





2/3 yard	10" Blocks Winter Scenes - Red/Gray (A)	F9221-89
5/8 yard	Snowflake on Texture - Red (B)	F9225-88
1/4 yard	Winter Scene with Animals - Gray/Red (C)	F9224-89
1/3 yard	Swirl - Red (D)	F9222-88
1/4 yard	Snowflake on Texture - Gray (E)	F9225-90
2/3 yard	Swirl - Gray (F)	F9222-90*
1/2 yard	Swirl - White (G)	F9222-9
1/2 yard	Bias Plaid - Red/White (H)	F9228-8
1 1/2 yards	Graphic Motifs - Red (I)	F9226-88
4 yards	Graphic Motifs - White (Backing)	F9226-8

Cutting Instructions

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the 10" Blocks Winter Scenes - Red/Gray (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 9 1/2" squares each centered on a block.

From the Snowflake on Texture - Red (B), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" strips.
- (4) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" strips.

From the Winter Scene with Animals - Gray/Red (C), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Swirl - Red (D), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.

From the Snowflake on Texture - Gray (E), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" squares.

From the Swirl - Gray (F), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" squares.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Swirl - White (G), cut:

- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" strips.

From the Bias Plaid - Red/White (H), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Graphic Motifs - Red (I), cut:

- (2) 6 1/2" x 52 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 6 1/2" x 52 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Graphic Motifs - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 72" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 60" x 72" back.

Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 9 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 9 1/2" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 13 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. **Trim the block to measure 12 1/2" square** to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



2. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric E square to each end of (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric C square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.



3. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric F square to each end of (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip to make the top row. Repeat to make the bottom row. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 8 1/2" Fabric G strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square to make the middle row. Sew the (3) rows together lengthwise to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (6) Block Two squares total.



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Quilt 1

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

4. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three.

5. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.

6. Sew the (4) rows together in numerical order to make the Center Block.


7. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

8. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric I LOF strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 52 ½" Fabric I WOF strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

9. Layer and quilt as desired.

10. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric F strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

11. Bind as desired.
