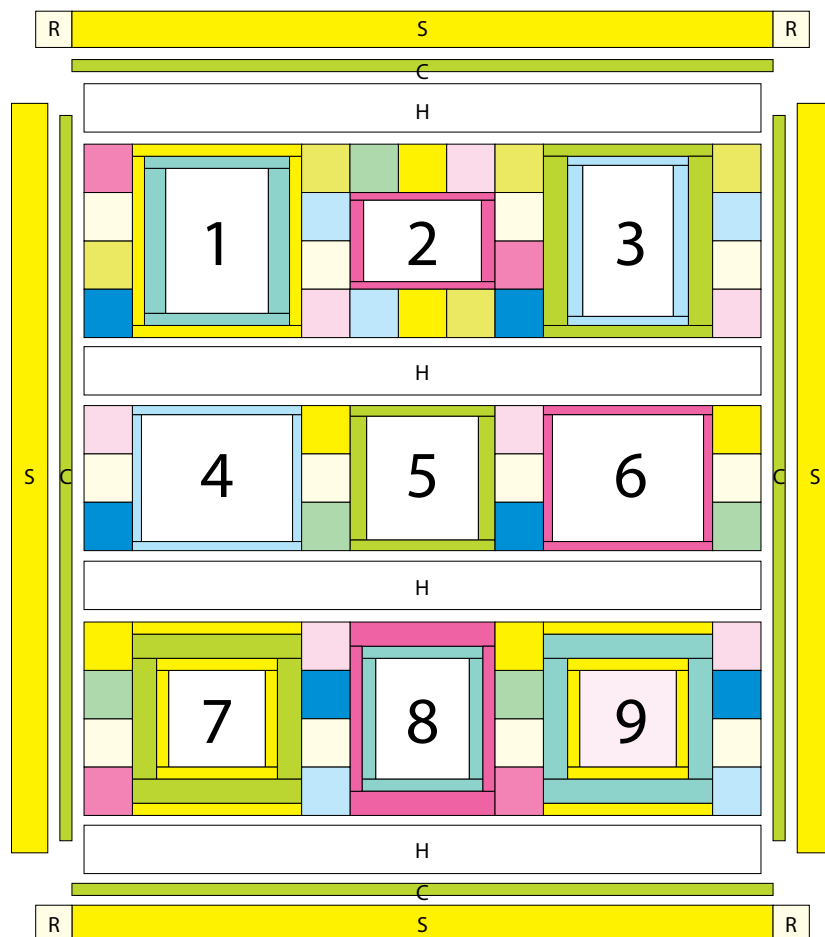
32. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 60 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 58 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

33. Sew (1) 3 ½" x 62 ½" Fabric S strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric R square to each end of (1) 3 ½" x 58 ½" Fabric S strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

34. Layer and quilt as desired.

35. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

36. Bind as desired.
