# MOONBEAMS AND RAINBOWS

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### Materials

1 panel	36 Inch Soft Book Panel - Cyan (A)	382P-17
1 3/8 yards	Small Floral - Soft Blue (B)	377-11
1 1/4 yards	Twinkle Star - Butter (C)	371-44*
1/4 yard	Tree - Soft Blue (D)	373-11
1/4 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Teal (E)	1063-61
1/4 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Pink (F)	1063-22
1/4 yard	Tossed Allover Bird - Cyan (G)	374-17
3/4 yard	Rainbow Stripe - Multi (H)	372-54
1 1/2 yards	Border Stripe - Cyan (I)	379-17
3/8 yard	Flying Bird Allover - Soft Purple (J)	376-5
1 5/8 yards	Tossed Unicorn and Rainbow - Cyan (K)	375-17
5 yards	Patchwork - White (Backing)	380-1

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the 36 Inch Soft Book Panel - Cyan (A):

- Fussy cut (12) 7 3/4" squares, each centered on a panel.

#### From the Small Floral - Soft Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 5 1/4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (64) 5 1/4" triangles.
- (5) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" x 7 3/4" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2 1/2" x 11 3/4" strips.

#### From the Twinkle Star - Butter (C), cut:

- (6) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" strips.
- (8) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" strips.
- (8) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Tree - Soft Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Teal (E), cut:

- (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 5 1/4" triangles.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Pink (F), cut:

- (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 5 1/4" triangles.

#### From the Tossed Allover Bird - Cyan (G), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 1/2" squares.

#### From the Rainbow Stripe - Multi (H), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" strips.
- (4) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 68 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end

with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" strips.

- (5) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 1" x 52 1/2" strips.

#### From the Border Stripe - Cyan (I):

- Fussy cut (2) 6 1/2" x 52 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips, each centered on a stripe.

#### From the Flying Bird Allover - Soft Purple (J), cut:

- (2) 4 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (1) 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" strip.

#### From the Tossed Unicorn and Rainbow - Cyan (K), cut:

- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 70 1/2" strips.
- (4) 6 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 1/2" x 66 1/2" strips.

#### From the Patchwork - White (Backing), cut:

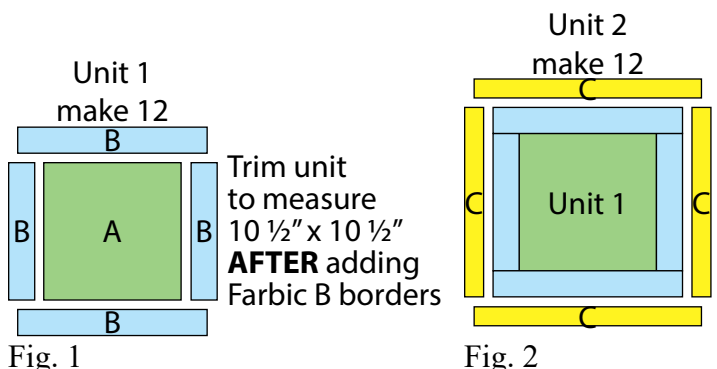
- (2) 90" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 74" x 90" back.

### Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 7 3/4" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 3/4" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 11 3/4" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). **Trim the unit to measure 10 1/2" x 10 1/2"**. Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 10 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 12 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Unit 1 square to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Unit 2 squares total.



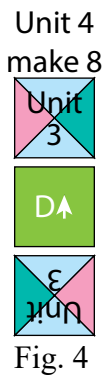

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3. Sew (1) 5 1/4" Fabric F triangle and (1) 5 1/4" Fabric B triangle together along short sides to make (1) FB triangle. Sew (1) 5 1/4" Fabric B triangle and (1) 5 1/4" Fabric E triangle together along short sides to make (1) BE triangle. Sew together the FB and BE triangles along their long sides to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (32) Unit 3 squares total.



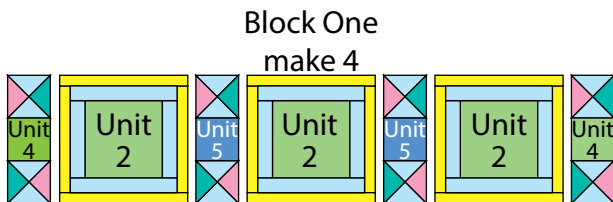
4. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric D square to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (8) Unit 4 strips total.



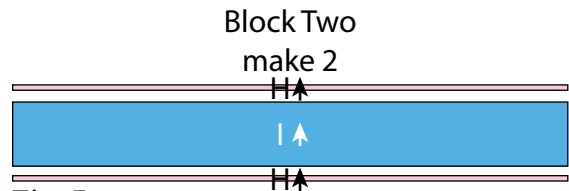
5. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the top and to the bottom of (1) 4 1/2" Fabric G square to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (8) Unit 5 strips total.



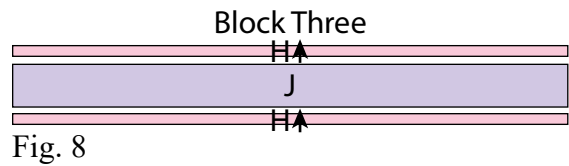
6. Sew together (1) Unit 4 strip, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 5 strip, (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 5 strip, (1) Unit 4 strip, in that order from left to right, to make (1) Block One strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block One strips total.



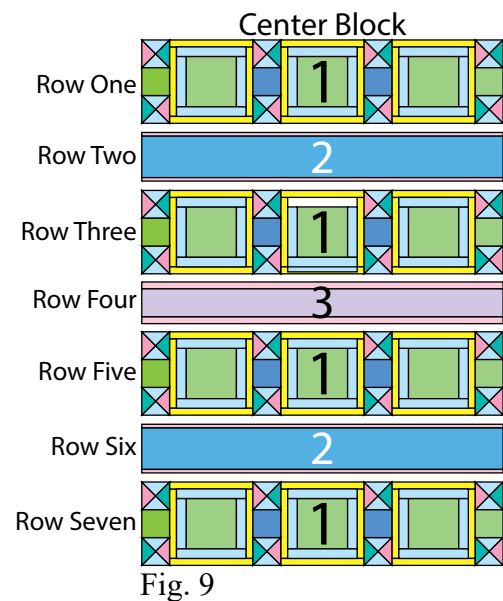
7. Sew (1) 1" x 52 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 6 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric I strip to make (1) 7 1/2" x 52 1/2" Block Two strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Block Two strip.



8. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) 4 1/2" x 52 1/2" Fabric J strip to make (1) 6 1/2" x 52 1/2" Block Three strip (Fig. 8).



9. Sew together (1) Block One strip, (1) Block Two strip, (1) Block One strip, (1) Block Three strip, (1) Block One strip, (1) Block Two strip and (1) Block One strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make the 52 1/2" x 68 1/2" Center Block (Fig. 9).



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## Quilt Top Assembly

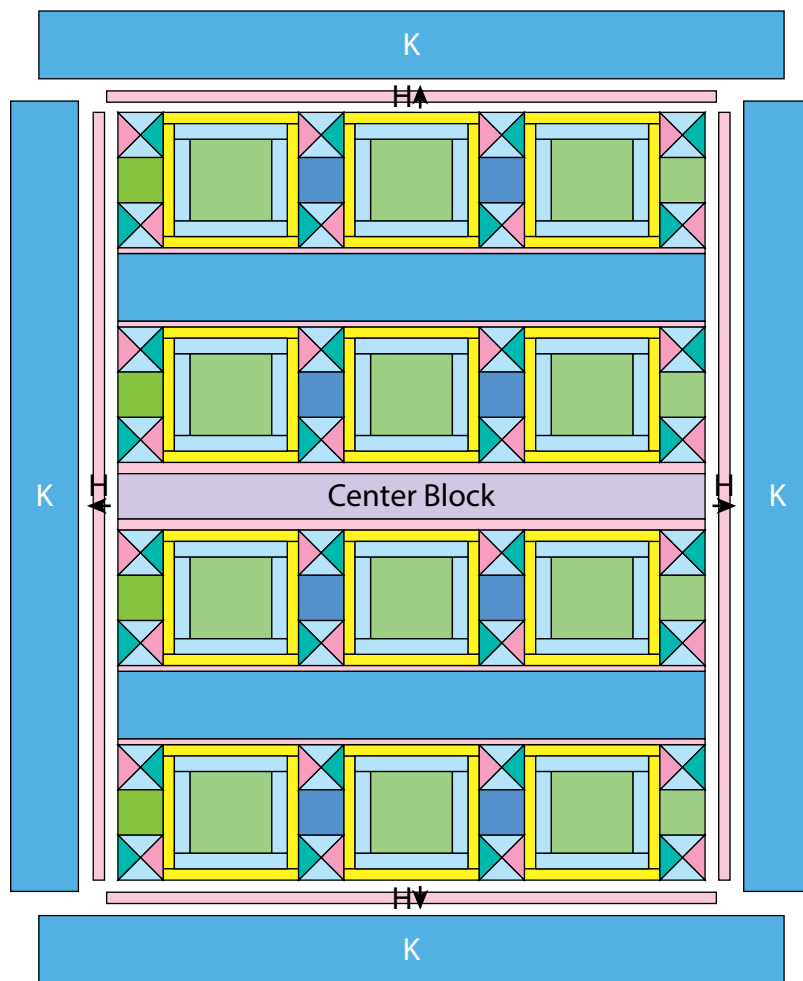
*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

10. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 68 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 1/2" x 54 1/2" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 70 1/2" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 1/2" x 66 1/2" Fabric K strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (8) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.
