# MOONBEAMS AND RAINBOWS 

## Materials

1 panel 36 Inch Soft Book Panel - Cyan (A) 382P-17
$13 / 8$ yards Small Floral - Soft Blue (B) 377-11
$1 \frac{1}{4}$ yards Twinkle Star - Butter (C) 371-44*
$1 / 4$ yard Tree - Soft Blue (D)
373-11
$1 / 4$ yard Modern Melody Basics - Teal (E) 1063-61
$1 / 4$ yard Modern Melody Basics - Pink (F) 1063-22
$1 / 4$ yard Tossed Allover Bird - Cyan (G) 374-17
$3 / 4$ yard $\quad$ Rainbow Stripe - Multi (H) 372-54
$11 / 2$ yards Border Stripe - Cyan (I) 379-17
$3 / 8$ yard Flying Bird Allover - Soft Purple (J) 376-5
$15 / 8$ yards Tossed Unicorn and Rainbow - Cyan (K) 375-17
5 yards Patchwork - White (Backing) 380-1
*Includes binding

## Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 36 Inch Soft Book Panel - Cyan (A):

- Fussy cut (12) $73 / 4$ " squares, each centered on a panel.

From the Small Floral - Soft Blue (B), cut:

- (2) $51 / 4 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) $5 \frac{1}{4}$ " triangles.
- (5) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 " \times 73 / 4 "$ strips.
- (8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $21 / 2 "$ x $113 / 4$ " strips.

From the Twinkle Star - Butter (C), cut:

- (6) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $11 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 10 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime}$ strips.
-(8) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " x $121 / 2 "$ strips.
-(8) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF strips for the binding.
From the Tree - Soft Blue (D), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (E), cut:
-(1) $51 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) $51 / 4$ " triangles.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pink (F), cut:

- (1) $51 / 4 " \times$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $51 / 4 "$ squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) $51 / 4 "$ triangles.

From the Tossed Allover Bird - Cyan (G), cut:
-(1) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) $41 / 2 "$ squares.
From the Rainbow Stripe - Multi (H), cut:

- (3) $11 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ strips.
- (4) $11 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $11 / 2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ strips.
-(3) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end
with diagonal seams and cut (2) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 541 / 2 "$ strips.
- (5) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1 " $\times 521 / 2 "$ strips.

From the Border Stripe - Cyan (I):

- Fussy cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2} / 2 \times 521 / 2 "$ Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on a stripe.

From the Flying Bird Allover - Soft Purple (J), cut:

- (2) $41 / 2 " x$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (1) $41 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ strip.

From the Tossed Unicorn and Rainbow - Cyan (K), cut:
-(4) $61 / 2 " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 701 / 2 "$ strips.

- (4) $6 \frac{1}{2} " \times$ WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) $6 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 66 \frac{1}{2} \gg$ strips.

From the Patchwork - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) 90 " x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the $74 " \times 90 "$ back.


## Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4$ "seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 73 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $73 / 4$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $21 / 2 " \times 113 / 4 "$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Trim the unit to measure
$101 / 2 " \times 101 / 2 "$. Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.
2. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2}$ " $\times 10 \frac{1}{2} "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 121 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Unit 2 squares total.


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3. Sew (1) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric F triangle and (1) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric B triangle together along short sides to make (1) FB triangle. Sew (1) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric B triangle and (1) $51 / 4 "$ Fabric E triangle together along short sides to make (1) BE triangle. Sew together the FB and BE triangles along their long sides to make (1) $41 / 2 "$ Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (32) Unit 3 squares total.

4. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (8) Unit 4 strips total.
5. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) $41 / 2 "$ Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (8) Unit 5 strips total.

6. Sew together (1) Unit 4 strip, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 5 strip, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 5 strip, (1) Unit 2 square and (1) Unit 4 strip, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Block One strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block One strips total.

7. Sew (1) $1 " \times 521 / 2$ " Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $61 / 2^{\prime \prime} \times 521 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric I strip to make (1) $71 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Block Two strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Block Two strip.

8. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) $41 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to make (1) $61 / 2 " \times 521 / 2 "$ Block Three strip (Fig. 8).

9. Sew together (1) Block One strip, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One strip, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One strip, (1) Block Two strip and (1) Block One strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the $521 / 2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 9).

Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 10. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 681 / 2 "$ Fabric $H$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 541 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) $61 / 2 " \times 701 / 2 "$ Fabric $K$ strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $61 / 2 "$ x $661 / 2 "$ Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (8) $21 / 2 " \times$ WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.


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
