

½ yard	Moths and Moons - Purple (B)	787G-55
²⁄₃ yard	Fairies and Fireflies - Black (C)	788G-99
1 1/4 yards	Twinkle - Royal Blue (D)	135-77
1 1/4 yards	Folio Basics - Powder Blue (E)	7755-07
½ yard	Twinkle - Aqua (F)	135-11
1/4 yard	Twinkle - Violet (G)	135-55
5∕8 yard	Moon Garden Florals - Purple (H)	791G-55
½ yard	Fireflies - Black (I)	789G-99
⅓ yard	Mushrooms - Black/Fuchsia (J)	790G-95
1/4 yard	Moon Garden Icons - Black/Multi (K)	792G-95
2 ½ yards	Moonflower Stripe - Black/Multi (L)	793G-95
5 yards	Mushrooms - Blue/Black (Backing)	790G-19

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Moonflowers - Black/Multi (A), cut:

• (2) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 8 ½" squares.

From the Moths and Moons - Purple (B), cut:

• (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 ½" squares.

From the Fairies and Fireflies - Black (C), cut:

• (2) 9 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 9 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 9 ½" triangles.

From the Twinkle - Royal Blue (D), cut:

- (7) 2 %" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2 %" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (192) 2 %" triangles.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Folio Basics - Powder Blue (E), cut:

- (4) 2 %" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 2 %" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (96) 2 %" triangles.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (96) 2 ½" squares.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 64 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 51 ½" strips.

From the Twinkle - Aqua (F), cut:

• (3) 4 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 1/8" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (48) 4 1/8" triangles.

From the Twinkle - Violet (G), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ½" squares.

From the Moon Garden Florals - Purple (H), cut:

• (2) 8 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 8 ½" squares.

From the Fireflies - Black (I), cut:

• (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 4 ½" squares.

From the Mushrooms - Black/Fuchsia (J), cut:

• (6) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Use the Template 1 (T-1) to cut (24) Unit 1 triangles from the Fabric J strips (Fig. 1).



From the Moon Garden Icons - Black/Multi (K), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 ½" squares.

From the Moonflower Stripe - Black/Multi (L), cut:

- (2) 6 ½" x 83" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6 ½" x 67" LOF strips.

From the Mushrooms - Blue/Black (Backing), cut:

• (2) 87" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 71" x 87" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) 4 ½" Fabric B square on the top left corner of (1) 8 ½" Fabric A square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle ¼" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).







2. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 4 ½" Fabric B square to each of the remaining corners of the 8 ½" Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 5).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.

4. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement and seam direction to make (6) Unit 3 squares.




5. Sew (2) 2 1/8" Fabric E triangles to adjacent sides of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric G square. Sew (1) 4 1/8" Fabric F triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 4 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (24) Unit 4 squares total.




6. Repeat Step 5 and refer to Figure 8 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (24) Unit 5 squares.




7. Follow Figure 9 and sew together (2) 2 ½" Fabric E squares, (4) 2 ½" Fabric D triangles and (1) 9 ½" Fabric C triangle to make (1) 4 ½" x 8 ½" Unit 6 rectangle. Repeat to make (24) Unit 6 rectangles total.



8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figure 10 for unit and fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (24) Unit 7 rectangles.



9. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each end of (1) Unit 6 rectangle to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 6 rectangle to each side of (1) Unit 2 square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 16 ½" Block One square (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figure 12 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.




- 11. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 13). Repeat to make Row Three.
- 12. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 13). Repeat to make Row Four.
- 13. Sew together the (4) Rows from Steps 11-12, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 48 ½" x 64 ½" Center Block (Fig. 13).




Quilt Top Assembly


(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 14. Sew (1) 2" x 64 ½" Fabric E strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 51 ½" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 15. Center (1) 6 ½" x 83" Fabric L strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ½" from the top edge of the block and stop a ½" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
- 16. Repeat Step 15 to sew (1) 6 ½" x 67" Fabric L strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 14).

17. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 14), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ½" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.



- 18. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 19. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric D strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 20. Bind as desired.
