Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Packed Daisies - Aqua (A), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 54 ½" strips.
- (3) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

From the Quilters Flour II - White (B), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.
- (20) 2 ½" x WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 3 ½" strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 2" x 6 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 58 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.

From the Spaced Small Floral - Cream/Yellow (C), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Tiny Chain of Daisies - Green (D), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Packed Daisies - Blue (E), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.
- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Spaced Small Floral - Cream/Red (F), cut:

- (1) 3 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 3 ½" squares.

From the Monotone Little Bo Peep - Yellow (G), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Small Monotone Roses - Green (H), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.

From the Small Monotone Roses - Red (I), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Tiny Chain of Daisies - Lavender (J), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Packed Daisies - Pink (K), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Tiny Chain of Daisies - Yellow (L), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Packed Daisies - Green (M), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.

From the Tiny Mice - Blue (N), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.
- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Medium Floral - Lavender (O), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Small Monotone Roses - Pink (P), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Clover and Daisies - Pink (Q), cut:

- (6) 2 ½" WOF strips.

From the Spaced Small Floral - Aqua (R), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Tiny Mice - Green (S), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Medium Floral - Red (T), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Monotone Little Bo Peep - Lavender (Backing), cut:

- (2) 64" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 64" x 76" back.

Block Assembly

Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew together (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric G strip, (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strip and (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric H strip, lengthwise and in that order from left to right, to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 1).

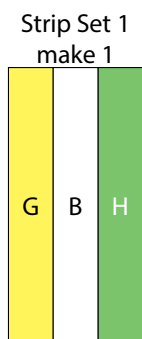

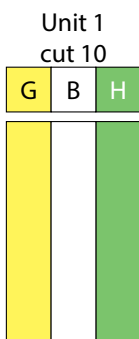

2. Cut the Strip Set 1 into (10) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).

3. Repeat Steps 1-2 and refer to Figures 3-12 for fabric identification and placement to make (10) of each unit strip for Unit 2 through Unit 6.

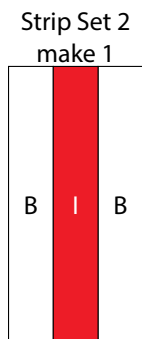

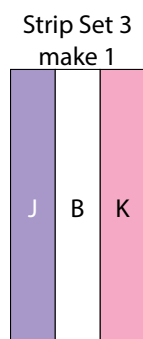

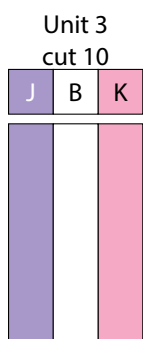

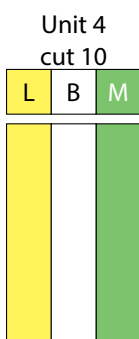

4. Sew together (1) Unit 1 strip, (1) Unit 2 strip and (1) Unit 3 strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Fig. 13). Repeat to make (10) Block One squares total.

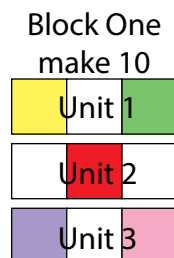

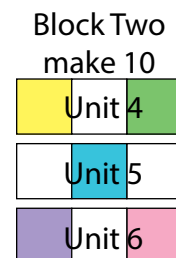

6. Sew (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $2\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF Fabric Q strip lengthwise to make (1) Strip Set 7 (Fig. 15). Repeat to make (6) Strip Set 7's total.

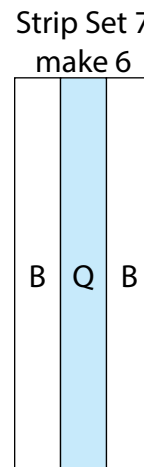

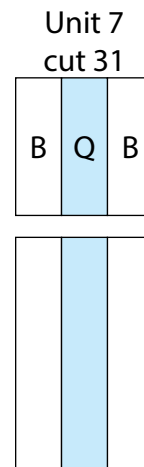

7. Cut the (6) Strip Set 7's into (31) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 7 squares (Fig. 16).

8. Sew (1) 2 " x $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) $3\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2 " x $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) $6\frac{1}{2}$ " Unit 8 square (Fig. 17). Repeat to make (12) Unit 8 squares total.

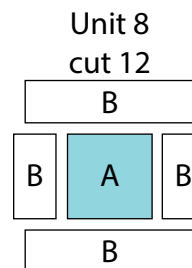

9. Place (1) 3 1/2" Fabric C square on the top left corner of (1) Unit 8 square, right sides together (Fig. 18). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 18). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle 1/4" away from the sewn seam (Fig. 19).

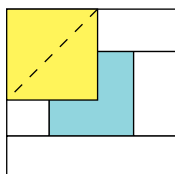

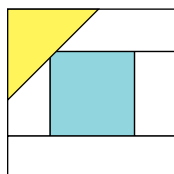

10. Follow Figure 20 for the seam direction to add a 3 1/2" Fabric E square to the lower left corner, a 3 1/2" Fabric D square to the upper right corner and a 3 1/2" Fabric F square to the lower right corner of the Unit 8 square to make (1) Block Three square (Fig. 21).

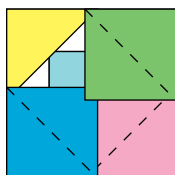

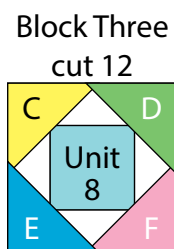

12. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Block Two square, (1) Unit 7 square, (1) Block One square, (1) Unit 7 square and (1) Block Two square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 22).

13. Repeat Step 12 and refer to Figure 22 for component identification, location and orientation to make Row Two through Row Nine.

14. Sew together the (9) Rows, in numerical order, to make the Center Block (Fig. 22).

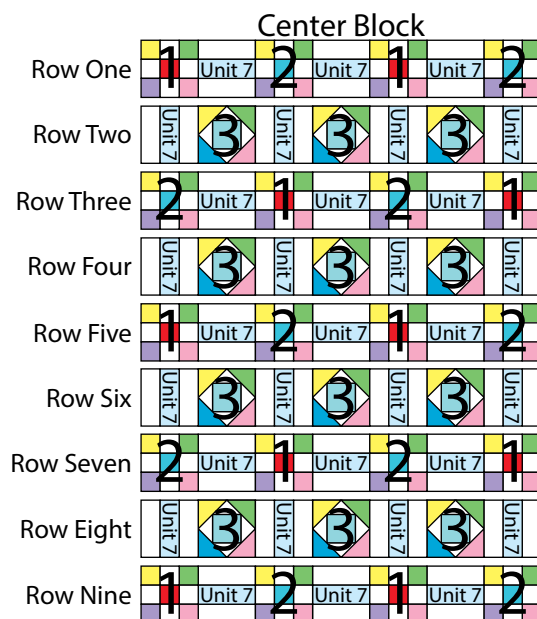

15. Sew together (30) assorted 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips lengthwise to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 23). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

16. Sew together (24) assorted 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips lengthwise. Sew (1) 4 1/2" Fabric B square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 24). Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

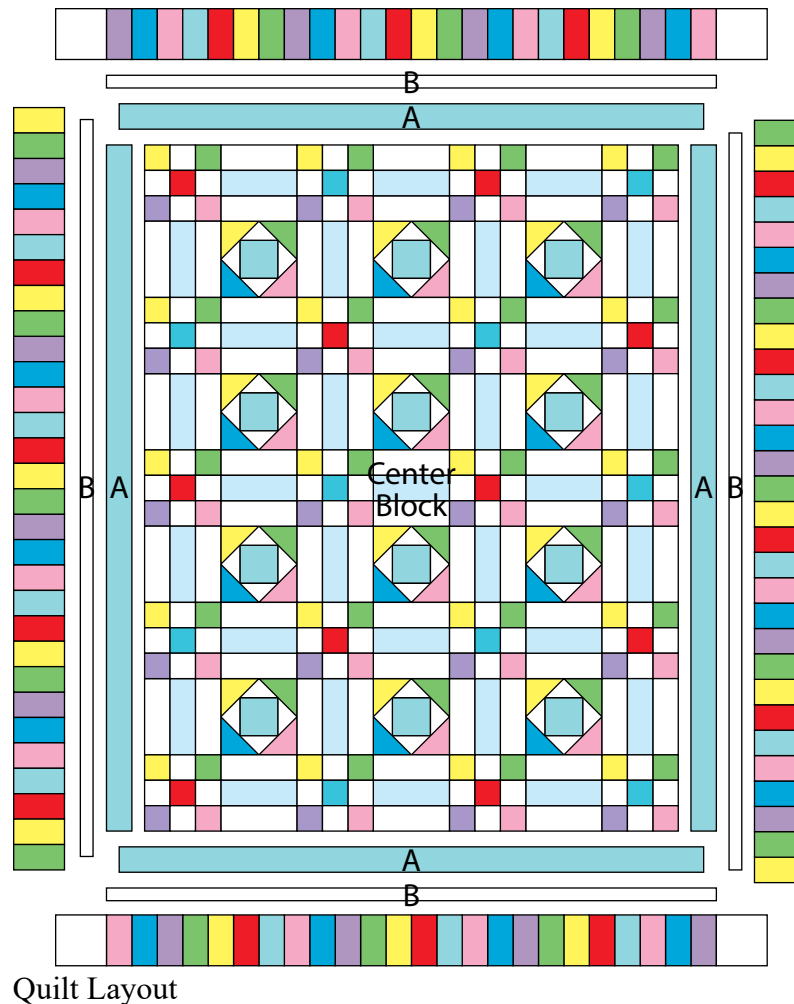

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

17. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 54 ½" Fabric A strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric A strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
18. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 58 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

19. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
20. Layer and quilt as desired.
21. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
22. Bind as desired.



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
