

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the On the 12th Day Panel Book - Red (A):

• Fussy cut (12) 7 ½" squares each centered on a block.

#### From the Stars - Green (B), cut:

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 7 ½" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (24) 1 ½" x 9 ½" strips.

#### From the Song Design - Cream (C), cut:

- (2) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 4 ½" x 2 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the 12th Day Circles - Cream (D), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Starflower Sprig - Cream (E), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Stars - Red (F), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Starflower Sprig - Red (G), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- (1) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (20) 1 ½" squares.

#### From the Heart and Stars - Red (H), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Pears - Brown (I), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the 12th Day Circles - Blue (J), cut:

- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 53 ½" strips.
- (3) 4 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 4 ½" x 48 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Heart and Stars - Blue (K), cut:

• (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (32) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Starflower Sprig - Cocoa (L), cut:

- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Stars - Blue (M), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Pears - Blue (N), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Pears - Taupe (O), cut:

• (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 2 ½" squares.

#### From the Heart and Stars - Cream (P), cut:

• (11) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (31) 1 ½" x 12 ½" strips.


#### From the Starflower Sprig - Cocoa (Backing), cut:

• (2) 56" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 56" x 69" back.

#### **Block Assembly**


Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention fabric and unit orientation when assembling the various components.

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 7 ½" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 ½" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 9 ½" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square. Trim the block to measure 8 ½" square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig. 1). Repeat to make (12) Unit 1 squares total.




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
2. Place (1) 2 ½" Fabric F square on the left side of (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 2). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 2). Flip open the triangle formed and press (Fig. 3). Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance.







- 3. Place another 2 ½" Fabric F square on the right side of the 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric C strip, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the square from the upper left corner to the lower right corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle, leaving a 1/4" seam allowance to make (1) Unit 2 strip (Fig. 5).
- 4. Repeat Steps 2-3 to make (4) Unit 2 strips total.
- 5. Repeat Steps 2-3 and refer to Figure 6 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (4) Unit 3 strips.









6. Sew (2) Unit 2 strips together end to end to make (1) Unit 4 strip (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Unit 4 strip.




7. Sew (2) Unit 3 strips together end to end to make (1) Unit 5 strip (Fig. 8). Repeat to make a second Unit 5 strip.



- 8. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 4 strip to make the top row.
- 9. Sew (1) Unit 5 strip to the left side of (1) Unit 1 square and (1) Unit 4 strip to the right side to make the middle row.
- 10. Sew (1) 2 ½" Fabric C square to each end of (1) Unit 5 strip to make the bottom row.
- 11. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 8-10 to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 9).



12. Repeat Steps 2-9 and refer to Figures 10-20 for fabric identification, placement, seam direction and orientation to make (1) of each block for Block Two through Block Twelve.










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13. Sew (4) 1 ½" Fabric G squares and (3) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric P strips together end to end and alternating them to make (1) Sashing Row (Fig. 21 below). Repeat to make (5) Sashing Rows total.


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#### **Quilt Top Assembly**

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.) 14. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric P strip, (1) Block One square, (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric P strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric P strip, (1) Block Three square and (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric P strip together in that order to make Row One.

- 15. Repeat Step 14 and refer to the quilt layout for component identification, location and orientation to make Rows Two, Three and Four.
- 16. Sew together the (5) Sashing Rows and (4) pieced rows, in numerical order, alternating them to make the Center Block.

- 17. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 53 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 4 ½" x 48 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.
- 18. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 19. Sew the (6) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric L strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 20. Bind as desired.
