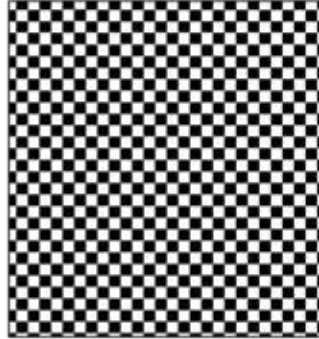

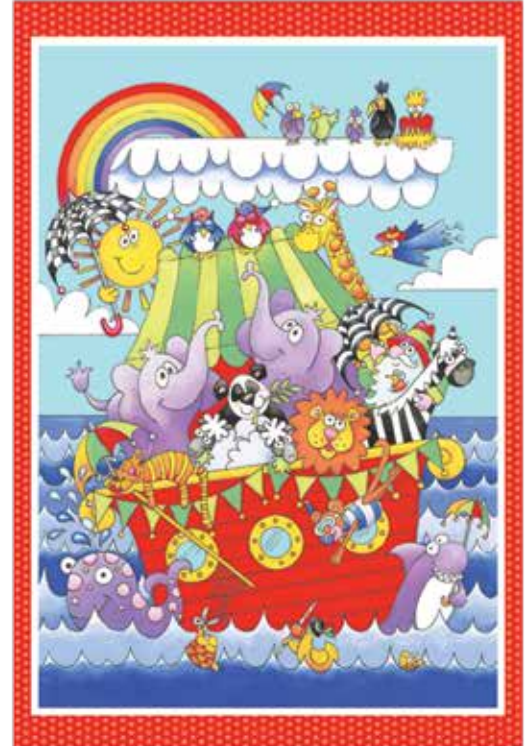

Materials

1 panel	30" Noah's Ark Panel - Multi (A)	9460P-81
1 yard	Modern Melody Basics - Black (B)	1063-99*
¼ yard	Check - Black/White (C)	9453-9
¼ yard	Folio - Yellow (D)	7755-34
¼ yard	Tossed Pandas - Red (E)	9455-88
¼ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Lime (F)	1063-64
¼ yard	Sky, Clouds, Sun - Light Blue (G)	9454-11
1 ½ yards	Zebra and Sheep - Blue (H)	9456-11
3 ¾ yards	Small Squares with Animal Motifs - Multi (Backing)	9452-78

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 30" Noah's Ark Panel - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 27" x 37 ½" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (B), cut:

- (2) 3" x 37 ½" WOF strips.
- (2) 2 ½" x 31 ½" WOF strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x 40 ½" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Check - Black/White (C), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 4 ½" squares.

From the Folio - Yellow (D), cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 3" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Tossed Pandas - Red (E), cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 3" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Lime (F), cut:

- (2) 3" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (14) 3" x 4 ½" strips.

From the Sky, Clouds, Sun - Light Blue (G), cut:

- (1) 4 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (14) 4 ½" x 3" strips.

From the Zebra and Sheep - Blue (H), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x 50 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 4 ½" x 40 ½" strips, piece as needed.

From the Small Squares with Animal Motifs - Multi (Backing), cut:

- (2) 66" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 66" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 3" x 37 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the 27" x 37 ½" Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 31 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 30 ½" x 40 ½".**

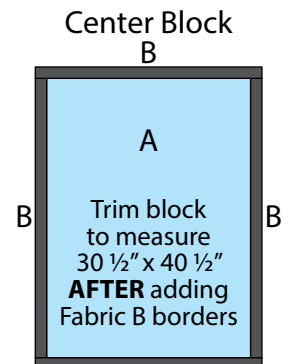

2. Follow Figure 2 and sew together (16) assorted 3" x 4 ½" rectangles to make the Left Side Border.

3. Follow Figure 3 and sew together (16) assorted 3" x 4 ½" rectangles to make the Right Side Border.

4. Follow Figure 4 and sew together (12) assorted 3" x 4 ½" Fabric C square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border.

5. Follow Figure 5 and sew together (12) assorted 3" x 4 ½" Fabric C square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border.

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the *Quilt Layout* while assembling the quilt top.)

6. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right side of the Center Block.

7. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

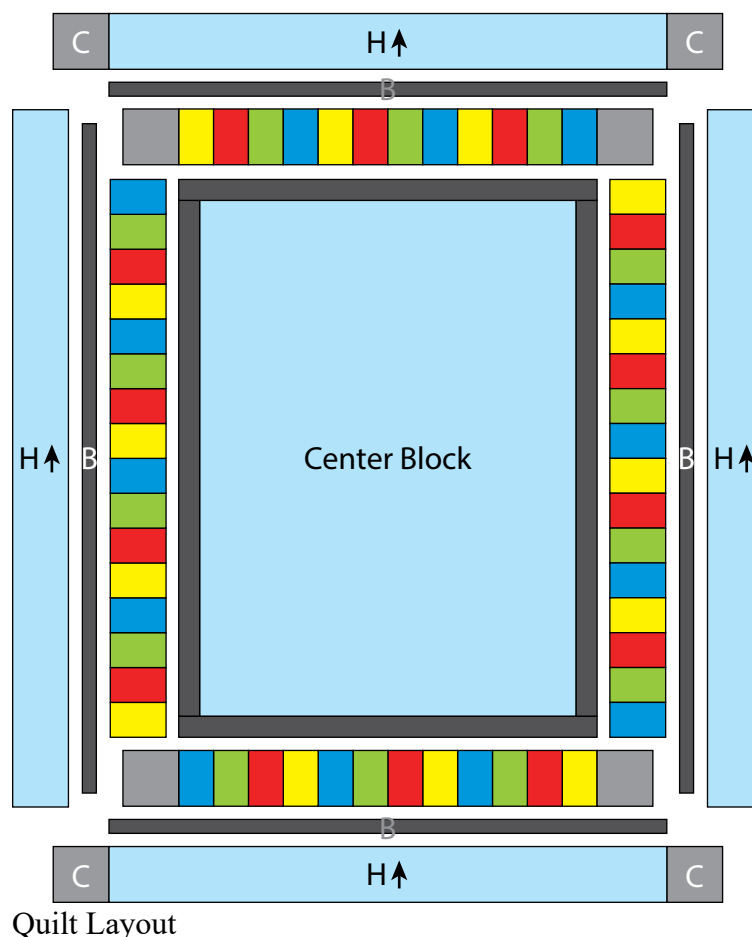
8. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

9. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" Fabric C square to each end of (1) 4 ½" x 40 ½" Fabric H strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

10. Layer and quilt as desired.

11. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

12. Bind as desired.
