

Materials

1 panel	24 Inch Banner Panel - White (A)	782P-01
1 2/3 yards	Prayer Word - Red (B)	776-88
7/8 yard	Small Stripe - Navy (C)	775-77*
1/3 yard	Folio Basics - Peach (D)	7755-22
1/2 yard	Houndstooth Basics - Brown (E)	8624-38
1/2 yard	Rainbow - Cream (F)	773-44
1/4 yard	Starry Basics - Indigo (G)	8294-77
1/4 yard	Alligator - Light Blue (H)	779-11
7/8 yard	Arboreal Characters - Navy (I)	774-77
3 yards	Tossed Characters - Tan (Backing)	778-44

*Includes binding

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Banner Panel - White (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 23" x 43" rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Prayer Word - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 56 1/2" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 1 3/4" x 43" LOF strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (2) 2" x 39 1/2" WOF strips and (2) 1 3/4" x 25 1/2" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Small Stripe - Navy (C), cut:

- (3) 2 1/2" WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" strips.
- (2) 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" WOF strips.
- (6) 2 1/2" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Folio Basics - Peach (D), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (12) 2 1/2" squares.
- (3) 1" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1" x 59 1/2" strips.
- (2) 1" x 40 1/2" WOF strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (E), cut:

- (1) 2 1/2" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 2 1/2" squares.
- (76) Template 5 triangles.

From the Rainbow - Cream (F), cut:

- (38) Template 3 pieces.
- (38) Template 4 pieces.

From the Starry Basics - Indigo (G), cut:

- (38) Template 2 squares.

From the Alligator - Light Blue (H), cut:

- (76) Template 1 triangles.

From the Arboreal Characters - Navy (I), cut:

- (3) 3 1/2" WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" strips.
- (3) 3 1/2" WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3 1/2" x 46 1/2" strips.

From the Characters - Tan (Backing), cut:

- (2) 54" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 54" x 74" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.




Fig. 1 **B**↑

1. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 43" Fabric B strip to each side of the 23" x 43" Fabric A rectangle. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 25 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 1/2" x 44 1/2"**. **B**↑

2. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric E square to make the top row. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric E square to the left side of (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 4 1/2" Block One square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.



3. Sew (2) Fabric H Template 1 triangles to adjacent sides of (1) Fabric G Template 2 square to make (1) Unit 1 triangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make (38) Unit 1 triangles.



4. Sew (1) Fabric F Template 3 piece to the bottom of (1) Unit 1 triangle to make (1) Unit 2 piece (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (38) Figure 2 pieces total.



5. Sew (1) Fabric F Template 4 piece to the long side of (1) Unit 2 piece. Sew (1) Fabric E Template 5 triangle to the bottom of the newly sewn piece to make (1) Unit 3 piece (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (38) Unit 3 pieces.





7. Sew together (12) Block Two squares to make the Left Side Border (Fig. 7).

8. Sew together (12) Block Two squares to make the Right Side Border (Fig. 8).

9. Sew together (7) Block Two squares. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 9).



10. Sew together (7) Block Two squares. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 10).

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

11. Sew (1) 2 1/2" x 44 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block.

12. Sew (1) 2 1/2" Fabric D square to each end of (1) 2 1/2" x 24 1/2" Fabric C strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

13. Sew the Left Side Border and Right Side Border to the left and to the right sides of the Center Block.

14. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

15. Sew (1) 2" x 56 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 39 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

16. Sew (1) 1" x 59 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1" x 40 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.


17. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 60 1/2" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 3 1/2" x 46 1/2" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

18. Layer and quilt as desired.

19. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.



20. Bind as desired.

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




Quilt Layout
