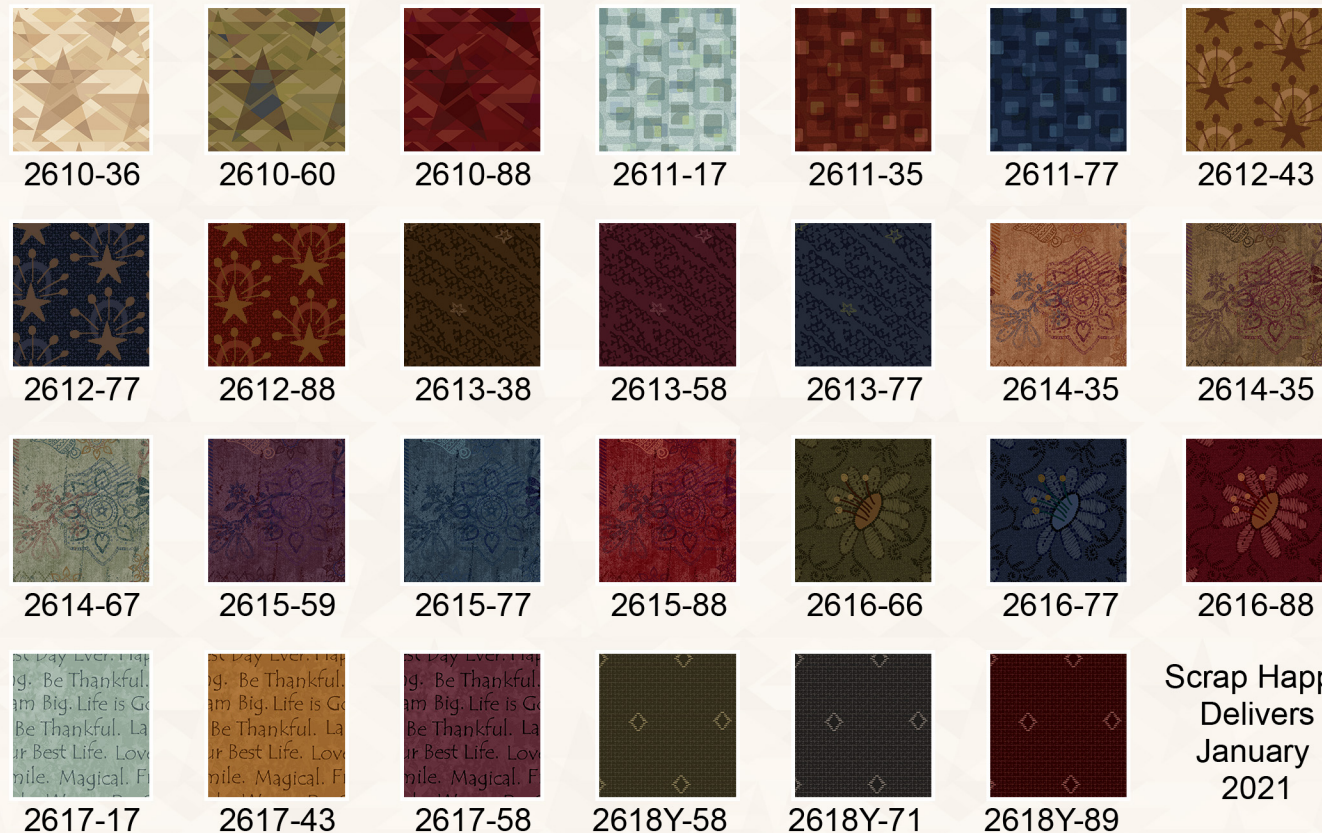
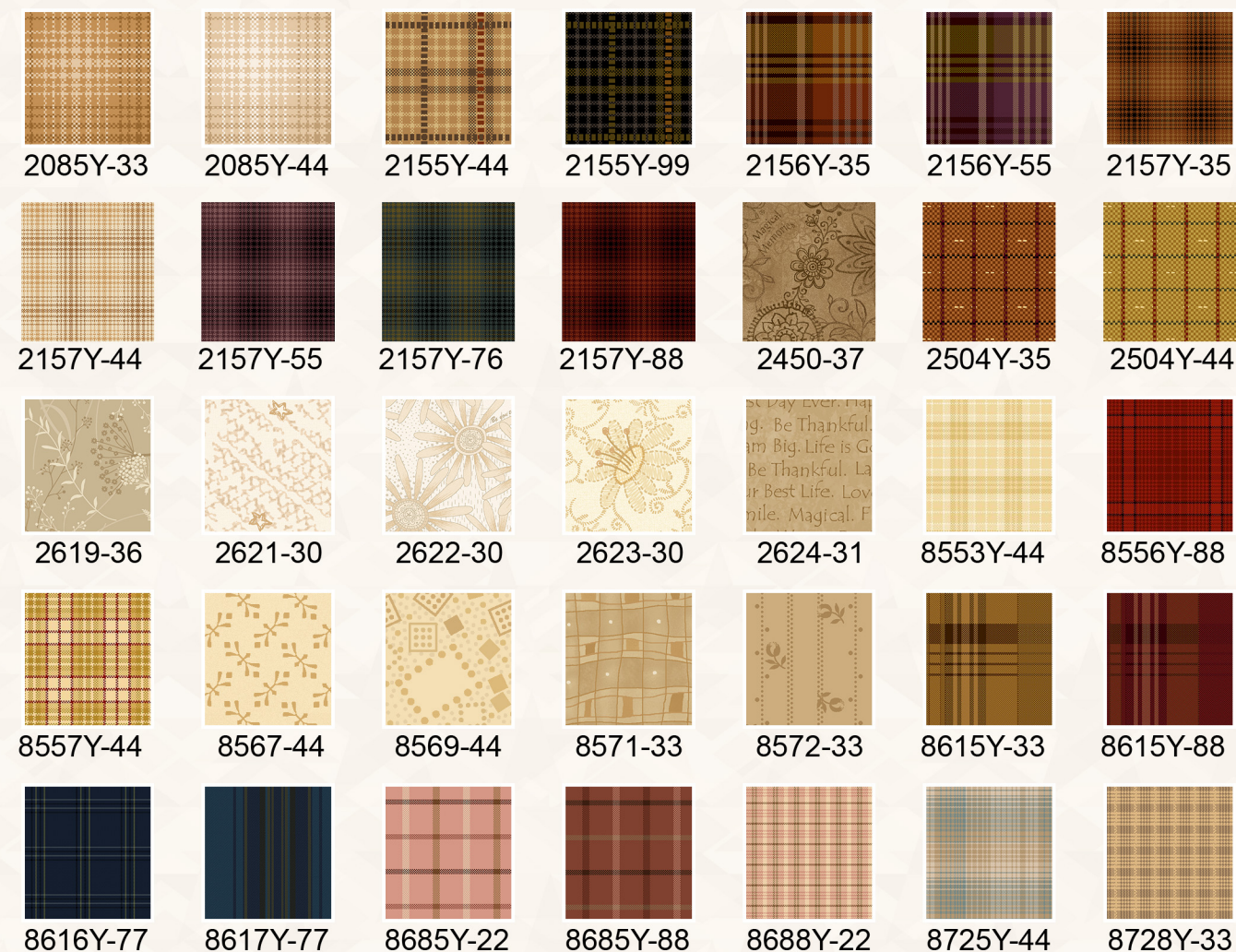

# One Crazy Sister Club III

There’s no better way to make a scrappy quilt then using One Sister’s crazy piecing technique! Many people have a hard time making scrappy quilts, and this time around, club quilts are definitely “Scrap Happy”! You and your students are in for a crazy good time as you join together each session and let the crazy good times begin!

- FOR THE SHOPS:
- Notice the color bars next to the quilt photos, which indicate the stacking order for the fabrics used. These color bars help you and your students with stacking. The top of the page is the top of your stack.
  - The instruction pages print out on 8.5” x 11” standard paper, but the insert/block pattern MUST BE PRINTED ON 11” X 17” PAPER in order to be the correct size.
  - The students will need the General Craziiness directions. These directions are a separate file so that you don’t have to print for each session.
  - You need one piece of fabric (in the designated size) or each block, so these quilts are easy to make larger! 16 blocks = 16 fabrics, 20 blocks = 20 fabrics, etc. It’s a breeze to make quilts larger, scrappier, and happier!
  - Shops can offer a basic starter pack for the small versions shown, and students can choose to make individual quilts larger!
  - Don’t forget to use Janet’s Crazy Piecing videos on her IGTV channel @ones1ster for reference.

Session 1: “Happy Dash” 24” x 24” Use these Churndash blocks to teach the basics of crazy piecing, including using the dots on the master patterns. This technique is a skill that will is used in each session. See Janet’s IG videos for hints on dots and dog ears. Easy stacking in two separate piles: one with all lights and one with all darks (blues).

Session 2: “Barn Raising” 36” x 36”. These scrappy Half-Square Triangle blocks are so versatile! Again in this session, there is easy stacking in two separate piles of lights and darks (reds).

Session 3: “Throw a Wrench in It” 54” x 54”. This project is an optional, bonus quilt, combining the two previous blocks, the churndash and the half-square

triangle blocks. The stacking and shuffling are slightly different, demonstrating to students how versatile this method is and how much fun it is to change things up!

Session 4: “Topsy Turvy” 24” x 24”. Discuss stacking a group of mediums; see Janet’s IG videos for reference.

Session 5: “Hugs and Kisses” 30” x 30” Card Trick blocks. Students will sharpen their stacking skills, stacking in 2 piles of lights and darks, but at the same time checking the contrast as you stack. Touch on appliqué hints, and add the easy circle “O” for the Hug amid all those “X” kisses! You can opt to substitute wool for the applique if your shop carries wool.

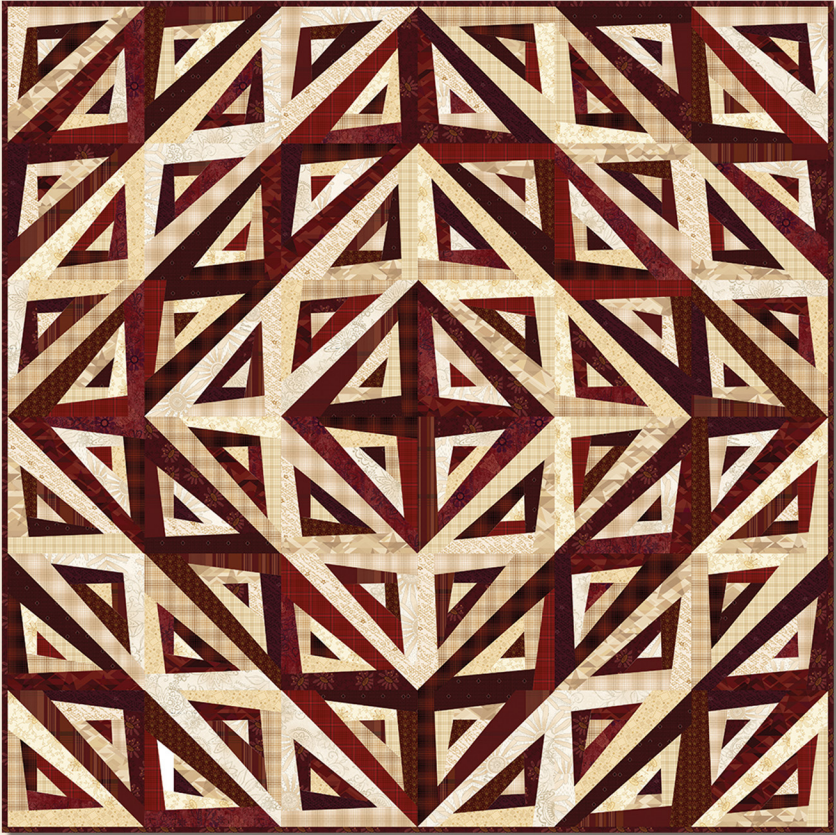
Session 6: “Crazy Goose Chase” 36” x 36” Stacks in two separate piles of lights and darks. The blocks are sashing with simple strip pieced units.

Session 7: “Crazy Monkeys” 46” x 46” This quilt also stacks in two separate piles of lights and darks. These Monkey Wrench blocks could also be used alternately with all the blocks of the Club (and even Club 2 blocks!) for a Scrap Happy finale! Enjoy your time together as you all piece like crazy!
