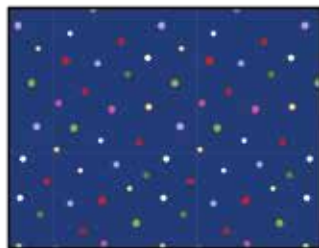

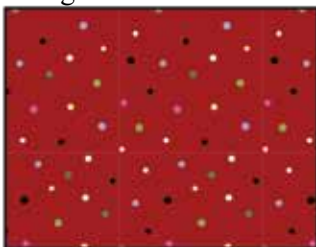

⅜ yard	Dots - Royal (E)	2757-77
¼ yard	Words & Veggies - Yellow (F)	2753-44
⅝ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (G)	1063-01W
1 ⅛ yards	Words & Veggies - Royal (H)	2753-77
½ yard	Multi Stripe - Royal (I)	2758-77*
3 yards	Veggies - Green (Backing)	2755-66

Table Topper Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Happy Valley Farm Blocks - Royal (A):

- Fussy cut (5) 8 ½" x 7 ¾" rectangles, each centered on a block.

From the Dots - Red (B), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2 ½" x 11 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 7 ¾" strips.

From the Mini Flowers - Light Blue (C), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Farm Animals - Light Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 ½" squares.

From the Dots - Royal (E), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 3 ½" squares.

From the Words & Veggies - Yellow (F), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 ½" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (G), cut:

- (3) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 ½" x 6 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 38 ½" WOF strips.

From the Words & Veggies - Royal (H), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 38 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 ½" x 46 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Multi Stripe - Royal (I), cut:

- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Veggies - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 54" back.

Table Topper Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 7 ¾" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" x 7 ¾" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 10 ½" x 10 ½"**. Repeat to make (5) Unit 1 squares total.

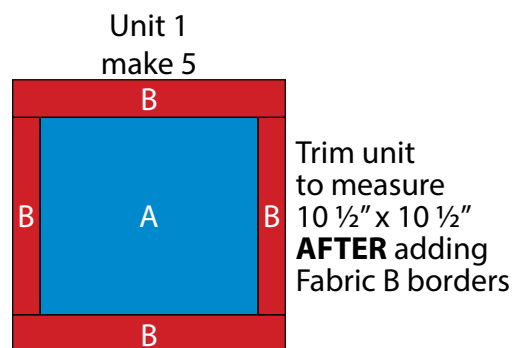

2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (5) Block One squares total.

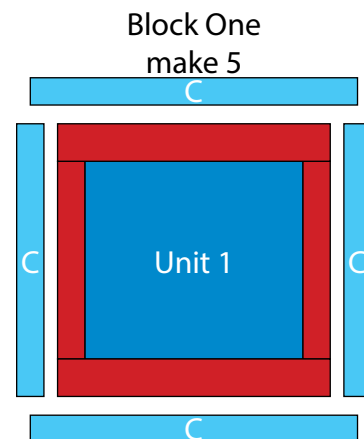

3. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric E square on the left side of (1) 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 4).

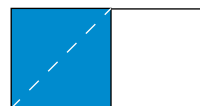

4. Place another 3 ½" Fabric E square on the right side of the 3 ½" x 6 ½" Fabric G strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 6).

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (16) Unit 2 strips total.



6. Sew (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 2 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Block Two square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.



7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make the Center Block (Fig. 8).

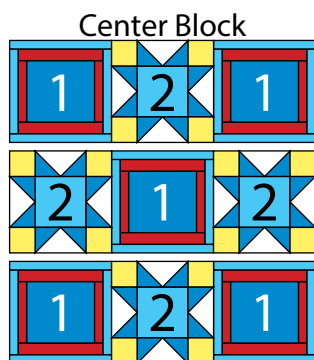

Table Topper Assembly

(Follow the Table Topper Layout in Figure 9 while assembling the topper.)

8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 36 ½" Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 38 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Topper top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.

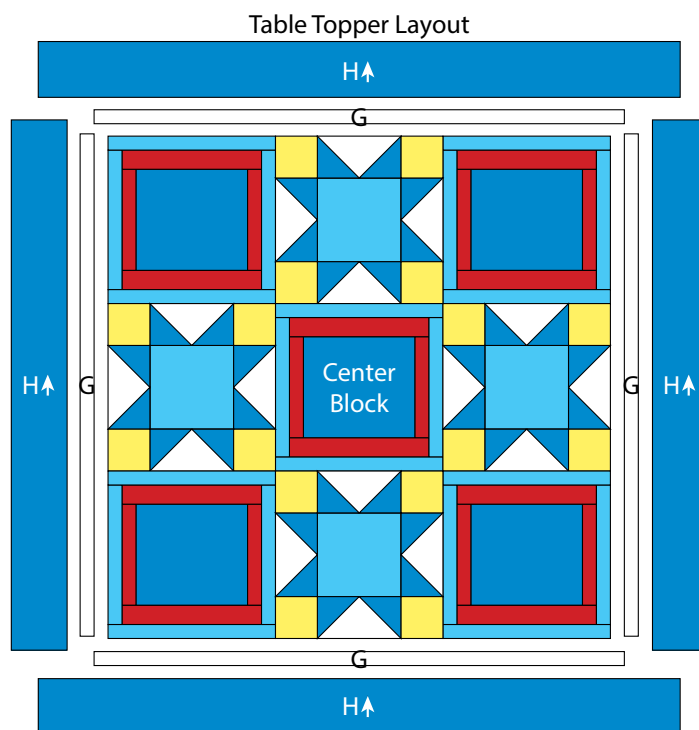

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Happy Valley Farm Blocks - Royal (A):

- Fussy cut (4) 8 ½" x 7 ¾" rectangles, each centered on a block.

From the Dots - Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 11 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2" x 7 ¾" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 ½" squares.

From the Mini Flowers - Light Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 10 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.

From the Dots - Royal (D), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 1 ½" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (E), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips.

From the Words & Veggies - Yellow (F), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 1 ½" squares.

From the Multi Stripe - Royal (G), cut:

- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Veggies - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 16" x 20" rectangles for the backs.

Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

13. Sew (1) 2" x 7 ¾" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 8 ½" x 7 ¾" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 10). **Trim the block to measure 10 ½" x 10 ½"**. Repeat to make (4) Unit 3 squares total.

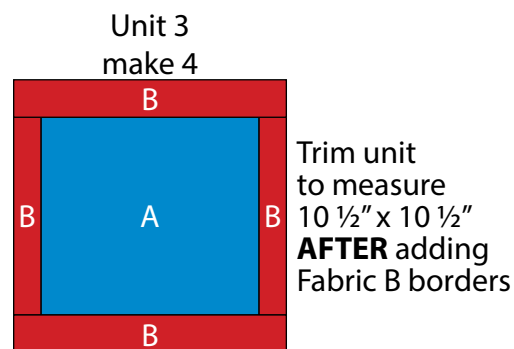

14. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 3 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 3 square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (4) Block Three squares total.

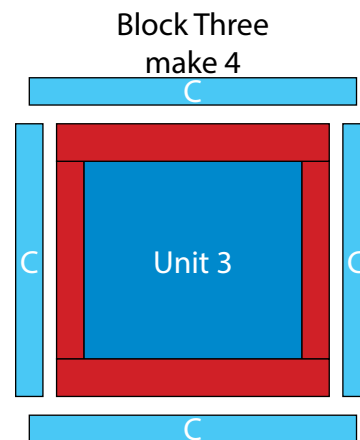

Table Set

15. Place (1) 1 ½" Fabric D square on the left side of (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 12). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 13).

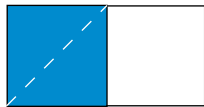

16. Place another 1 ½" Fabric D square on the right side of the 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric E strip, right sides together (Fig. 14). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 14). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 15).

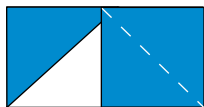

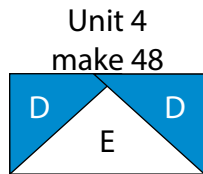

17. Repeat Steps 15-16 to make (48) Unit 4 strips total.

18. Sew (1) 1 ½" Fabric F square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 4 ½" Block Four square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (8) Block Four squares total.

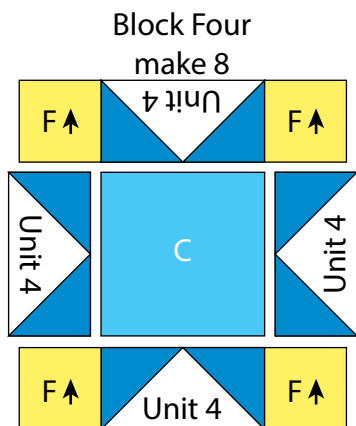

19. Repeat Step 18 and refer to Figure 17 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (4) Block Five squares.

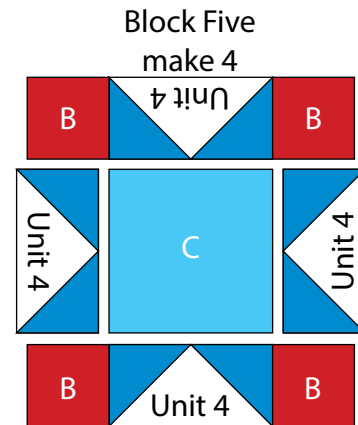

20. Sew (1) Block Four square to the top and to the bottom of (1) Block Five square. Sew the newly sewn strip to the left side of (1) Block Three square to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (4) Place Mat tops total.

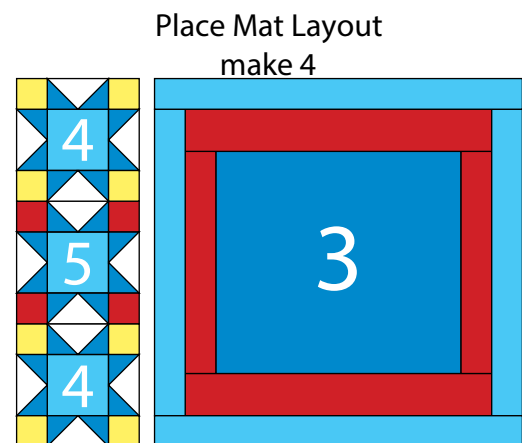

21. Layer and quilt as desired.

22. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal pieces.

23. Bind as desired.

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
