## Cutting Instructions - Quilt

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Large Tossed Lemons - Multi (A), cut:

- (2) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Small Tossed Lemons - Blue (B), cut:

- (2) $41 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) $41 / 4$ " triangles.
- (2) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Small Tossed Lemon Flowers - Blue (C), cut:

- (2) $41 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) $41 / 4$ " triangles.
- (2) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Packed Lemons - Yellow (D), cut:

- (2) $41 / 4 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) $41 / 4$ " triangles.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (E), cut:

- (2) $41 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) $41 / 4$ " triangles.
- (4) $2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) $2 "$ squares.

From the Diagonal Plaid - Blue (F), cut:

- (2) $31 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $31 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Packed Sliced Lemons - Yellow (G), cut:

- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 301 / 2 "$ WOF strips.
- (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 321 / 2 / 2$ WOF strips.

From the Tossed Lemon Blossoms - Blue (H), cut:
-(2) $41 / 2 " \times 321 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

- (2) $41 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ WOF strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Grass Green (I), cut:
-(5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Just Lemons - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 48 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $48^{\prime \prime} \times 48^{\prime \prime}$ back.


## Block Assembly - Quilt <br> Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) $6 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 1). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 1). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 2).

2. Follow Figure 3 for the seam direction to add a $31 / 2$ " Fabric B square to the lower right corner and (2) $31 / 2$ " Fabric C squares to each of the remaining corners of the $6 \frac{1}{2}, "$ Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 4).
3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (9) Unit 1 squares total.

4. Repeat Steps $1-2$ with (16) $31 / 2$ " Fabric $F$ squares and (64) 2 " Fabric E squares to make (16) Unit 2 squares.

5. Sew (1) $4 \frac{1}{4} "$ Fabric C triangle to (1) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric D triangle along a short side as shown to make (1) CD triangle. Sew (1) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric E triangle to (1) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric B triangle along a short side as shown to make (1) EB triangle. Sew the CD triangle to the EB triangle along their long side to make (1) $31 / 2 "$ Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make

6. Sew together (2) Unit 3 squares along their Fabric D sides to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (12) Unit 4 strips total.

7. Sew together (4) Unit 4 strips and (3) Unit 1 squares, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 8 below). Repeat to make (3) Unit 5 strips total.
8. Sew together (2) Unit 3 squares along their Fabric D sides to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (12) Unit 6 strips total.

9. Sew together (4) Unit 2 squares and (3) Unit 6 strips, alternating them, to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 10 below). Repeat to make (4) Unit 7 strips total.

## Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew together (4) Unit 7 strips and (3) Unit 5 strips, alternating them, to make the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 "}{} \times 301 / 2 "$ Fabric $G$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 321 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
12. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 321 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $41 / 2 " \times 401 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
13. Layer and quilt as desired.
14. Sew the (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
15. Bind as desired.

- (1) $61 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $61 / 2 "$ squares.

From the Small Tossed Lemons - Blue (B), cut:

- (1) $41 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) $41 / 4$ " triangles.
- (1) $31 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $3^{1 / 2 "}$ squares.
- (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Small Tossed Lemon Flowers - Blue (C), cut:

- (1) $41 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) $41 / 4$ " triangles.
- (1) $31 / 2 " \mathrm{x}$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $31 / 2 "$ squares.
- (1) 2 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Packed Lemons - Yellow (D), cut:

- (1) $41 / 4 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) $41 / 4 "$ triangles.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (E), cut: - (1) $41 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) $41 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (16) $41 / 4$ " triangles.

- (4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2 " squares.

From the Diagonal Plaid - Blue (F), cut:
-(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Packed Sliced Lemons - Yellow (G), cut:
-(2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 " x $91 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) 1 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 " x $131 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Just Lemons - Multi (H), cut:
-(2) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $101 / 2$ " strips.
-(4) 2 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 2 " x $161 / 2 "$ strips.
From the Modern Melody Basics - Grass Green (I), cut:
-(7) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Large Tossed Lemons - Multi (Backing), cut: -(2) 17 " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (4) 17 " x $20 "$ strips.

## Assembly Instructions - Place Mat Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.

16. Place (1) $31 / 2 "$ Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) $6 \frac{112 "}{}$ Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 12). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 12). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle $1 / 4$ " away from the sewn seam (Fig. 13).

17. Follow Figure 14 for the seam direction to add a $31 / 2 "$ Fabric B square to the lower right corner and (2) $31 / 2$ " Fabric C squares to each of the remaining corners of the $61 / 2 "$ Fabric A square to make one Unit 8 square (Fig. 15).
18. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (4) Unit 8 squares.

19. Sew (1) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric C triangle to (1) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric D triangle along a short side as shown to make (1) CD triangle. Sew (1) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric E triangle to (1) $41 / 4 "$ Fabric B triangle along a short side as shown to make (1) EB triangle. Sew the CD triangle to the EB triangle along their long side to make (1) $31 / 2$ " Unit 9 square (Fig. 16).

Repeat to make (16) Unit 9 squares total.
20. Sew together (2) Unit 9 squares along their Fabric D sides to make (1) Unit 10 strip (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (8) Unit 10 strips total.

21. Place (1) $2 "$ Fabric E square on the left side of (1) $2 " \times 31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 18). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 18). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance (Fig. 19).

22. Place another 2" Fabric E square on the right side of the 2 " x $31 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, right sides together (Fig. 20). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 20). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $1 / 4$ " seam allowance to make (1) Unit 11 strip (Fig. 21).
23. Repeat Steps 21-22 to make (16) Unit 11 strips total.

29. Sew (1) $2 " \times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to each side of (1) Unit 17 rectangle. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric H strip to the top and bottom of the Unit 17 rectangle to make (1) Place Mat (Fig. 28). Repeat to make (4) Place Mats total.
30. Layer and quilt place mats as desired.
31. Sew the (7) $21 / 2>1 \times$ WOF Fabric I strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press. Cut the strip into (4) equal lengths.
32. Bind as desired.
