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

## **Runner Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the Border Stripe - Black/Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 29" x 11" Length of Fabric (LOF) strip, centered on stripes.

## From the Modern Melody Basics - Hunter (B), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2" squares.
- (1) 1 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 1/4" x 11" strips.
- (2) 1 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" x 30 <sup>1</sup>/<sub>2</sub>" WOF strips.

## From the Confetti - White/Multi (C), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 56 ½" strips.

## From the Argyle - Multi (D), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" squares.

## From the Tossed Beads - Black/Multi (E), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles.

## From the Modern Melody Basics - Purple (F), cut:

- (1) 2 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 3/8" squares and (8) 2"
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

## From the Modern Melody Basics - Marigold (G), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 3/8" squares
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2" squares.

## From the Tossed Masks - Black/Multi (H), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 4 ½" x 14 ½" strips.
- (4) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 64 ½" strips.


## From the Tossed Feathers - Black/Multi (Backing), cut:

• (1) 72" x 30" WOF strip for the backing.

## **Runner Block Assembly**

*Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction.* Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 11" Fabric B strip to each end of the 29" x 11" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 1 1/4" x 30 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the 30 ½" x 12 ½" Block One rectangle (Fig. 1).



2. Place (1) 2 3/8" Fabric G square on top of (1) 2 3/8" Fabric F square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2" square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (16) Unit 1 squares total.



3. Sew (1) 2" Fabric F square to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) 2" Fabric B square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) Unit 3 ½" Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (8) Unit 2 squares total.



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4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric G stirp to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square lengthwise. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric G strip to the top of the Unit 2 square to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 3 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (8) Unit 3 squares total.









5. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 3 square, right sides together (Fig. 7). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 7). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (8) Unit 4 squares total.






- 6. Place (1) 2" Fabric G square on the bottom left corner of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric E rectangle, right sides together (Fig. 9). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 9). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 10).
- 7. Follow Figure 11 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric G square to the upper right corner of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric E rectangle to make (1) Unit 5 rectangle (Fig. 12).
- 8. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (8) Unit 5 rectangles total.










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9. Repeat Steps 6-7 and refer to Figure 13 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (8) Unit 6 rectangles.



10. Sew (1) Unit 5 rectangle to the left side of (1) Unit 6 rectangle lengthwise to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 7 square (Fig. 14). Repeat to make (8) Unit 7 squares total.



11. Sew (1) Unit 4 square to each side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) Unit 7 square to each side of (1) 4 ½" Fabric D square to make the middle row. Sew together the (3) rows lengthwise to make (1) 12 1/2" Block Two square (Fig. 15). Repeat to make a second Block Two square.


12. Sew (1) Block Two square to each end of (1) Block One rectangle to make the 54 ½" x 12 ½" Runner Center Block (Fig. 16 below).

## **Runner Assembly**

(Follow the Runner Layout in Figure 17 below while assembling the runner top.)

- 13. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric C strip to each end of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 56 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $14\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to each end of the Runner Center Block. Sew (1)  $4\frac{1}{2}$ " x  $64\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Runner Center Block to make the runner top.

- 15. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 16. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 17. Bind as desired.





## **Place Mat Cutting Instructions**

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

## From the 6 Blocks 10" x 10" - Black/Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (6) 11 ½" squares, each centered on a block.

## From the Confetti - White/Multi (B), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 11 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 13 ½" strips.

## From the Tossed Beads - Black/Multi (C), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" x 4 ½" rectangles.

## From the Modern Melody Basics - Marigold (D), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 3/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 3/8" squares
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 3 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.

## From the Modern Melody Basics - Hunter (E), cut:

- (1) 2 3/8 " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 3/8" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.

### From the Modern Melody Basics - Purple (F), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2" squares.
- (10) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.


## From the Tossed Feathers - Black/Multi (Backs), cut:

• (3) 16" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 16" x 20" rectangles for the backings.

### **Place Mat Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

18. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 11 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 11 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 13 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 12 ½" x 12 ½" to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 18). Repeat to make (6) Block Three squares total.



19. Place (1) 2 3/8" Fabric D square on top of (1) 2 3/8" Fabric E square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 19). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 19). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 20) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2" square to make (2) Unit 8 squares (Fig. 21). Repeat to make (24) Unit 8 squares total.









20. Sew (1) Unit 8 square to the left side of (1) 2" Fabric E square to make the top row. Sew (1) 2" Fabric F square to the left side of (1) Unit 8 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 3 ½" Unit 9 square (Fig. 22). Repeat to make (12) Unit 9 squares total.


21. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 3 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) Unit 9 square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric D strip to the right side of the Unit 9 square to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 10 square (Fig. 23). Repeat to make (12) Unit 10 squares total.



22. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square on the top right corner of (1) Unit 10 square, right sides together (Fig. 24). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 24). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>" away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 11 square

(Fig. 25). Repeat to make (12) Unit 11 squares total.








23. Place (1) 2" Fabric D square on the bottom left corner of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C rectangle, right sides together (Fig.26). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 26). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 27).

24. Follow Figure 28 for the seam direction to add a 2 ½" Fabric D square to the upper right corner of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C rectangle to make (1) Unit 12 rectangle (Fig. 29).

25. Repeat Steps 6-7 to make (6) Unit 12 rectangles total.










- 26. Repeat Steps 23-24 and refer to Figure 30 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (6) Unit 13 rectangles.
- 27. Sew (1) Unit 12 rectangle to the left side of (1) Unit 13 rectangle lengthwise to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 14 square (Fig. 31). Repeat to make (6) Unit 14 squares total.

28. Sew (1) Unit 11 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 14 square to make **Block Four** (1) 4 ½" x 12 ½" Block Four rectangle

(Fig. 32). Repeat to make (6) Block Four rectangles total.






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29. Sew (1) Block Four strip to the right side of (1) Block Three square to make (1) Place Mat top (Fig. 33). Repeat to make (6) Place Mat tops total.

## Place Mat Layout



- 30. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 31. Sew the (10) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Cut the strip into (6) equal lengths. Fold each strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 32. Bind as desired.

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
