## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Border Stripe - Cream (A), cut:

- (1) $421 / 2 " \times 281 / 2 "$ rectangle.

From the Zig Zag Stripe - Blue (B), cut:

- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " x 68 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2 " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 " $\times 571 / 2$ " strips.
- (2) $11 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.


## From the Tossed Bouquets - Dark Cream (C), cut:

- (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Allover Large Novelty - Cream (D), cut:
-(4) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 711 / 2 "$ strips.

- (4) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $61 / 2 " \times 691 / 2 "$ strips.
- (2) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) $41 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Whimsy Basic - Navy (E), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (112) $21 / 2 "$ squares.


## From the Tossed Leaf Sprig - Red (F), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Leaf Sprig - Cream Rust (G), cut: - (7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (112) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Bouquets - Blue (H), cut:
-(13) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (112) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Tossed Outline Flower - Gold (I), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 "$ x WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Tossed Leaf Sprig - Green (J), cut:

- (4) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (56) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Diamond Texture - Red (K), cut:

- (7) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (112) $21 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Diamond Texture - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) $91 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 77 " x 91 " back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 421 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to each side of the $281 / 2 " \times 421 / 2 "$ Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).

2. Place (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric E square on the left side of (1) $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 3).

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3. Place another $21 / 2$ " Fabric E square on the right side of the $21 / 2 " \times 41 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 5).
4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (56) Unit 1 strips total.

5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figures 6-7 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (56) Unit 2 squares and (56) Unit 3 squares.

6. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left end of (1) Unit 3 square, along the Fabric G ends to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (56) Unit 4 strips total.

7. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric I to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $81 / 2$ " Unit 5 square (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (14) Unit 5 squares total.

8. Sew (1) $21 / 2 "$ Fabric J square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 4 strip to each side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) $121 / 2 "$ Block One square (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (14) Block One squares total.

9. Sew together (4) $21 / 2 " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric C strips and (3) Block One squares, alternating them from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 11). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

10. Sew together (4) Block One squares and (3) $21 / 2$ " $\times 121 / 2$ " Fabric C strips, alternating them from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 12). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

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Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 11. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
12. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
13. Sew (1) $2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $2 " \times 571 / 2 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
14. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} " \times 71 \frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric $D$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 691 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
15. Layer and quilt as desired.
16. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
17. Bind as desired.


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
