

Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Home Sweet Home Panel 24 inch x 44 inch - Cream (A):

• Fussy cut (3) 11 ¹/₂" x 9 ¹/₂" rectangles, centered on panel pieces.

From the Folio Basics - Dark Green (B), cut:

• (2) 2" x 36 ½" WOF strips.

• (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2" x 9 ½" strips.

From the Cross Stitch Texture - Cream (C), cut:

• (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the HSH-Cross Stitch Hearts - Black (D), cut:

• (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Small Applique Flowers - Cream (E), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Cross Stitch Texture - Black (F), cut:

(1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" squares.
(4) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Alphabet - Cream (G), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Alphabet - Black (H), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the HSH-Cross Stitch Hearts - Cream (I), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" squares. **From the Small Applique Flowers - Black (J), cut:** • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) 2 ¹/₂" squares.


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From the Small House Toss - Cream (Backing), cut: • (1) 52" x 28" WOF rectangle for the back.

Runner Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew together (3) 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangles end to end to make (1) 33 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 1).





2. Sew (1) 2" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle to make the 36 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Runner Center Block (Fig. 2).




3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (12) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a 2 x 6 matrix to make the Left Side Border.

4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (12) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a 2 x 6 matrix to make the Right Side Border.





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5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (44) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a 22 x 2 matrix to make the Top Border.

6. Follow Figure 6 and sew together (44) assorted $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a 22 x 2 matrix to make the Bottom Border.

Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 7 while assembling the runner top.)

7. Sew the Left Side and Right Side Borders to the left and right sides of the Runner Center Block. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the Runner Center Block to make the Runner top.


8. Layer and quilt as desired.

9. Sew the (4) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

10. Bind as desired.

Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Home Sweet Home Panel 24 Inch x 44 Inch - Cream (A):

• Fussy cut (6) 11 ¹/₂" x 9 ¹/₂" rectangles, centered on panel pieces.

From the Folio Basics - Gold (B), cut:

• (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 2" x 14 ¹/₂" strips.

• (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 2" x 9 ½" strips.

From the HSH-Cross Stitch Hearts - Black (C), cut:

• (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Cross Stitch Texture - Cream (D), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Alphabet - Cream (E), cut:

• (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Small Applique Flowers - Black (F), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Cross Stitch Texture - Black (G), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ¹/₂" squares. • (11) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the HSH-Cross Stitch Hearts - Cream (H), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Small Applique Flowers - Cream (I), cut: • (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Alphabet - Black (J), cut:

• (1) 2 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Folio Basics - Dark Green (K), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 2" x 14 ¹/₂" strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 2" x 9 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Small House Toss - Black (Backs), cut:


• (3) 22" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 22" x 16" rectangles for the backs.

Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

11. Sew (1) 2" x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 11 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 9 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) 14 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Three rectangle (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (3) Block One rectangles total.

12. Sew (1) 2" x 9 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of (1) 11 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 14 ½" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make (1) 14 ½" x 12 ½" Block One rectangle (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (3) Block Two rectangles total.



13. Follow Figure 10 and sew together (12) assorted 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares into a 2 x 6 matrix to make (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Three rectangle. Repeat to make (6) Block Three rectangles total.



Block Three

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Place Mat Assembly

(Follow the Place Mat Layouts in Figures 11-12 while assembling the place mat tops.)

14. Sew (1) Block Three rectangle to the right side of (1) Block One square to make (1) Place Mat #1 top (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (3) Place Mat #1 tops total.

15. Sew (1) Block Three rectangle to the right side of (1) Block Two square to make (1) Place Mat #2 top (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (3) Place Mat #2 tops total.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (11) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.


