### Runner Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Bunnies and Eggs - Pastel Pink (A), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 5 ½" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - Lilac (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3" squares.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 15 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 47 ½" strips.

#### From the Eggs on Grass - Green Grass (C), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5 ½" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - White on White (D), cut:

- (5) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (60) 3" squares.

#### From the Patchwork - Multi (E), cut:

- (2) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 5 ½" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - Peach (F), cut:

- (14) Template 1 triangles.

#### From the Folio Basics - Powder Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3" squares.
- (12) Template 1 triangles.

#### From the Folio Basics - Powder Pink (H), cut:

- (10) Template 1 triangles.

#### From the Plaid - Multi (I), cut:

- (2) 5" x 30" WOF strips.
- (3) 5" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5" x 60" strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Pink (J), cut:

- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Tossed Bunnies - Pastel Blue (Backing), cut:

- (1) 64" x 34" WOF strip for the backing.

### Runner Block Assembly

*Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.*

1. Place (1) 3" Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) 5 ½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 2).

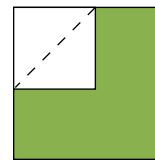

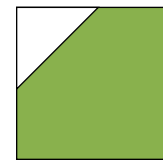

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a 3" Fabric D square to the upper right corner and 3" Fabric B squares to the lower left and lower right corners of the 5 ½" Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).

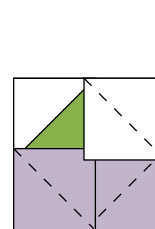

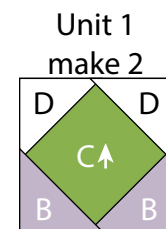

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make a second Unit 1 square.

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 5-12 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of each unit square for Unit 2 through Unit 9 squares.

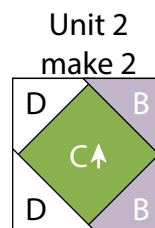

5. Sew (1) Unit 9 square to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row (Fig. 13).

6. Sew together (1) Unit 2 square, (1) 5 1/2" Fabric A square and (1) Unit 3 square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 13).

7. Sew (1) Unit 9 square to each side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the bottom row (Fig. 13).

8. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 5-7 lengthwise to make (1) 15 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 13).

9. Repeat Steps 5-8 to make a second Block One square.

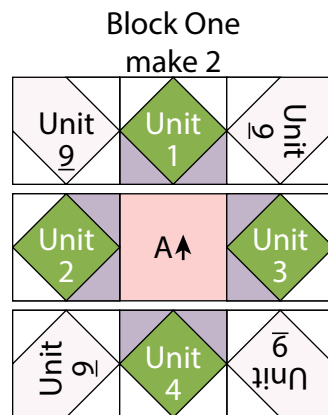

10. Repeat Steps 5-8 and refer to Figure 14 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (1) Block Two square.

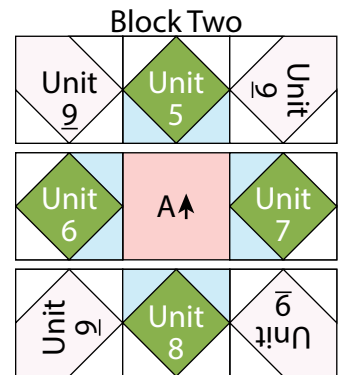

11. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of the Block Two square to make the 45 1/2" x 15 1/2" Runner Center Block (Fig. 15).

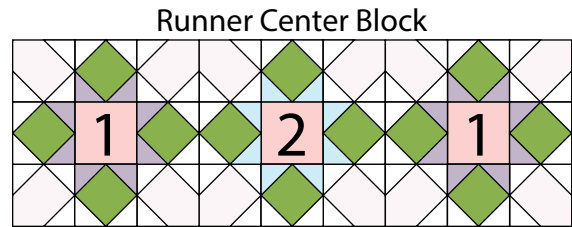

### Runner Assembly

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 19 while assembling the Runner top.)

12. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric B strip to each end of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 47 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block (Fig. 16 below).

13. Center (1) 5" x 30" Fabric I strip on (1) end of the Runner Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

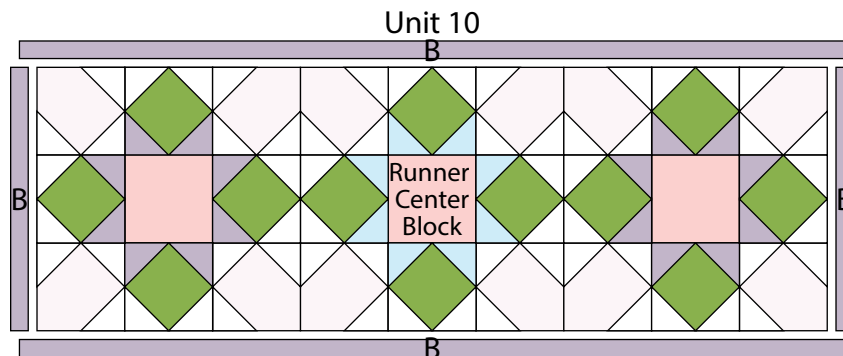

14. Repeat Step 13 to sew (1) 5" x 60" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Runner Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 17).

15. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 17), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Unit 11 rectangle (Fig. 18).

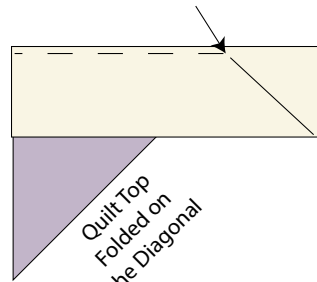

16. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.

17. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.

18. Refer to Figure 19 to arrange and press the (36) Fabric F, Fabric G and Fabric H triangles on the Fabric I strips of the Unit 11 rectangle.

19. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to make the Runner Top.

20. Layer and quilt as desired.

21. Sew the (5) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

22. Bind as desired.

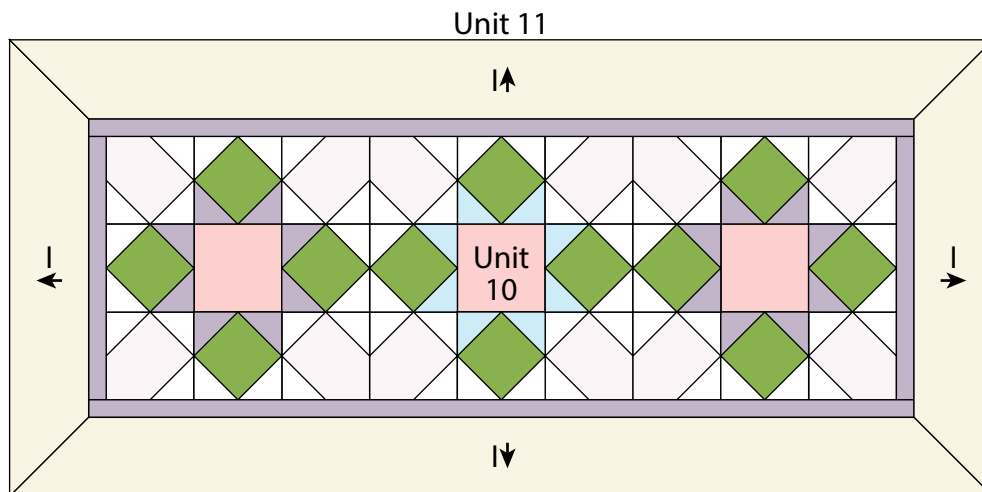

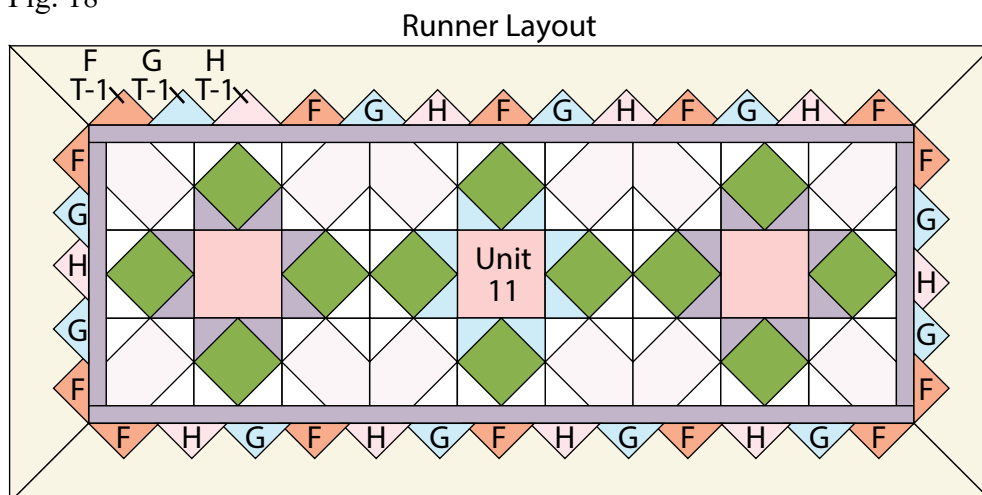

### Place Mat Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Bunnies and Eggs - Pastel Pink (A), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 ½" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - Lilac (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3" squares.

#### From the Eggs on Grass - Green Grass (C), cut:

- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 ½" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - White on White (D), cut:

- (6) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (80) 3" squares.

#### From the Patchwork - Multi (E), cut:

- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 ½" squares.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Pink (F), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 1 ½" x 15 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Folio Basics - Powder Blue (G), cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3" squares.

#### From the Small Stripe - Multi (H), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 2 ½" x 15 ½" strips.

#### From the Small Floral - Pastel Blue (Backings), cut:

- (2) 22" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 19" x 22" strips.

### Place Mat Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

23. Place (1) 3" Fabric D square on the top left corner of (1) 5 ½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 20). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 20). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 21).

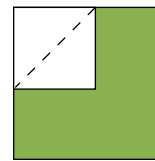

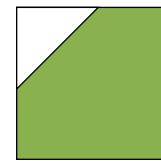

24. Follow Figure 22 for the seam direction to add a 3" Fabric D square to the upper right corner and 3" Fabric B squares to the lower left and lower right corners of the 5 ½" Fabric C square to make (1) Unit 12 square (Fig. 23).

25. Repeat Steps 23-24 to make a second Unit 12 square.

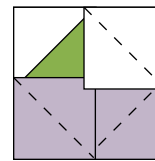

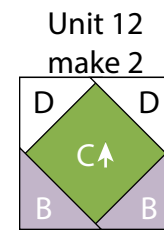

26. Repeat Steps 23-24 and refer to Figures 24-31 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make the indicated number of unit squares for Unit 13 through Unit 20.

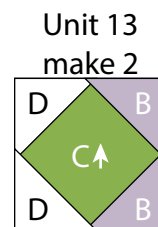

27. Sew (1) Unit 20 square to each side of (1) Unit 12 square to make the top row (Fig. 32).

28. Sew together (1) Unit 13 square, (1) 5 1/2" Fabric A square and (1) Unit 14 square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 32).

29. Sew (1) Unit 20 square to each side of (1) Unit 15 square to make the bottom row (Fig. 32).

30. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 27-29 lengthwise to make (1) 15 1/2" Block Three square (Fig. 32).

31. Repeat Steps 27-30 to make a second Block Three square.

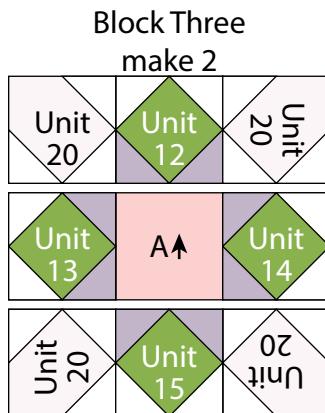

32. Repeat Steps 27-30 and refer to Figure 33 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Block Four squares.

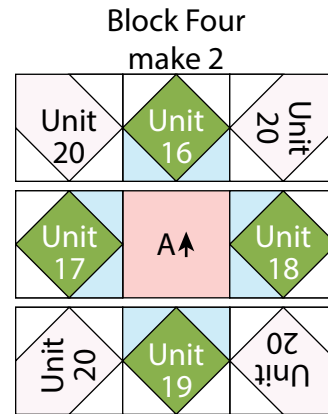

33. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric F strip to the right side of (1) Block Three square (Fig. 34). Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 15 1/2" Fabric H strip to the right side of the Fabric F strip to make (1) Place Mat #1 top (Fig. 34). Repeat to make a second Place Mat #1 top.

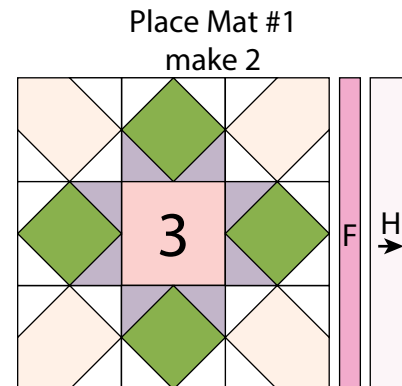

34. Repeat Step 33 and refer to Figure 35 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (2) Place Mat #2 tops.

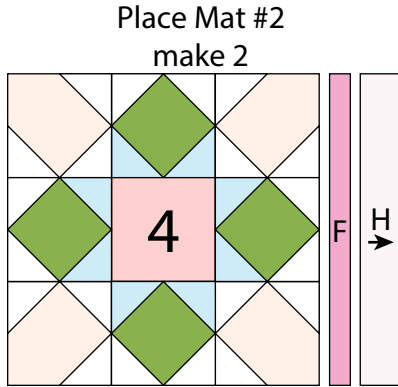


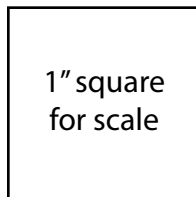

35. Layer and quilt as desired.

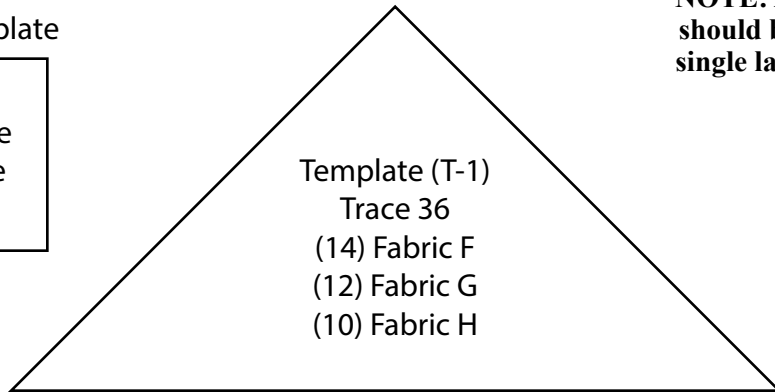
36. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

37. Bind as desired.
