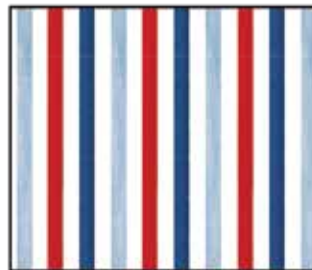

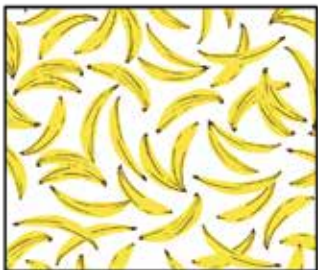

Materials

1 panel	Monkey Panel - Multi (A)	9318P-87
1 yard	Stripe - Multi (B)	9314-127*
½ yard	Stars - Navy (C)	9313-77
⅜ yard	Stars - Yellow (D)	9313-44
⅞ yard	Stacked Monkey Faces - Multi (E)	9315-81
¼ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Wine (F)	1063-89
2 ¾ yards	Tossed Monkeys - Red (Backing)	9317-88

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.

From the Monkey Panel - Multi (A), fussy cut:

- (1) 20 ½" x 25" rectangle, centered on the large panel.
- (4) 6" x 7" rectangles, each centered on a small panel.

From the Stripe - Multi (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 25" WOF strips.
- (2) 3" x 25 ½" WOF strips.
- (5) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Stars - Navy (C), cut:

- (4) 1 ¾" x 24 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ¼" x 28 ½" WOF strips.

From the Stars - Yellow (D), cut:

- (4) 1 ¼" x 28 ½" WOF strips.
- (4) 1 ¼" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

From the Stacked Monkey Faces - Multi (E), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 28 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 ½" x 24 ½" WOF strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Wine (F), cut:

- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 8 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1 ½" x 7" strips.

From the Tossed Monkeys - Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 46" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 46" x 52" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 3" x 25" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 20 ½" x 25" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 3" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the Center Block to measure 24 ½" x 28 ½"**.

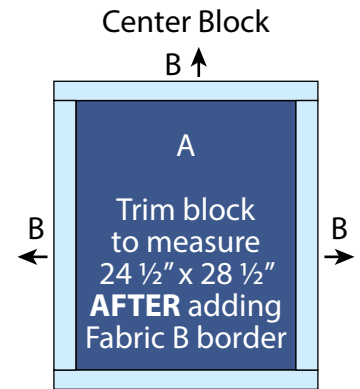

2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 7" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 6" x 7" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the 6" x 7" Fabric A panel to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 2). **Trim the block to measure 7 ½" x 8 ½"**. Repeat to make (4) Block One rectangles total.

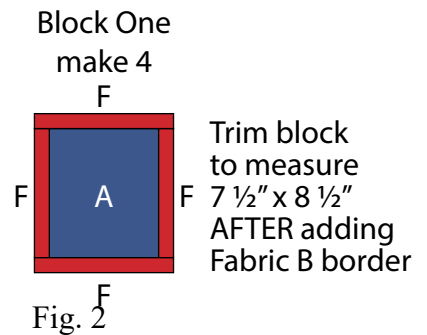

3. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 28 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 4 ½" x 28 ½" Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 28 ½" Fabric C strip to each Fabric D strip to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

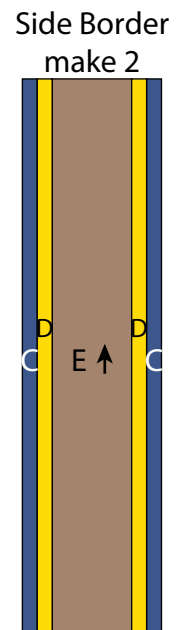

4. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 24 ½" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 4 ½" x 24 ½" Fabric E strip. Sew (1) 1 ¾" x 24 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the newly sewn strip. Sew (1) Block One rectangle to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

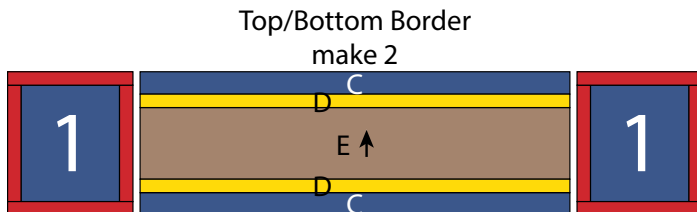
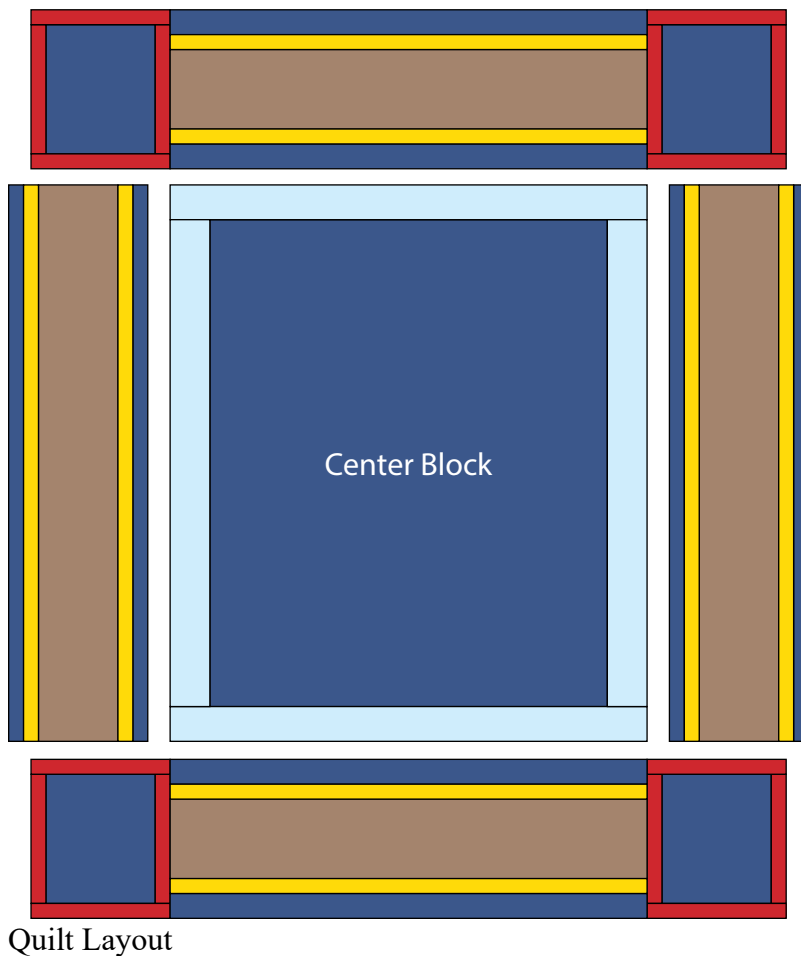

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

5. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
6. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
7. Layer and quilt as desired.
8. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
9. Bind as desired.



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
