

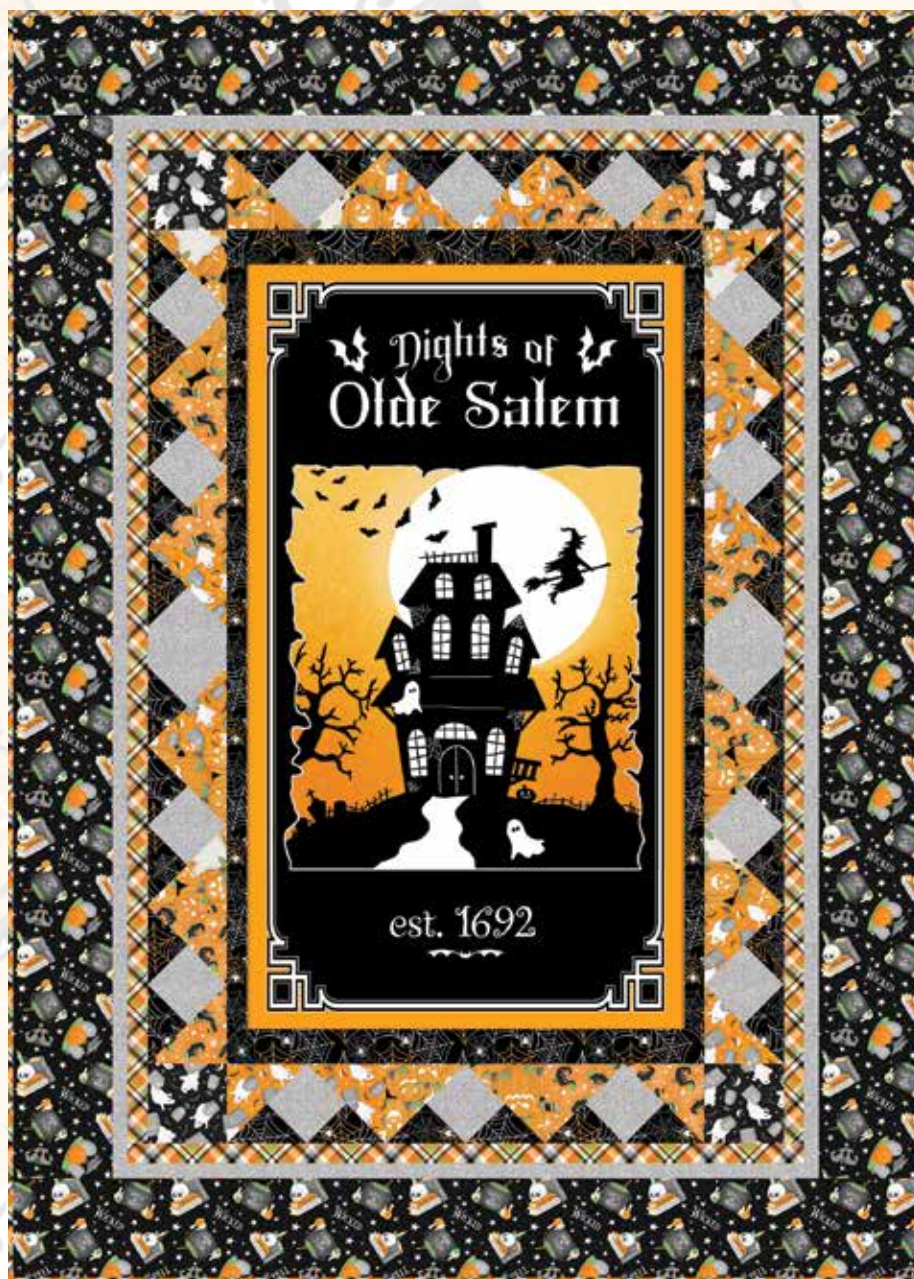

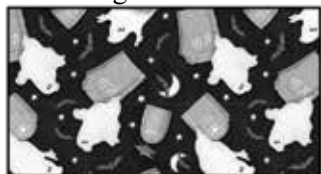

5/8 yard	Glow Spiderweb - Black (B)	801G-99
5/8 yard	Twinkle - Gray (C)	135-90
3/8 yard	Glow Packed Pumpkins - Orange (D)	799G-33
1/4 yard	Glow Tossed Ghosts - Orange (E)	807G-33
1/4 yard	Glow Witch's Shoes - Orange (F)	808G-33
1/4 yard	Glow Tossed Ghosts - Black (G)	807G-99
3/4 yard	Glow Bias Plaid - Multi (H)	804G-39*
1 1/8 yards	Glow Tossed Motifs - Black (I)	806G-99
3 yards	Glow Tossed Cats - Orange (Backing)	802G-33

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 1/2" x 39" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Glow Spiderweb - Black (B), cut:

- (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 5 1/4" triangles.
- (2) 2 3/4" x 25 1/2" WOF strips.
- (2) 2" x 39" WOF strips.

From the Twinkle - Gray (C), cut:

- (1) 5 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 5 1/4" squares. Cut the squares across both diagonals to make (32) 5 1/4" triangles.
- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" strips.
- (3) 1 1/4" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/4" x 52 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/4" x 36" WOF strips.

From the Glow Packed Pumpkins - Orange (D), cut:

- (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal from the upper right corner to the lower left corner to make (12) right to left Fabric D triangles. *Note: You will only use (6) right to left Fabric D triangles.*
- (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal from the upper left corner to the lower right corner to make (12) left to right Fabric D triangles. *Note: You will only use (6) left to right Fabric D triangles.*

From the Glow Tossed Ghosts - Orange (E), cut:

- (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal to make (10) Fabric E triangles.

From the Glow Witch's Shoes - Orange (F), cut:

- (1) 4 7/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 4 7/8" squares. Cut the squares across the diagonal to make (10) Fabric F triangles.

From the Glow Tossed Ghosts - Black (G), cut:

- (1) 4 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 4 1/2" squares.

From the Glow Bias Plaid - Multi (H), cut:

- (3) 1 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 1/2" x 50 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1 1/2" x 34 1/2" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Glow Tossed Motifs - Black (I), cut:

- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 54" strips.
- (3) 5 1/2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 1/2" x 46" strips.

From the Glow Tossed Cats - Orange (Backing), cut:

- (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 72" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2" x 39" Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 1/2" x 39" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 2 3/4" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 42 1/2".**

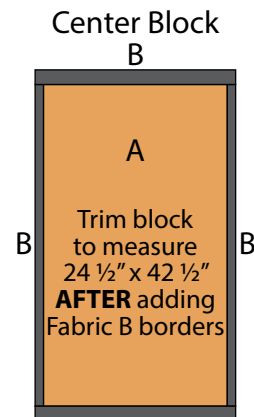

- Sew together (1) 5 1/4" Fabric B triangle and (1) 5 1/4" Fabric C triangle along short sides. Sew (1) 4 7/8" Fabric D triangle to the long side of the newly sewn triangle to make (1) 4 1/2" Unit 1 square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (6) Unit 1 squares total.



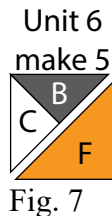
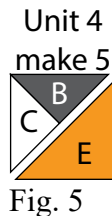

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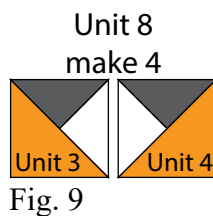
3. Repeat Step 2 and refer to Figures 3-7 for fabric identification, placement and orientation to make (6) Unit 2 squares, (5) Unit 3 squares, (5) Unit 4 squares, (5) Unit 5 squares and (5) Unit 6 squares.



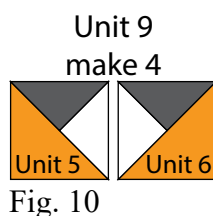
4. Sew (1) Unit 1 square to the left side of (1) Unit 2 square, along the Fabric C sides, to make (1) Unit 7 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (6) Unit 7 strips total.



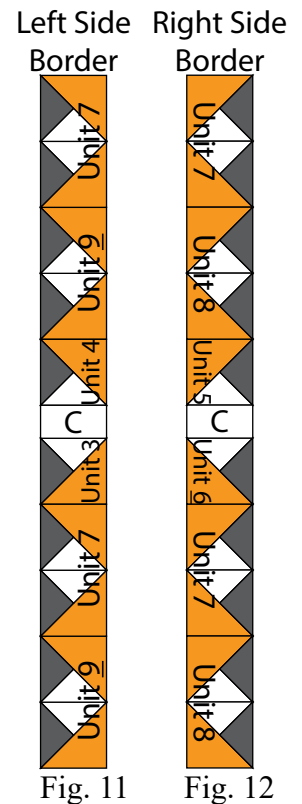
5. Sew (1) Unit 3 square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square, along the Fabric C sides, to make (1) Unit 8 strip (Fig. 9). Repeat to make (4) Unit 8 squares total.



6. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 6 square, along the Fabric C sides, to make (1) Unit 9 strip (Fig. 10). Repeat to make (4) Unit 9 squares total.

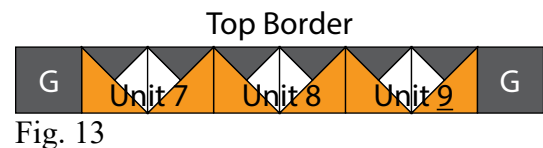


7. Sew together (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip, (1) Unit 4 square, (1) 2 1/2" x 4 1/2" Fabric C strip, (1) Unit 3 square, (1) Unit 7 strip and (1) Unit 9 strip, in that order from top to bottom, to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 11).

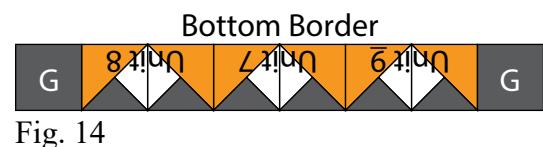


8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figure 12 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Right Side Border.

9. Sew together (1) 4 1/2" Fabric G square, (1) Unit 7 strip, (1) Unit 8 strip, (1) Unit 9 strip and (1) 4 1/2" Fabric G square, in that order from left to right, to make the Top Border (Fig. 13).



10. Repeat Step 9 and refer to Figure 14 for component identification, placement and orientation to make the Bottom Border.

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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

11. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

12. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 34 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

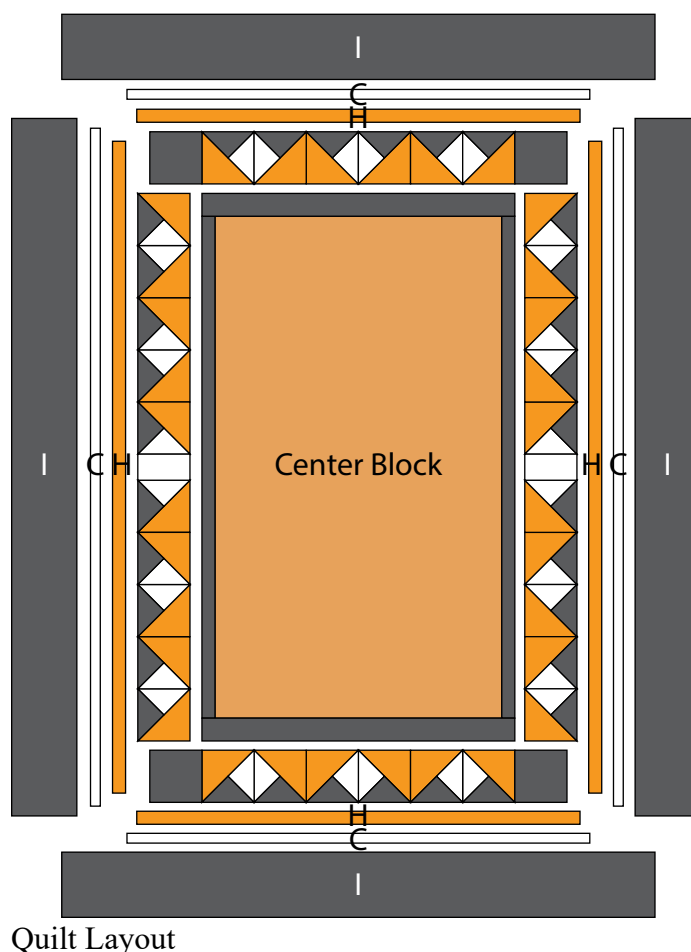
14. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 52 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ¼" x 36" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 54" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 ½" x 46" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

16. Layer and quilt as desired.

17. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

18. Bind as desired.
