

#### **Cutting Instructions**

Please note: all strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

#### From the Song Design - Blue (A), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Song Design - Green (B), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the 12th Day Circles - Blue (C), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the 12th Day Circles - Cream (D), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (5) 2 ½" x 12½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" strips.
- (5) T-1 Template triangles.
- (5) T-3 Template triangles.

#### From the 12th Day Circles - Taupe (E), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Pears - Blue (F), cut:

• (2) T-2 Template triangles.

#### From the Pears - Taupe (G), cut:

• (2) T-2 Template triangles.

#### From the Pears - Brown (H), cut:

- (4) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (15) 1" x 2 ½" strips.

#### From the Stars - Red (I), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Stars - Green (J), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Stars - Blue (K), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Starflower Sprig - Cream (L), cut:

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (5) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 ½" x 2 ½" strips.
- (5) T-1 Template triangles.
- (5) T-3 Template triangles.

#### From the Starflower Sprig - Cocoa (M), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Starflower Sprig - Red (N), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Heart and Stars - Cream (O), cut;

- (2) 2 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (5) 2 ½" x 12 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (5) 2 ½" x 4 ½" strips.
- (1) 2 1/4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (10) 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" strips.
- (5) T-1 Template triangles.
- (5) T-3 Template triangles.

#### From the Heart and Stars - Blue (P), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Heart and Stars - Red (Q), cut:

• (1) T-2 Template triangle.

#### From the Song Design - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (1) 44" x 38" WOF strip for the backing.

#### **Block Assembly**

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention fabric and unit orientation when assembling the various components.


1. Place (1) Fabric D-Template 1 triangle on top of (1) Fabric A-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the left sides (Fig. 1). Sew the (2) triangles together along the left side. Press the smaller triangle open.

**Block Three** 

2. Place (1) Fabric D-Template 3 triangle on top of the Fabric A-Template 2 triangle, right sides together, aligning the right sides (Fig. 2). Sew the (2) triangles together along the right side. Press the smaller triangle open. Trim the block to measure 4 ½" x 8 ½" to make (1) Unit 1 rectangle (Fig. 3).









3. Sew (1) 2 1/4" x 2 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of (1) 1" x 2 1/2" Fabric H strip to make (1) unit 2 strip (Fig. 4).



4. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 4 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) Unit 2 strip to the bottom of the Unit 1 rectangle. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric D strip to the right side of the newly sewn block to make (1) Block One rectangle (Fig. 5).



5. Repeat Steps 1-4 and refer to Figures 6-19 for fabric identification, location and orientation to make (1) of each block for Block Two through Block Fifteen.







#### **Quilt Top Assembly** (Follow the Quilt Layout on Page 5 while assembling the

- 6. Sew together Blocks One through Five, in that order from left to right, to make Row One.
- 7. Sew together Blocks Six through Ten, in that order from left to right, to make Row Two.
- 8. Sew together Blocks Eleven through Fifteen, in that order from left to right, to make Row Three.
- 9. Sew the (3) rows together, in numerical order, to make the quilt top.
- 10. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 11. Sew the (4) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 12. Bind as desired.
