Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tiny Daisies - Aqua (A), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ½" squares.

From the Medium Daisies - Peach (B), cut:

- (2) 7 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 7 ¼" triangles.

From the Monotone Floral - Lavender (C), cut:

- (1) 6 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 6 ⅞" triangles.

From the Bunnies and Bears - Lavender (D), cut:

- (1) 6 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 6 ⅞" triangles.

From the Sheep - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) 7 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 ¼" triangles.
Note: You will use (6) 7 ¼" triangles.

From the Tiny Daisies - Blue (F), cut:

- (1) 7 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 ¼" triangles.
Note: You will use (6) 7 ¼" triangles.

From the Medium Daisies - Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 7 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 ¼" triangles.
Note: You will use (6) 7 ¼" triangles.

From the Musical Elephants - Blue (H), cut:

- (1) 7 ¼" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (8) 7 ¼" triangles.
Note: You will use (6) 7 ¼" triangles.

From the Tiny Daisies - Green (I), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Sheep - Green (J), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (K), cut:

- (4) 7 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (18) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (72) 7 ¼" triangles.
- (5) 3 ⅞" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (48) 3 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (96) 3 ⅞" triangles.

From the Bunnies and Bears - Pink (L), cut:

- (1) 6 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ½" squares.

From the Medium Daisies - Green (M), cut:

- (2) 7 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (6) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (24) 7 ¼" triangles.

From the Monotone Floral - Peach (N), cut:

- (3) 7 ¼" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 7 ¼" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (48) 7 ¼" triangles.

From the Tiny Daisies - Yellow (O), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Monotone Floral - Yellow (P), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Geometric - Pink (Q), cut:

- (1) 6 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 6 ⅞" triangles.

From the Musical Elephants - Pink (R), cut:

- (1) 6 ⅞" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 6 ⅞" squares. Cut the squares across (1) diagonal to make (12) 6 ⅞" triangles.

From the Geometric - Yellow (S), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 72 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 57 ½" strips.

From the Tulips - Aqua (T), cut:

- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 75 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 67 ½" strips.

From the Monotone Floral - Aqua (U), cut:

- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Tulips - Lavender (Backing), cut:

- (2) 93" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 75" x 93" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 3 7/8" Fabric K triangle to adjacent sides of (1) 3 1/2" Fabric J square. Sew (1) 6 7/8" Fabric C triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.

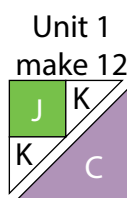

2. Repeat Step 1 and refer to Figures 2-4 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (12) of each unit square for Unit 2 through Unit 4.

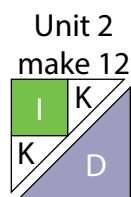

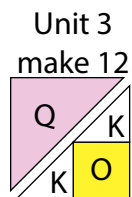

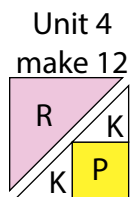

3. Sew (1) 7 1/4" Fabric K triangle and (1) 7 1/4" Fabric E triangle together along short sides to make (1) KE triangle. Sew (1) 7 1/4" Fabric B triangle and (1) 7 1/4" Fabric K triangle together along short sides to make (1) BK triangle. Sew the KE and BK triangles together along their long sides to make (1) 6 1/2" Unit 5 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (6) Unit 5 squares total.

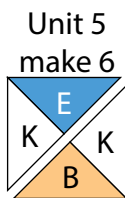

4. Repeat Step 3 and refer to Figures 6-9 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Unit 6 squares, (6) Unit 7 squares, (6) Unit 8 squares and (24) Unit 9 squares.

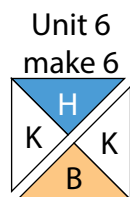

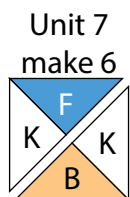

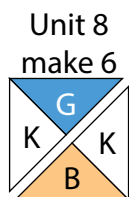

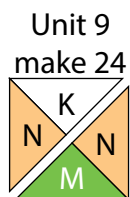

5. Sew together (1) Unit 1 square, (1) Unit 5 square and (1) Unit 2 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 10).

6. Sew together (1) Unit 6 square, (1) 6 1/2" Fabric A square and (1) Unit 7 square, in that order from left to right, to make the middle row (Fig. 10).

7. Sew together (1) Unit 2 square, (1) Unit 8 square and (1) Unit 1 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 10).

8. Sew together the (3) Rows from Steps 5-7 lengthwise to make (1) 18 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 10).

9. Repeat Steps 5-8 to make (6) Block One squares total.

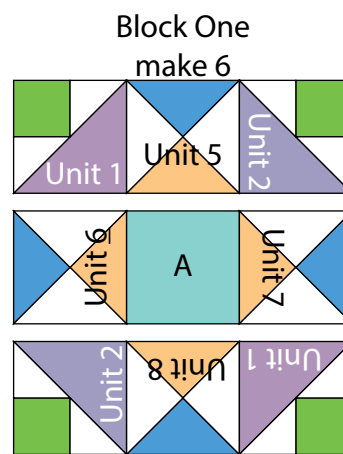

10. Repeat Steps 5-8 and refer to Figure 11 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Block Two squares.

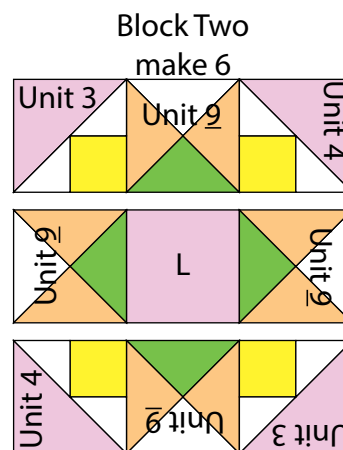

11. Sew (1) Block One square to each side of (1) Block Two square to make Row One (Fig. 12). Repeat to make Row Three.

12. Sew (1) Block Two square to each side of (1) Block One square to make Row Two (Fig. 12). Repeat to make Row Four.

13. Sew the (4) rows from Steps 11-12 together lengthwise and in numerical order to make the 54 ½" x 72 ½" Center Block (Fig. 12).

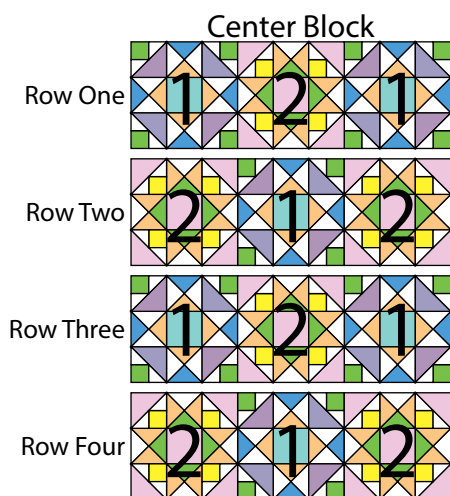

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

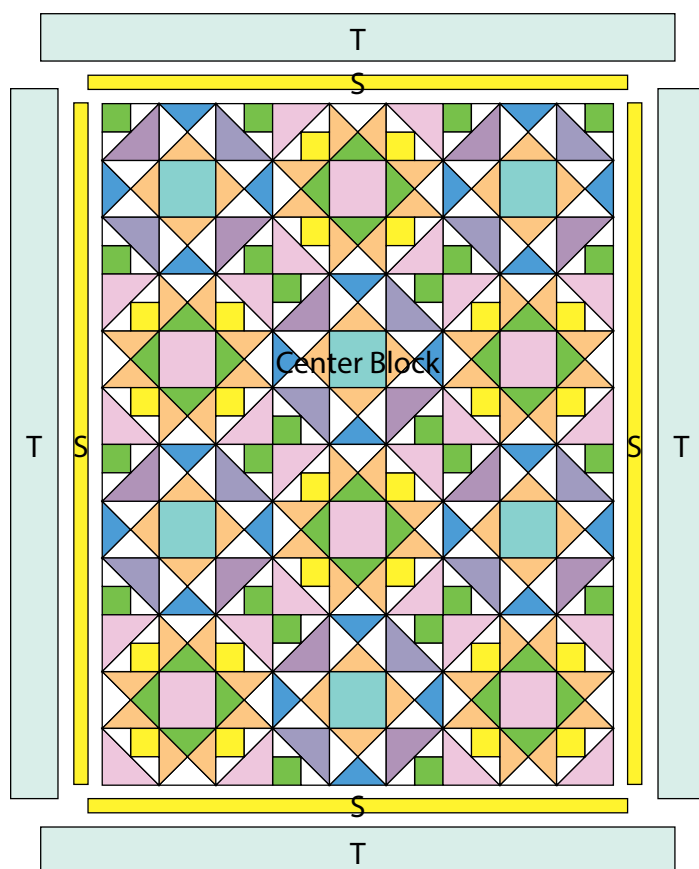
14. Sew (1) 2" x 72 ½" Fabric S strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 57 ½" Fabric S strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 75 ½" Fabric T strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 67 ½" Fabric T strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric U strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.
