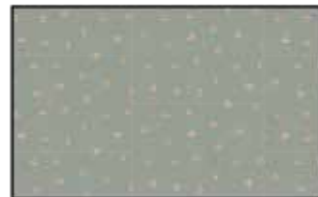

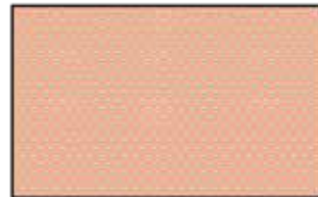

1/8 yard	Row Houses - Taupe (D)	2633-39
1/8 yard	Spots - Cream (E)	2636-4
1/8 yard	Spots - Peach (F)	2636-35
1/8 yard	Posey Dot - Light Blue (G)	2638-17
1 yard	Posey Dot - Plum (H)	2638-58
1/8 yard	Posey Dot - Cream (I)	2638-4
3/4 yard	Town Toss - Cream (J)	2634-4
3 yards	Posey Dot - Cream (Backing)	2638-4

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Neighborhood Panel - Sage (A), cut:

- (1) 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" panel.

#### From the Daisy - Taupe (B), cut:

- (2) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" WOF strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 43 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 48 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 30 1/2" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Daisy - Light Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Row Houses - Taupe (D), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Spots - Cream (E), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Spots - Peach (F), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Posey Dot - Light Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (11) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Posey Dot - Plum (H), cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3" squares.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/2" squares.
- (32) Template 1 triangles.
- (32) Template 3 triangles.

#### From the Posey Dot - Cream (I), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (11) 2 1/2" squares.

#### From the Town Toss - Cream (J), cut:

- (1) 5 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 5 1/2" squares.
- (32) Template 2 triangles.

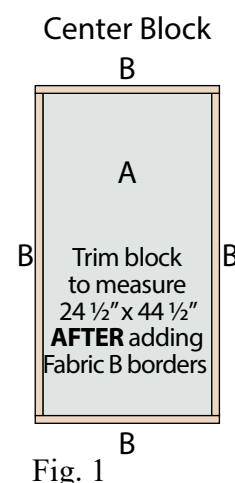
#### From the Posey Dot - Cream (Backing), cut:

- (2) 51" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 51" x 71" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

1. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 22 1/2" x 42 1/2" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 26 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2".**



2. Place (1) 3" Fabric H square on the top left corner of (1) 5 1/2" Fabric J square, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 3).

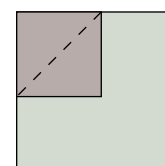

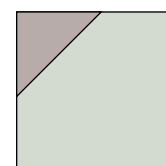

3. Follow Figure 4 for the seam direction to add a 3" Fabric H square to each of the remaining corners of the 5 1/2" Fabric J square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 5).

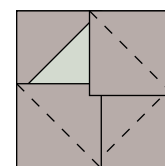

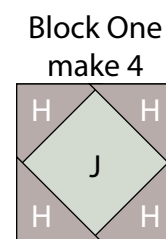

4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (4) Block One squares total.

5. Place (1) Fabric H-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric J-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 6). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.

6. Place (1) Fabric H-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric J-Template 3 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 7). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open to make (1) Block Two square (Fig. 8). Trim the block to measure  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " square.

7. Repeat Steps 5-6 to make (32) Block Two squares total.

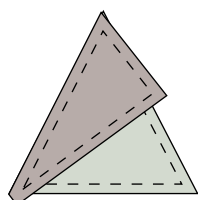

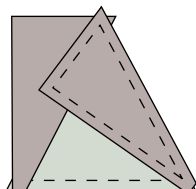

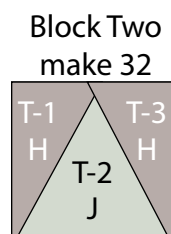

8. Sew together (22) assorted  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make the Inner Left Side Border (Fig. 9).

9. Sew together (22) assorted  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make the Inner Right Side Border (Fig. 10).

10. Sew together (14) assorted  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make the Inner Top Border (Fig. 11).

11. Sew together (14) assorted  $2\frac{1}{2}$ " squares to make the Inner Bottom Border (Fig. 12).

12. Sew (10) Block Two squares together to make (1) Outer Side Border (Fig. 13). Repeat to make a second Outer Side Border.

13. Sew (6) Block Two squares together. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Outer Top Border (Fig. 14 below). Repeat to make the Outer Bottom Border.

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

14. Sew the Inner Left Border and Inner Right Side Border to the left and to the right of the Center Block. Sew the Inner Top Border and Inner Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 30 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

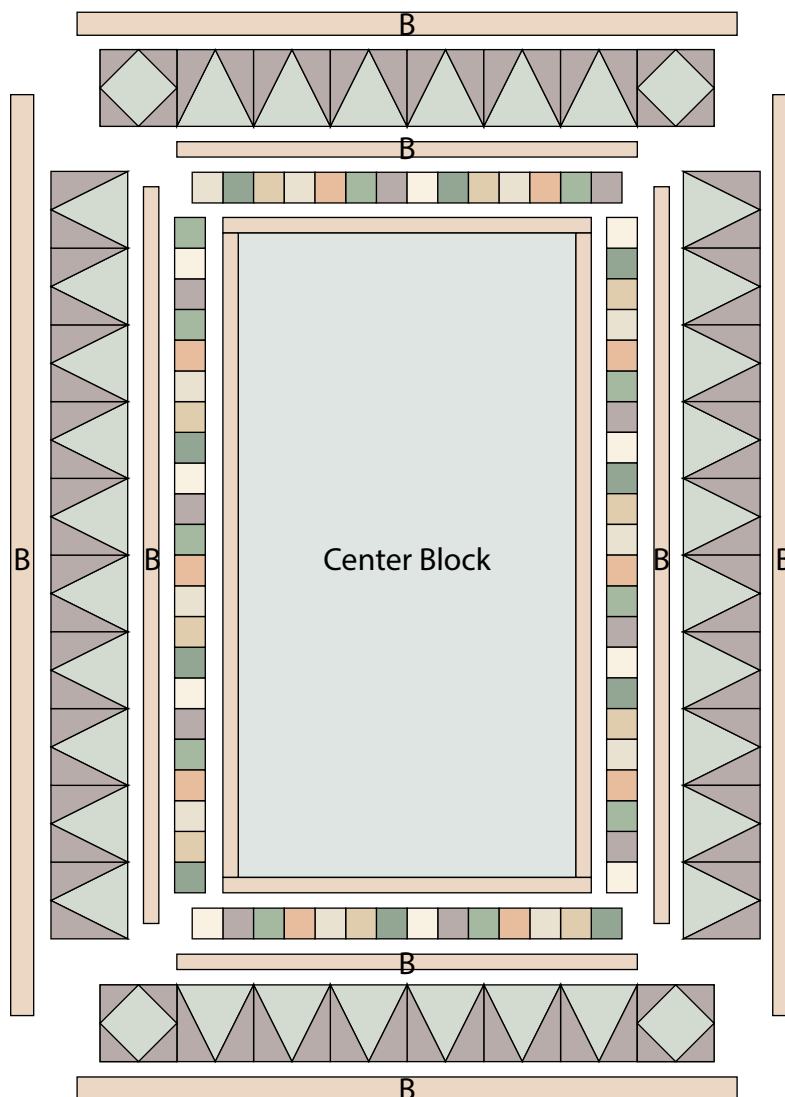
16. Sew (1) Outer Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Outer Top Border and Outer Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

17. Sew (1) 2" x 60 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 43 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

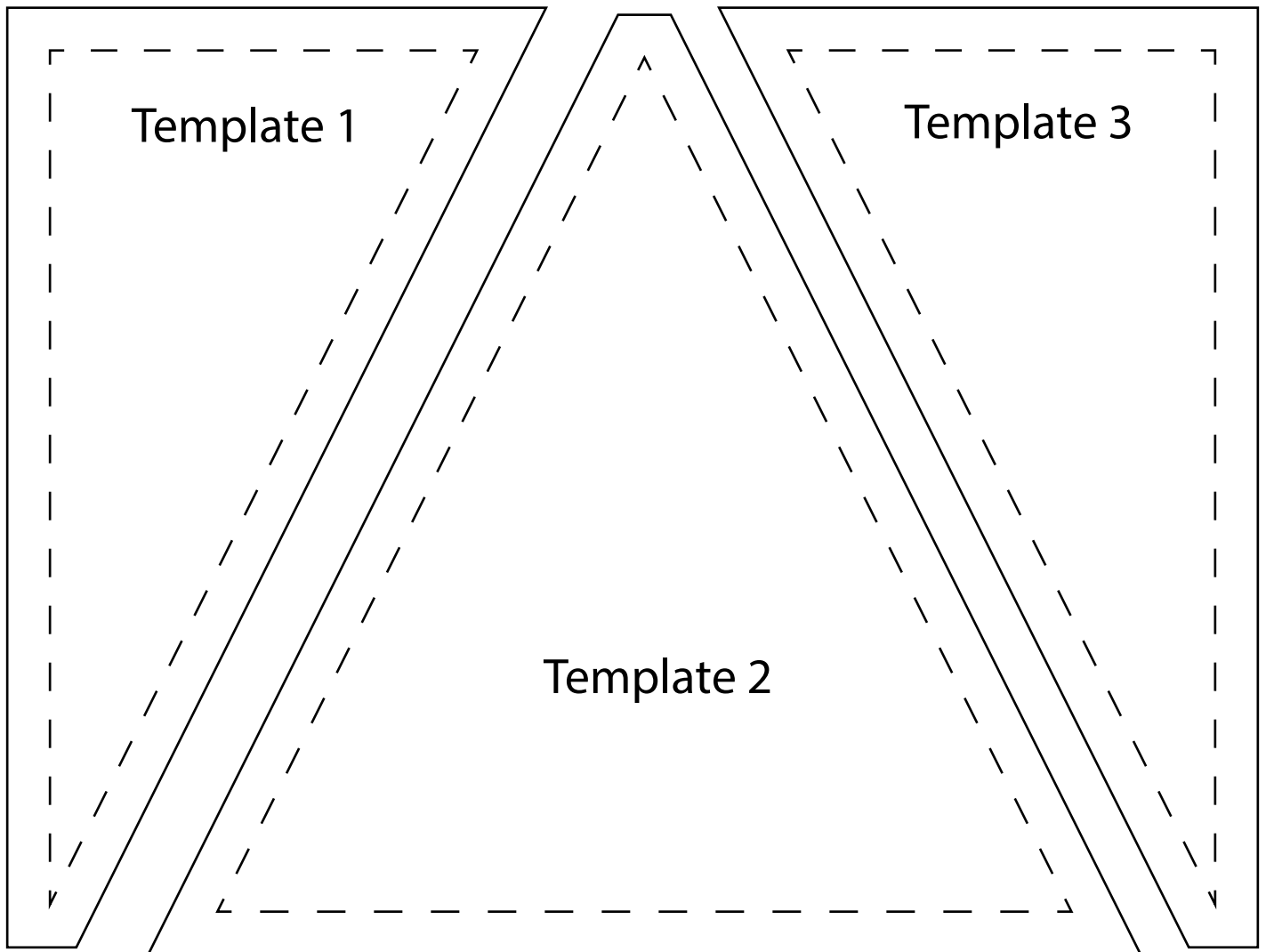
20. Bind as desired.
