



Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Packed Monotone Daisy - Red (A), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (20) 2 ½" squares.

From the White on White Small Wild Flower - White (B), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 63" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 2 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 4" strips.

From the Packed Monotone Daisy - Green (C), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 4" strips.
- See instructions to cut (44) Vines.

From the Large Daisy - Green (D), cut:

• (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 5 ½" strips.

From the Multicolored Wildflowers - Red/Aqua (E), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 5 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 13" strips.

From the Multicolored Wildflowers - Pink/Purple (F), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 7" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 11 ½" strips.

From the Large Daisy - Aqua (G), cut:

• (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 7" strips.

From the Little Bo Peep - Aqua (H), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 8 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (6) Flowers.

From the Tossed Bunnies and Bears - Yellow (I), cut:

• (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 8 ½" strips.

From the Multicolored Daisy - Yellow (J), cut:

• (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 10" strips.

From the Tiny Farm Animals - Purple (K), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 10" strips.
- See instructions to cut (6) Flowers.

From the Multicolored Daisy - Purple (L), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 11 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (6) Flowers.

From the Tossed Elephants on Plaid - Pink (M), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 11 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flowers.

From the Multicolored Daisy - Pink (N), cut:

- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 13" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 8 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (6) Flowers.

From the White on White Small Daisy - White (O), cut:

- (7) 6 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (4) 6 ½" x 68 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 2 ½" strips.
- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10 2" x 4" strips.

From the Multicolored Daisy - Blue (P), cut:

- (1) 2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 4" strips.
- See instructions to cut (6) Flowers.

From the Little Bo Peep - Blue (Q), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 5 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flowers.

Cutting Instructions - Continued

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Tossed Elephants on Plaid - Yellow (R), cut:

• (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 5 ½" strips.

From the Packed Monotone Daisy - Yellow (S), cut:

- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 7" strips.
- See instructions to cut (44) Flower Centers.

From the Large Daisy - Purple (T), cut:

• (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 7" strips.

From the Monotone Geometric - Purple (U), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 8 ½" strips.
- See instructions to cut (2) Flowers.

From the Tiny Farm Animals - Pink (V), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 10" strips.
- See instructions to cut (4) Flowers.

From the Tossed Elephants on Plaid - Green (W), cut:

• (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 10" strips.

From the Tossed Bunnies and Bears - Green (X), cut:

• (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2" x 11 ½" strips.

From the Monotone Geometric - Blue (Y), cut:

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 66 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 56 ½" strips.

From the Large Daisy - Blue (Z), cut:


• (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Multicolored Wildflowers - Pink/Purple (Backing), cut:

• (2) 88" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 76" x 88" back.


Block Assembly

1. Sew (1) 2" x 2 ½" Fabric B strip to the left side of (1) 2 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 4" Fabric B strip to the top of the newly sewn strip to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (10) Unit 1 squares total.



- 2. Sew (1') 2" x 4" Fabric C strip to the right side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 2" x 5 ½" Fabric D strip to the bottom of the newly sewn block to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (10) Unit 2 squares total.
- 3. Sew (1) 2" x 5 ½" Fabric E strip to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square. Sew (1) 2" x 7" Fabric F strip to the top of the newly sewn block to make (1) Unit 3 square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (10) Unit 3 squares total.
- 4. Sew (1) 2" x 7" Fabric G strip to the right side of (1) Unit 3 strip. Sew (1) 2" x 8 ½" Fabric H strip to the bottom of the newly sewn block to make (1) Unit 4 square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (10) Unit 4 squares total.




- 5. Sew (1) 2" x 8 ½" Fabric I strip to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric J strip to the top of the newly sewn block to make (1) Unit 5 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (10) Unit 5 squares total.
- 6. Sew (1) 2" x 10" Fabric K strip to the right side of (1) Unit 5 square. Sew (1) 2" x 11 ½" Fabric L strip to the bottom of the newly sewn block to make (1) Unit 6 square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (10) Unit 6 squares total.



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7. Sew (1) 2" x 11 ½" Fabric M strip to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square. Sew (1) 2" x 13" Fabric N strip to the top of the newly sewn block to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 7). The block should measure 13" square. Repeat to make (10) Block One squares total.



8. Repeat Steps 1-7 and refer to Figure 8 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (10) Block Two squares.




- 9. Sew (2) Block One squares and (2) Block Two squares together, alternating them, to make Row One. Repeat to make Row Three and Row Five.
- 10. Sew (2) Block Two squares and (2) Block One squares together, alternating them, to make Row Two. Repeat to make Row Four.
- 11. Sew the (5) rows together, in numerical order, to make the Center Block (Fig. 9).



Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow Figure 10 and the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 12. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 63" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 54 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Fig. 10).
- 13. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 66 ½" Fabric Y strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 56 ½" Fabric Y strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block (Fig. 10).
- 14. Sew (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " x $68\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric O strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 68 ½" Fabric O strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top (Fig. 10).




- 15. Following the manufacturer's instructions, trace the listed number of each template onto the paper side of the fusible web. Roughly cut out each template about 1/8" outside the drawn lines.
- 16. Press each template onto the wrong side of the fabrics as listed on the templates. Cut out each template on the drawn lines.
- 17. Refer to the quilt layout to arrange and press the assorted flowers, flower centers and vines onto the quilt top.

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- 18. Finish the raw edges of each shape with a decorative stitch such as a buttonhole or satin stitch to complete the top.
- 19. Layer and quilt as desired.


- 20. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric Z strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 21. Bind as desired.
