## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Heart Blocks Repeat - Pink/Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 10 " squares, each centered on a block.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (B), cut:

- (4) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (17) $31 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ strips.
-(2) $23 / 8>\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $23 / 8 "$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (48) $23 / 8$ " triangles.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 " x 10 " strips.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 13 " strips.
- (2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.
- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 611 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 481 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 11 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.


## From the Monotone Geometric - Red (C), cut:

-(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" squares.

- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 131 / 2 "$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 2 " \times 11 \frac{1}{2} "$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 4 " \times 12 "$ strips.
- (4) $1 \frac{1}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $11 / 4 " \times 131 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Birds and Butterflies - Pink (D), cut:

- (4) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Packed Roses - Pink (E), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
-(34) Template 2 triangles.
From the Small Hearts Allover - Pink/Red (F), cut: - (2) $31 / 2$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $31 / 2$ "squares.

From the Monotone Lacy Allover - Aqua (G), cut:

- (2) $37 / 8 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $37 / 8$ " squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (24) $37 / 8$ " triangles.
- (4) $11 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 4 " \times 641 / 2 "$ strips.
- (3) $11 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 4 " \times 50 "$ strips.

From the Folio Basics - Rose (H), cut:

- Cut (34) Template 1 triangles.
- Cut (34) Template 3 triangles.

From the Birds and Butterflies - Aqua (I), cut:

- (1) $31 / 2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) $3^{1 / 2 "}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Large Hearts Allover - Red (J), cut:

- (4) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 66^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (3) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $41 / 2 " \times 58 "$ strips.

From the Monotone Geometric - Pink (K), cut:
-(7) $21 / 2$ " $\times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Small Hearts Allover - Pink/Red/White (Backing), cut:

- (2) $66 "$ x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66 " x 82 " back.


## Block Assembly <br> Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 10$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13' Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the square to measure 12" x 12".
Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) $11 / 4 " \times 12 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $11 / 4$ " x $131 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.

7. Place (1) 2" Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 9). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4 "$ away from the sewn seam.
8. Follow Figure 10 for the seam direction to add a 2 " Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the Fabric E square to make (1) $31 / 2 "$ Unit 4 square (Fig. 11).
3. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 2 square, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 4). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam.

4. Follow Figure 5 for the seam direction to add a $31 / 2$ " Fabric D square to each of the remaining corners of the Unit 2 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 6).
5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (6) Block Ones total.

6. Sew (1) $23 / 8$ " triangle to adjacent sides of (1) 2" Fabric C square to form (1) BCB triangle. Sew the BCB triangle to (1) $37 / 8$ " Fabric G triangle along their long side to make (1) $31 / 2 "$ Unit 3 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (24) Unit 3 squares total.

9. Repeat Steps $7-8$ to make (6) Unit 4 squares total.

10. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to each side of (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric F square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric F square to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (6) Unit 5 squares total.
11. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 111 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 5 square to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (6) Unit 6 squares total.

12. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 11 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 6 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 131 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 6 square to make (1) Unit 7 square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (6) Unit 7 squares total.
13. Repeat Steps $3-4$ to add (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric D square to each corner of (1) Unit 7 square to make (1) Block Two Square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.

14. Place (1) Fabric H-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric E-Template 2 triangle right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 16). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.

15. Place (1) Fabric H-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric E-Template 2 triangle right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 17). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make (1) $31 / 2 "$ Unit 8 square (Fig. 18).
16. Repeat Steps $14-15$ to make (34) Unit 8 squares total.

17. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) $31 / 2 " \times 71 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (17) Unit 9 strips total.

18. Sew together (3) Unit 9 strips and (2) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric I squares, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (3) Unit 10 strips total.

## HEART \& SOUL <br> Quilt 1

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Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
19. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Unit 9 stirp and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.
20. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Unit 9 stirp and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
21. Sew the (4) Rows together, in numerical order and alternating them with (3) Unit 10 strips, to make the Center Block.
22. Sew (1) $2 " \times 611 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2 " \times 481 / 2 "$ Fabric B stirp to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
23. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4 \prime} \times 641 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{4} " \times 50 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
24. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 66 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 58 "$ Fabric J stirp to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
25. Layer and quilt as desired.
26. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric K strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
27. Bind as desired.
