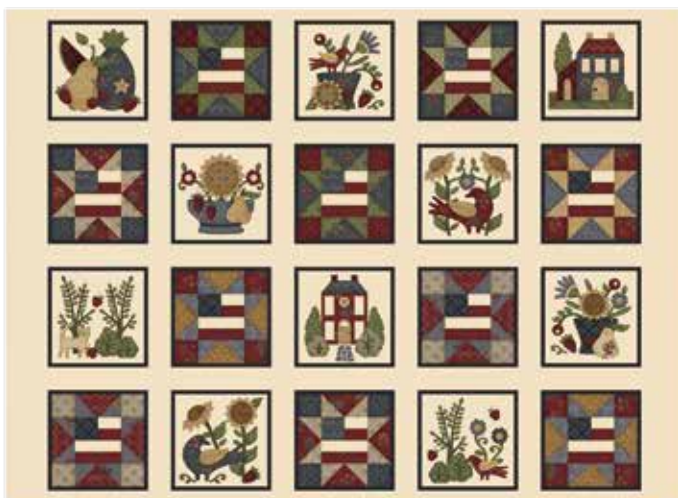

1 yard	Blocks 6.5 x 6.5 inches - Cream (D)	2923-33
3/4 yard	Whimsy Basic - Navy (E)	8945-78
3/8 yard	Tossed Bouquets - Blue (F)	2915-77
1/8 yard	Diamond Texture - Red (G)	2916-88
1/8 yard	Zig Zag Stripe - Blue (H)	2919-77
1/8 yard	Tossed Leaf Sprig - Green (I)	2917-66
1/8 yard	New Foulard - Rust (J)	2920-35

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the House on Summer Hill Panel 36 x 44 inches - Cream (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 35" square, centered on the panel.

From the Tossed Outline Flower - Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 35" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 39" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 3/4" x 59 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 3/4" x 62" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Leaf Sprig - Cream Rust (C), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 7/8" squares.
- (2) 2" x 37 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 56 1/2" strips
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 59 1/2" strips

From the Blocks 6.5 x 6.5 inches - Cream (D), fussy cut:

- (6) 7" squares, each centered on a scene.
- (6) 7" squares, each centered on a flag.

From the Whimsy Basic - Navy (E), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 7" strips.
- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 10" strips.

From the Tossed Bouquets - Blue (F), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Diamond Texture - Red (G), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Zig Zag Stripe - Blue (H), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Leaf Sprig - Green (I), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.

From the New Foulard - Rust (J), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Zig Zag Strip - Green (K), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Leaf Sprig - Red (L), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 7/8" squares.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Tossed Outline Flower - Gold (M), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Whimsy Basic - Oyster (N), cut:

- (2) 2 7/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 7/8" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Whimsy Basic - Light Blue (O), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 7/8" squares.

From the Zig Zag Stripe - Red (P), cut:

- (1) 2 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 7/8" squares.

From the Allover Large Novelty - Cream (Q), cut:

- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 62" strips.
- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 74" strips.

From the Tossed Bouquets - Dark Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 82" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 82" x 82" back.

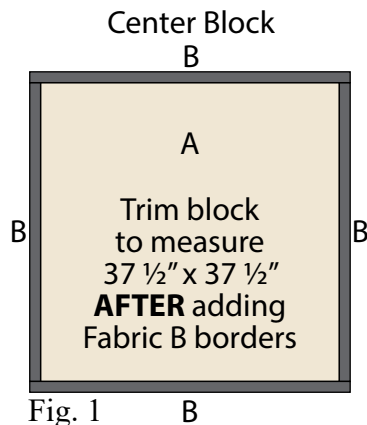
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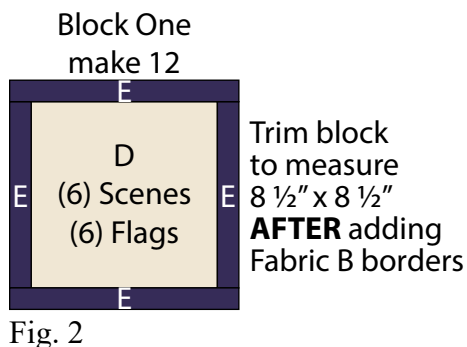
Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 35" Fabric B strip to each side of the 35" x 35" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 39" Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 37 ½" x 37 ½"**.



2. Sew (1) 2" x 7" Fabric E strip to each side (1) 7" Fabric D square (scene). Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 2). **Trim the block to measure 8 ½" x 8 ½"**. Repeat to make (12) Block One squares total: (6) with Scene squares and (6) with Flag squares.



3. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric H square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric N strip, right sides together (Fig. 3). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 3). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance (Fig. 4).

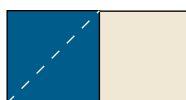

4. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric G square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric N strip, right sides together (Fig. 5). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 5). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 6).

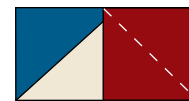

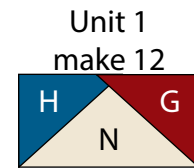

5. Repeat Steps 3-4 to make (12) Unit 1 strips total.

6. Repeat Steps 3-4 and refer to Figures 7-9 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (12) Unit 2 strips, (12) Unit 3 strips and (12) Unit 4 strips.

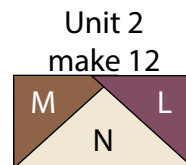

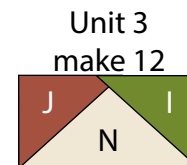

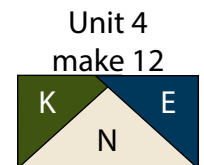

7. Place (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric N square on top of (1) 2 ⅞" Fabric O square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 10). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 10). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 11) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 ½" square to make (2) Unit 5 squares (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (12) Unit 5 squares total.

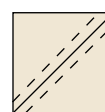

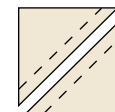

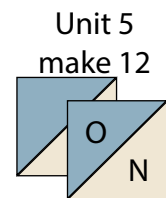

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figures 13-15 for fabric identification and placement to make (12) of each unit square for Unit 6 through Unit 8.

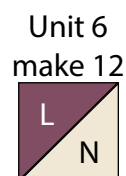

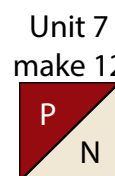

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9. Sew together (1) Unit 5 square, (1) Unit 1 strip and (1) Unit 6 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 16).

10. Sew together (1) Unit 2 strip, (1) 4 ½" Fabric F square and (1) Unit 3 strip, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 16).

11. Sew together (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Unit 4 strip and (1) Unit 8 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 16).

12. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 9-11 lengthwise to make (1) 8 ½" Block Two square (Fig. 16).

13. Repeat Steps 9-12 to make (12) Block Two squares total.

14. Sew together (3) Block Two squares and (2) Block One squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 17).

15. Repeat Step 14 and refer to Figure 18 for component identification and location to make the Right Side Border.

16. Sew together (4) Block One squares and (3) Block Two squares, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 19).

17. Repeat Step 16 and refer to Figure 20 for component identification and placement to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

18. Sew (1) 2" x 37 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 40 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

19. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

20. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and bottom of the Center Block.

21. Sew (1) 2" x 56 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 59 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

22. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 59 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 62" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

23. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 62" Fabric Q strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 74" Fabric Q strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

24. Layer and quilt as desired.

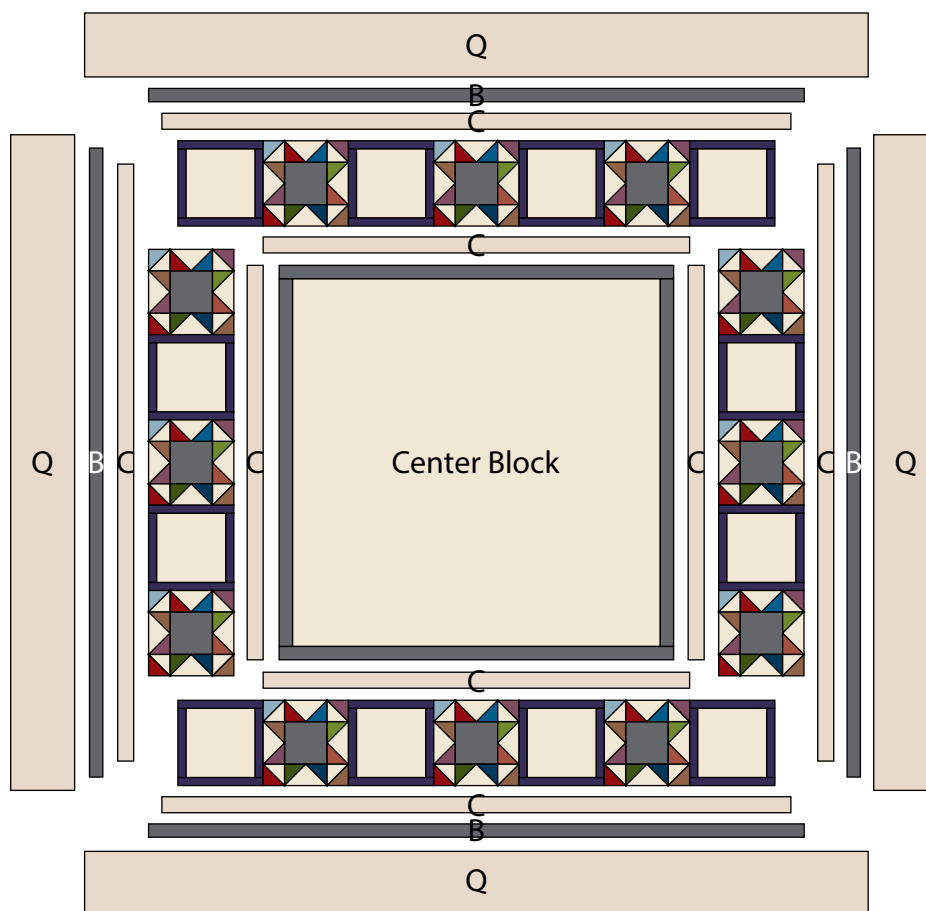
25. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

26. Bind as desired.
