Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Red Flakes on White Ground - White (A), cut:

- (6) 4 ⅝" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 4 ⅝" squares.
- (6) 4 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 4 ¼" squares.
- (10) 2" x WOF strips.

From the Swirling Snow - Gray (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips.

From the Dots - Red (C), cut:

- (5) 2" x WOF strips.
- (16) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 2" x 15 ½" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Silver Gray (D), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips.

From the Snowflakes on Texture - Red (E), cut:

- (3) 4 ⅝" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 ⅝" squares.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Swirling Snow - Red (F), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips.

From the Snowflakes in Boxes - Gray (G), cut:

- (5) 2" x WOF strips.

From the Small Snowflakes - Red (H), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips.

From the Snowflakes in Blocks - Gray (I), cut:

- (3) 4 ⅝" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 ⅝" squares.

From the Plaid - Gray (J), cut:

- (16) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 2" x 15 ½" strips.

From the Red Deer on White Ground - White (K), cut:

- (2) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 3 ½" squares.

From the Winter Trees - Red/Gray (L), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 75 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 67 ½" strips.

From the Snowflakes in Boxes - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 93" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 75" x 93" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew together (1) 2" x WOF Fabric D strip, (1) 2" x WOF Fabric A strip, (1) 2" x WOF Fabric C strip, (1) 2" x WOF Fabric A strip and (1) 2" x WOF Fabric D strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 1).

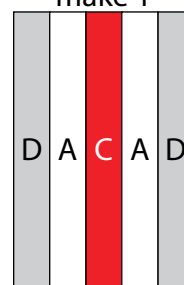

2. Cut the Strip Set 1 into (12) 2" x 8" Unit 1 strips.

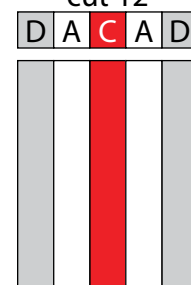

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 3-12 for fabric identification and placement to make (12) Unit 2 strips, (6) Unit 3 strips, (12) Unit 4 strips, (12) Unit 5 strips and (6) Unit 6 strips.

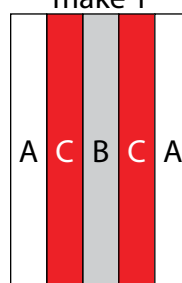

cut 12

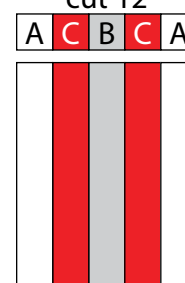

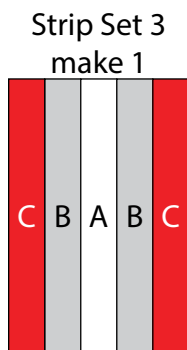

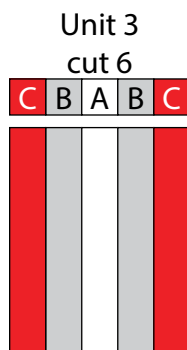

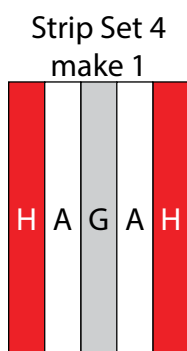

4. Sew together (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) Unit 3 strip, (1) Unit 2 strip and (1) Unit 1 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) 8" Unit 7 square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (6) Unit 7 squares total.

5. Repeat Step 4 and refer to Figure 14 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) 8" Unit 8 squares.

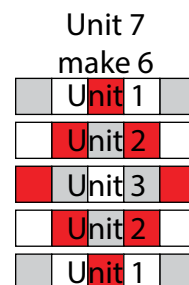

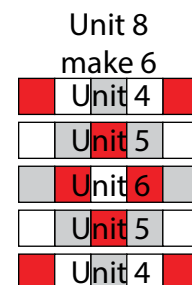

6. Place (1) 4 5/8" Fabric E square on top of (1) 4 5/8" Fabric A square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 15). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 15). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 16) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 4 1/4" square to make (2) Unit 9 squares (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (48) Unit 9 squares total.

7. Repeat Step 6 and refer to Figure 18 for fabric identification and placement to make (48) Unit 10 squares.

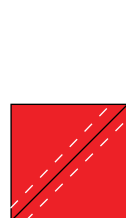

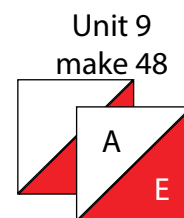

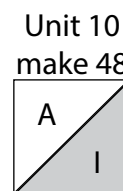

8. Sew (2) Unit 9 squares together along the Fabric A sides to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 19). Repeat to make (24) Unit 11 strips total.

9. Sew (2) Unit 10 squares together along the Fabric A sides to make (1) Unit 12 strip (Fig. 20). Repeat to make (24) Unit 12 strips total.

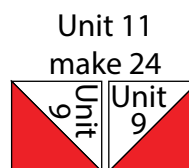

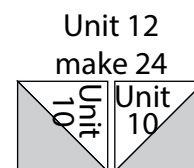

10. Sew (1) 4 1/4" Fabric A square to each end of (1) Unit 11 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 11 strip to each side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 21). The block should measure 15 1/2" square. Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.

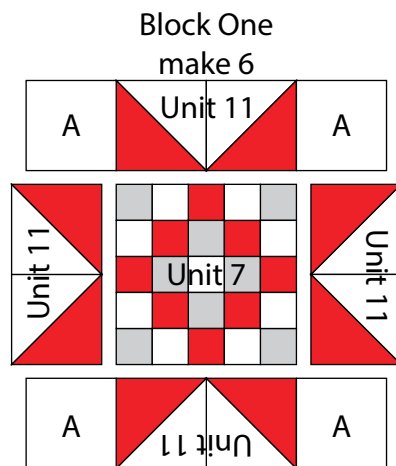

11. Repeat Step 10 and refer to Figure 22 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.

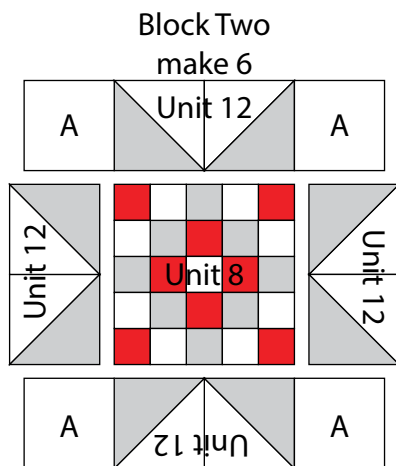

12. Sew (1) 2" x 15 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top of (1) 2" x 15 1/2" Fabric J strip lengthwise to make (1) Unit 13 strip (Fig. 23). Repeat to make (31) Unit 13 strips total.

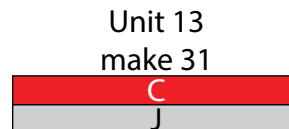

13. Sew together (4) 3 1/2" Fabric K squares and (3) Unit 13 strips, alternating them from left to right, to make (1) Unit 14 strip (Fig. 24 below). Repeat to make (3) Unit 14 strips total.

14. Repeat Step 13 and refer to Figure 25 below for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Unit 15 strips.

15. Sew together (1) Unit 13 strip, (1) Block One square, (1) Unit 13 strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Unit 13 strip, (1) Block One square and (1) Unit 13 strip, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Block Three strip (Fig. 26 below). Repeat to make a second Block Three strip.

16. Repeat Step 15 and refer to Figure 27 below for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Four strips.

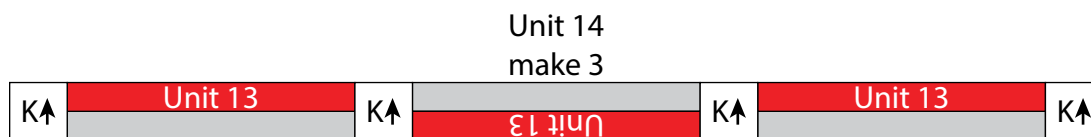

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

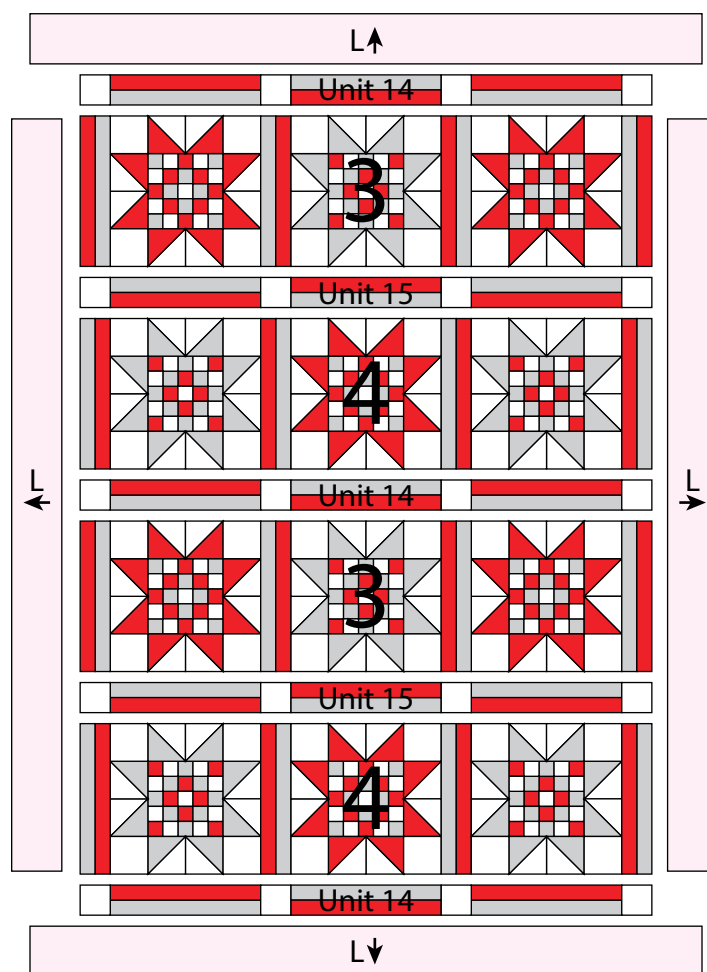
17. Sew together (1) Unit 14 strip, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Unit 15 strip, (1) Block Four strip, (1) Unit 14 strip, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Unit 15 strip, (1) Block Four strip and (1) Unit 14 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the Center Block.

18. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 75 ½" Fabric L strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 67 ½" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

19. Layer and quilt as desired.

20. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

21. Bind as desired.
