



1 yard	Quilter's Ruler - Light Blue (B)	494-71
1/3 yard	Stitch and Needle - Red (C)	488-82
1/2 yard	Packed Buttons - Multi (D)	490-78
1/4 yard	Large Sewing Accessories - Multi (E)	486-87
1/4 yard	Tossed Pins and Needles - Multi (F)	493-71
1/4 yard	Tossed Spools and Buttons - Multi (G)	489-38
1/4 yard	Tossed Iron - Multi (H)	492-89
1/2 yard	Tossed Scissors and Needles - Multi (I)	496-97
2/3 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Black (J)	1063-99*
3/4 yard	Tossed Thimble - White (K)	491-81
3/8 yard	Stitch and Needle - Blue (L)	488-77
3/8 yard	Set Square Buttons - Red (M)	495-89
3 1/4 yards	Tossed Sewing Accessories - Multi (Backing)	487-78

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 10" x 10" Blocks - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 10 1/2" squares, each centered on a block.

From the Quilter's Ruler - Light Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 7 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 7 1/4" squares and (4) 3" squares. Cut the 7 1/4" squares across both diagonals to make (24) 7 1/4" triangles.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 13" strips.

From the Stitch and Needle - Red (C), cut:

- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 11 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1" x 12 1/2" strips.

From the Packed Buttons - Multi (D), cut:

- (2) 7 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 7 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 7 1/4" triangles.

From the Large Sewing Accessories - Multi (E), cut:

- (1) 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 6 7/8" triangles.
- Note: You will only use (6) 6 7/8" of the triangles.*

From the Tossed Pins and Needles - Multi (F), cut:

- (1) 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (6) 6 7/8" triangles.

From the Tossed Spools and Buttons - Multi (G), cut:

- (1) 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (6) 6 7/8" triangles.

From the Tossed Iron - Multi (H), cut:

- (1) 6 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 6 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (6) 6 7/8" triangles.

From the Tossed Scissors and Needles - Multi (I), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (J), cut:

- (2) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 3/4" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tossed Thimble - White (K), cut:

- (7) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (46) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.
- (1) 1 3/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 3/4" squares.
- (1) 1 3/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 3/4" x 3" strips.

From the Stitch and Needle - Blue (L), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (23) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Set Square Buttons - Red (M), cut:

- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (23) 2 1/2" x 5 1/2" strips.

From the Tossed Sewing Accessories - Multi (Backing), cut:


- (2) 58" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 58" x 70" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 11 1/2" x 11 1/2".** Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) 1" x 11 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) 12 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



3. Sew (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric B triangle and (1) $7\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric D triangle together along short sides. Sew (1) $6\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric E triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 2 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.



4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 4-6 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Unit 3 squares, (6) Unit 4 squares and (6) Unit 5 squares.







5. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) Unit 3 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to the left side of (1) Unit 5 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 ½" Block Two square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



6. Place (1) 1 $\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric K square on the left side of (1) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric J strip, right sides together (Fig. 8). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 8). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance (Fig. 9).

7. Place another 1 ¾" Fabric K square on the right side of the 1 ¾" x 5 ½" Fabric J strip, right sides together (Fig. 10). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 10). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a ¼" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 6 strip (Fig. 11).

8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (8) Unit 6 strips total.



9. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 3" Fabric K strip to each side of (1) 3" Fabric B square. Sew (1) Unit 6 strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn block to make (1) 5 ½" Block Three square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (4) Block Three squares total.



10. Follow Figure 13 and sew together (26) assorted 2 ½" x 5 ½" strips lengthwise to make the Left Side Border.

11. Follow Figure 14 and sew together (26) assorted 2 ½" x 5 ½" strips lengthwise to make the Right Side Border.

12. Follow Figure 15 and sew together (20) assorted 2 ½" x 5 ½" strips lengthwise. Sew (1) Block Three square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border.



13. Follow Figure 16 and sew together (20) assorted 2 ½" x 5 ½" strips lengthwise. Sew (1) Block Three square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border.



14. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 17). Repeat to make Row Three.

15. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 17). Repeat to make Row Four.

16. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 14-15, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 36 ½" x 48 ½" Center Block (Fig. 17).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

17. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


18. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

19. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

20. Layer and quilt as desired.

21. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric J strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

22. Bind as desired.
