Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Main Bird and Floral - Cream (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 16 ½" square, centered on a bird.

From the Serpentine Ribbons - Light Teal (B):

• Fussy cut (4) 1 ½" x 22" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on a ribbon.

From the Fan Floral - Caramel (C), cut:

- (4) 4 ½" x 70" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric cut (36) 6 ½" squares.

From the Bouquets & Diamonds - Cream (D), cut:

- (6) 2 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (72) 2 1/8" squares.
- (9) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (144) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips.

From each of the (12) (E) fabrics, cut:

- (6) 2 %" squares
- (3) 2 ½" squares.
- (12) 1 ½" x 2 ½" strips.

From the Serpentine Ribbon - Caramel (F), cut:

- (7) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.
- (4) 2 ½" x 62" LOF strips, each centered on a ribbon.


From the Fan Floral - Caramel (Backing), cut:

• (2) 74" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 74" back.


Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- 1. Center (1) 1 ½" x 22" Fabric B strip on (1) side of the 16 ½" x 16 ½" Fabric A square and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 2. Repeat Step 1 to sew (1) 1 ½" x 22" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 1).



3. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 1), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ½" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the Center Block (Fig. 2).




LILLE (Quilt 2)


4. Place (1) 2 %" Fabric E square on top of (1) 2 %" Fabric D square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 3). Sew ¼" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 4) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 ½" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (36) sets of (4) Unit 1 squares.









5. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) 1 ½" x 2 ½" Fabric E strip lengthwise to make (1) 2 ½" Unit 2 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (36) sets of (4) squares total.



6. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to each side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric E square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Block One square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (36) Block One squares total.



7. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square to each side of (1) Block 1 square to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Side Border.



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8. Follow Figure 9 and sew together (14) 6 ½" Fabric C squares and (13) Block 1 squares into a 3 x 9 matrix to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.


Top/Bottom Border make 2 C TO C TO C Fig. 9

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)
9. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.

- 10. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Repeat Steps 1-3 and refer to the quilt layout for fabric identification, placement and orientation while using (4) 2 ½" x 62" Fabric F strips to make the Inner Border.
- 12. Repeat Steps 1-3 and refer to the quilt layout for fabric identification, placement and orientation while using (4) 4 ½" x 70" Fabric C strips to make the Outer Border and finish the quilt top.
- 13. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 14. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 15. Bind as desired.





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
