## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Home Sweet Home Panel 24 Inch x 44 Inch -

 Cream (A):- Fussy cut (2) $111 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ rectangles centered on a house and words.

From the Cross Stitch Texture - Black (B), cut:
-(1) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

- (1) $2 "$ x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $2 "$ x $181 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 14 \frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the HSH - Cross Stitch Hearts - Black (C), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ strips.
- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ strips.


## From the Folio Basics - Off White (D), cut:

-(1) $41 / 8 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 8 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) $41 / 8 "$ triangles.
-(4) $37 / 8 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) $37 / 8 "$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (72) $37 / 8 "$ triangles.

- (1) $33 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $33 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) $33 / 4$ " triangles.

From the Cross Stitch Texture - Cream (E), cut:

- (1) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) $21 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Folio Basics - Light Green (F), cut:

- (2) $23 / 4 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $23 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (72) $23 / 4$ " triangles.
- (3) $23 / 8 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (36) $23 / 8 "$ squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (72) $23 / 8$ " triangles.

From the Folio Basics - Wine (G), cut:

- (2) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.
- (5) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ strips.
-(7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Alphabet - Black (H), cut:
- (2) $21 / 2 \times 1 \times 361 / 2$ " WOF strips.
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times 341 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
From the Border Stripe - Cream (I), cut:
- (2) $91 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) $91 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 50$ " LOF strips.
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times 44$ " LOF strips.

From the Folio Basics - Dark Green (J), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Small Applique Flowers - Black (K), cut:
-(2) $21 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ LOF strips.

- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) $21 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed and (8) $93 / 8$ " squares. Cut the $93 / 8$ " squares across (1) diagonal to make (16) $93 / 8 "$ triangles.

From the Small Applique Flowers - Cream (L), cut: - (1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Mini Patch - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 78 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 72 " $\times 78$ " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew together (2) $111 / 2 " \times 91 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangles to make (1) $111 / 2 " \times 181 / 2 "$ Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1).
2. Sew (1) 2 " x $181 / 2$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 141 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the $14 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 201 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 2).

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3. Sew together (1) $23 / 8 "$ Fabric F triangle, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 21 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip and (1) $23 / 8$ " Fabric F triangle, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row. Sew (1) $23 / 4$ " Fabric F triangle to each end of (1) $11 / 2$ " $\times 21 / 2$ " Fabric G strip. Sew (1) $23 / 8$ " Fabric F triangle to the top of the Fabric G strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew together the rows to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). The unit should measure $43 / 4$ " square. Repeat to make (9) Unit 2 squares total.

5. Sew (1) $37 / 8 "$ Fabric D triangle to each of the (4) sides of (1) Unit 2 square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 5). The block should measure $61 / 2$ " square. Repeat to make (9) Block One squares total.
6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figure 6 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (9) Block Two squares.

7. Sew together (2) Block One squares and
(2) Block Two squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) Inner Side Border (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Inner Side Border.

8. Sew together (3) Block Two squares and (2) Block One squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Inner Top Border (Fig. 8).

9. Sew together (3) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Inner Bottom Border (Fig. 9).

3. Sew together (1) $3 \sqrt[3]{4}$ " Fabric D triangle, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric L square, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip and (1) $3^{3 / 4}$ " Fabric D triangle, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row. Sew (1) $41 / 8$ " Fabric D triangle to each end of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip. Sew (1) $33 / 4 "$ Fabric D triangle to the top of the Fabric G strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew together the rows to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 10). The unit should measure 9" square. Repeat to make (4) Unit 4 squares total.

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11. Sew (1) $93 / 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric K triangle to each of the (4) sides of (1) Unit 4 square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 11). The block should measure $121 / 2$ " square. Repeat to make (4) Block Three squares total.

12. Sew together (1) $9^{1 / 2 "} \times 46^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric I strip, (1) $21 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip and (1) $11 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Block Four strip (Fig. 12). Repeat to make a second Block Four strip.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
16. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 201 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 18 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
17. Sew (1) Inner Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
18. Sew the Inner Top and Bottom Borders to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
19. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 36 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 341 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
20. Center (1) $31 / 2 " \times 50 "$ Fabric I strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a $1 / 4$ " from the top edge of the block and stop a $1 / 4$ " from the bottom edge. DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS. Repeat with the opposite side.

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21. Repeat Step 20 to sew (1) $31 / 2 " \times 44 "$ Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start $1 / 4 "$ away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 16).
22. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 16), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners.

23. Sew (1) Block Four strip to each side of the Center Block.
24. Sew the Outer Top Border and the Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
25. Layer and quilt as desired.
26. Sew the (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
27. Bind as desired.


Quilt Layout

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
