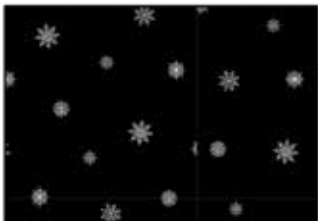

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

### From the 24 Inch She Shed Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 21  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34  $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

### From the Bias Plaid - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 25  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (6) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

### From the Small Motif Allover - Multi (C), cut:

- (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

### From the She Shed with Trucks Allover - Multi (D), cut:

- (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

### From the Large Snowflake - White/Red (E), cut:

- (2) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

### From the Monotone Swirl - Green (F), cut:

- (4) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.
- (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (3) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

### From the Small Snowflake - Red (G), cut:

- (5) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

### From the Monotone Swirl - Red (H), cut:

- (3) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

### From the She Shed Allover - Black (I), cut:

- (2) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 48  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 5  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.

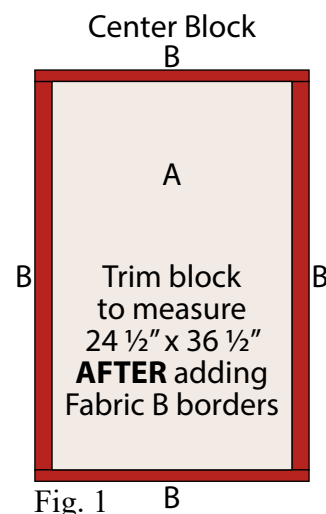
## From the She Sheds with Trucks Allover - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 66" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 66" x 54" back.

## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a  $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 21  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 34  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 24  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 36  $\frac{1}{2}$ ".



- Place (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square on the top left corner of (1) 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam.

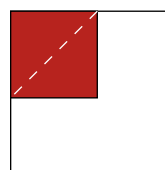

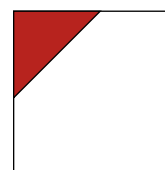

- Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G square to the upper right and lower left corners and (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F square to the lower right corner of the 4  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 5).

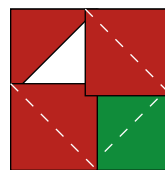

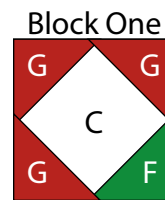

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4. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-13 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make the designated number of block squares for Block Two through Block Nine.

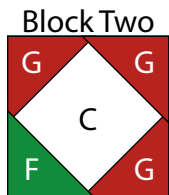

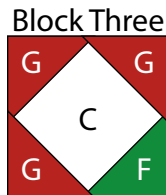

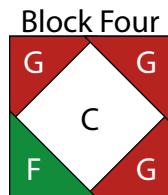

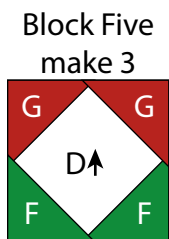

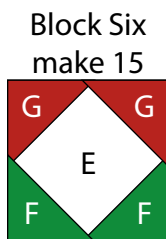

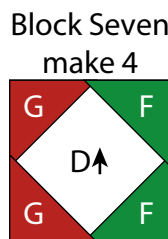

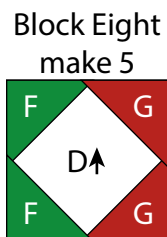

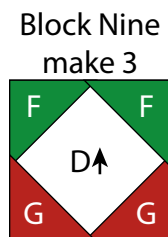

5. Sew together (5) Block Six squares and (4) Block Seven squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 14).

6. Sew together (5) Block Eight squares and (4) Block Six squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 15).

7. Follow Figure 16 and sew together (8) assorted Blocks to make the Top Border.

8. Follow Figure 17 and sew together (8) assorted Blocks to make the Bottom Border.

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

9. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and right sides of the Center Block.

10. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 34 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric F strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 36 1/2" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

14. Layer and quilt as desired.

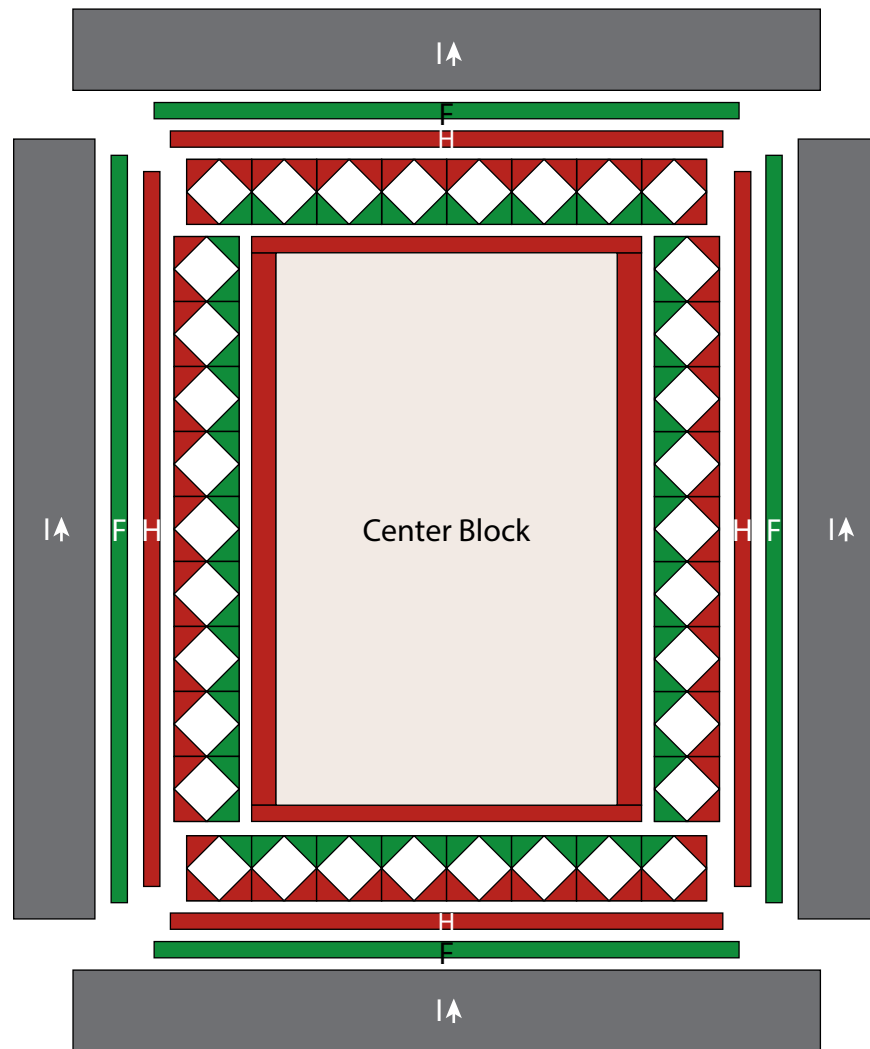
15. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

16. Bind as desired.
