Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Packed Monsters Glow - Multi (A), cut:

• (2) 7" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) 7" squares.

From the Twinkle Basics - Orange (B), cut:

(5) 1 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ¹/₄" x 7" strips.
(8) 1 ¹/₄" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ¹/₄" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Tossed Monsters & Footsteps Glow - Red (C), cut:

(1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 7" squares.
(1) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ¹/₂" squares.

From the Monsters & Stars Glow - Black (D), cut:

• (4) 4 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (15) 4 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Twinkle Basics - Black (E), cut:

- (6) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" strips.
- (1) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 1 ¹/₂" x 8" strips.
- (7) 1 ¹/₂" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (6) 1 ¹/₂" x 46 ¹/₂" strips.
- (6) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Monster Boxes Glow - Multi (F), cut:

• (3) 8" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 8" x 44 ¹/₂" strips.

From the Eyes Glow - Aqua (G), cut:

- (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 57 ¹/₂" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 ¹/₂" x 46 ¹/₂" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Splat Glow - Black (Backing), cut:


• (2) 62" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 62" x 73" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


1. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₄" x 7" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₄" x 8 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) 8 ¹/₂" Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (9) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₄" x 7" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₄" x 8 ¹/₂" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) 8 ¹/₂" Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 2 squares total.




3. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the top of (1) 4 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" Fabric D strip to make (1) 8 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Unit 3 rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (9) Unit 3 rectangles total.

4. Sew (1) 4 ¹/₂" x 8 ¹/₂" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) Unit 2 square to make (1) 8 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Unit 4 rectangle (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (6) Unit rectangles total.




5. Sew together (1) Unit 3 rectangle, (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric E strip, (1) Unit 4 rectangle, (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric E strip, (1) Unit 3 rectangle, (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric E strip, (1) Unit 4 rectangle, (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric E strip and (1) Unit 3 rectangle, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (3) Unit 5 strips total.



6. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 12 ¹/₂" Fabric E strip to each end of (1) Unit 5 strip. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 46 ¹/₂" Fabric E strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 5 strip to make (1) 46 ¹/₂" x 14 ¹/₂" Block One strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (3) Block One strips total.



7. Sew (1) 1 ¹/₂" x 8" Fabric E strip to each end of (1) 8" x 44 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip to make (1) 46 ¹/₂" x 8" Block Two strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Block Two strip.



8. Sew together (1) Block One strip, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One strip, (1) Block One strip, and (1) Block One strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the $46 \frac{1}{2}$ " x 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 8).



Quilt Top Assembly


(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 9. Sew (1) $4^{\frac{1}{2}}$ x 57 $\frac{1}{2}$ Fabric G strip to each side of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square to each end of (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 46 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric G strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

11. Layer and quilt as desired.

12. Sew the (6) $2\frac{1}{2}$ x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

13. Bind as desired.
