

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Moon Garden Panel - Black/Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 42 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

#### From the Folio Basics - Grape (B), cut:

- (6) 3 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 3 ½" squares.
- (2) 2 ½" x 42 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 ½" x 26 ½" WOF strips.

#### From the Moonflowers - Black/Multi (C), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 45 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (8) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Twinkle - Aqua (D), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 45 ½" strips.
- (2) 2" x 36 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Fairies and Fireflies - Black (E), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 63 ½" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 ½" x 63 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed, and (8) 6 ½" squares.

#### From the Mushrooms - Blue/Black (F), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Fuchsia (G), cut:

• (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" squares.

#### From the Folio Basics - Powder Blue (H), cut:

- (6) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" squares.

#### From the Moon Garden Icons - Black/Multi (I), cut:

• (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 3 ½" squares.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Pink (J), cut:

• (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (64) 2" squares.

#### From the Moths and Moons - Purple (Backing), cut:

• (2) 71" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 83" back.

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 42 ½" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 26 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). Trim the block to measure 25 ½" x 45 ½".



2. Place (1) 3 ½" Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) 6 ½" Fabric C square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).








- 3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 3 ½" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 6 ½" Fabric C square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (8) Block One squares total.
- 5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (8) Block Two squares.









6. Place (1) 2" Fabric G square on the left side of (1) 2" x 3 ½" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance (Fig. 8).







- 7. Place another 2" Fabric G square on the right side of the 2" x 3 ½" Fabric H strip, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 1 strip (Fig. 10).
- 8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (32) Unit 1 strips total.
- 9. Repeat Steps 6-7 and refer to Figure 11 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (32) Unit 2 strips.








10. Sew (1) 2" Fabric H square to each end of (1) Unit 1 strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 1 strip to each side of (1) 3 ½" Fabric F square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 6 ½" Block Three square (Fig. 12). Repeat to make (8) Block Three squares total.



11. Repeat Step 10 and refer to Figure 13 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (8) Block Four squares.



- 12. Sew together (1) Block Three square, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Four square, (2) Block Two squares, (1) Block Four square, (1) Block One square and (1) Block Three square, in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 14). Repeat to make a second Side Border.
- 13. Sew together (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Three square, (1) Block One square, (2) Block Four squares, (1) Block One square, (1) Block Three square and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 15). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.



**Quilt Top Assembly** 

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 14. (1) 4 ½" x 45 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.

- 15. Sew (1) 2" x 45 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 36 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 16. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
- 17. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 18. Sew (1) 2" x 60 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 51 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 19. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 63 ½" LOF Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 20. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 63 ½" WOF Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 21. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 22. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 23. Bind as desired.
