5/8 yard	Twinkle - Gray (C)	135-90
3/8 yard	Glow Packed Pumpkins - Orange (D))799G-33
1/4 yard	Glow Tossed Ghosts - Orange (E)	807G-33
1/4 yard	Glow Witch's Shoes - Orange (F)	808G-33
1/4 yard	Glow Tossed Ghosts - Black (G)	807G-99
3/4 yard	Glow Bias Plaid - Multi (H)	804G-39*
1 1/8 yards	Glow Tossed Motifs - Black (I)	806G-99
3 yards	Glow Tossed Cats - Orange (Backing)	802G-33

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Panel - Multi (A):

• Fussy cut (1) 22 ½" x 39" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Glow Spiderweb - Black (B), cut:

- (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 5 1/4" triangles.
- (2) 2 ³/₄" x 25 ¹/₂" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 39" WOF strips.

From the Twinkle - Gray (C), cut:

- (1) 5 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 5 ½" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 5 ½" triangles.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 52 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ¹/₄" x 36" WOF strips.

From the Glow Packed Pumpkins - Orange (D), cut:

- (1) 4 1/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 1/8" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal from the upper right corner to the lower left corner to make (12) right to left Fabric D triangles. Note: You will only use (6) right to left Fabric D triangles.
- (1) 4 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 %" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower left right corner to make (12) left to right Fabric D triangles. Note: You will only use (6) left to right Fabric D triangles.

From the Glow Tossed Ghosts - Orange (E), cut:

• (1) 4 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 %" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal to make (10) Fabric E triangles.

From the Glow Witch's Shoes - Orange (F), cut:

• (1) 4 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 %" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal to make (10) Fabric F triangles.

From the Glow Tossed Ghosts - Black (G), cut:

• (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 ½" squares.

From the Glow Bias Plaid - Multi (H), cut:

- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 50 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 34 ½" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Glow Tossed Motifs - Black (I), cut:

- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 54" strips.
- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 46" strips.

From the Glow Tossed Cats - Orange (Backing), cut:

• (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 72" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 2" x 39" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 ½" x 39" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ¾" x 25 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24** ½" x 42 ½".



2. Sew together (1) 5 ¼" Fabric B triangle and (1) 5 ¼" Fabric C triangle along short sides. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric D triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 ½" Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.


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3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Unit 2 squares, (5) Unit 3 squares, (5) Unit 4 squares, (5) Unit 5 squares and (5) Unit 6 squares.



4. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square, along the Fabric C sides, to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Unit 7 strips total.





5. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square, along the Fabric C sides, to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (4) Unit 8 squares total.



6. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square, along the Fabric C sides, to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Unit 9 squares total.



- 7. Sew together (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 7 strip and (1) Unit 9 strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 11).
- 8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figure 12 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border.



9. Sew together (1) 4 ½" Fabric G square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip and (1) 4 ½" Fabric G square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 13).



10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figure 14 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Bottom Border.


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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

- 11. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.
- 12. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 13. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 14. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 52 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 36" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

- 15. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 54" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 46" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 16. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 17. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 18. Bind as desired.
