From the Houndstooth Basics - Green (B), cut:

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ½" x 6" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ½" x 8" strips.

From the Houndstooth Basics - Light Gray (C), cut:

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (27) 1 ½" x 7" strips.
- (10) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (7) 1 ½" x 59 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Blue (D), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 10 ½" strip, (1) 7" x 14 ¼" strip and (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip.

From the Cloud - Teal (E), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip and (1) 7" x 12 ¾" strip.

From the Starry Basics - Green (F), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.

From the Bias Plaid - Green (G), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 1/2" strips.

- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 64 ½" strips.

From the Cloud - Teal (E), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip and (1) 7" x 12 ¾" strip.

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.

From the Bias Plaid - Green (G), cut:

- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 3" x 7" strips and (4) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 1 5%" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 5%" squares.

From the Alligator - Light Blue (I), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip and (1) 7" x 12 ¾" strip.

From the Arboreal Characters - Navy (J), cut:

- (2) 2" x 61 ½" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (1) 16 ½" x 7" WOF strip, (1) 14 ¼" x 7" WOF strip, (32) 3 ½" squares and (2) 2" x 49 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Border Stripe - Teal (K), cut:

- (2) 9 ½" x 64 ½" LOF strips.
- (2) 9 ½" x 49 ½" LOF strips.

From the Rainbow - Cream (Backing), cut:

• (2) 92" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 77" x 92" back.

From the 24 Inch Block Panel - Light Gray (A):

• Fussy cut (15) 6" squares, each centered on a block.

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ½" x 6" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ½" x 8" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Light Gray (C), cut:

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (27) 1 ½" x 7" strips.
- (10) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (7) 1 ½" x 59 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.

From the Folio Basics - Peach (D), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 10 ½" strip, (1) 7" x 14 ¼" strip and (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip.

From the Rainbow - Cream (E), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip and (1) 7" x 12 ¾" strip.

From the Small Stripe - Navy (F), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.

From the Tossed Llamas - White (G), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.
- (6) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starry Basics - Brown (H), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 3" x 7" strips.

From the Tossed Characters - Tan (I), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip and (1) 7" x 12 ¾" strip.

From the Prayer Word - Red (J), cut:

- (2) 2" x 61 ½" length of fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (1) 16 ½" x 7" WOF strip, (1) 14 ¼" x 7" WOF strip, and (2) 2" x 49 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Tossed Llamas - White (Backing), cut:

• (2) 57" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 57" x 72" back.

From the 24 Inch Block Panel - Light Gray (A):

• Fussy cut (15) 6" squares, each centered on a block.

- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ½" x 6" strips.
- (6) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (30) 1 ½" x 8" strips.

From the Starry Basics - Light Gray (C), cut:

- (2) 3 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/8" squares.
- (2) 1 5/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1 5/8" x 2 3/4" strips.
- (1) 1 %" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 %" squares.
- (5) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (27) 1 ½" x 7" strips.
- (10) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (7) 1 ½" x 59 ½" strips.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 46 ½" strips.
- (2) 1 ½" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 ½" x 5" strips.

From the Folio Basics - Peach (D), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 10 ½" strip, (1) 7" x 14 ¼" strip and (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip.
- (2) 3 1/8" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 3 1/8" squares.
- (3) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 49 ½" strips.
- (4) 1 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 ½" x 64 ½" strips.

From the Rainbow - Cream (E), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip and (1) 7" x 12 ¾" strip.

From the Small Stripe - Navy (F), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.

From the Tossed Llamas - White (G), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.
- (8) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Starry Basics - Brown (H), cut:

- (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 7" x 16 ½" strips.
- (1) 3" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (3) 3" x 7" strips and (4) 1 ½" squares.
- (1) 1 5/8" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1 5/8" squares.

From the Tossed Characters - Tan (I), cut:

• (1) 7" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (1) 7" x 16 ½" strip and (1) 7" x 12 ¾" strip.

From the Prayer Word - Red (J), cut:

- (2) 2" x 61 ½" length of fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric, cut (1) 16 ½" x 7" WOF strip, (1) 14 ¼" x 7" WOF strip, (32) 3 ½" squares and (2) 2" x 49 ½" WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Border Stripe - Teal (K), cut:

- (2) 9 ½" x 64 ½" LOF strips.
- (2) 9 ½" x 49 ½" LOF strips.

From the Tossed Llamas - White (Backing), cut:


• (2) 92" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 77" x 92" back.

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
Block Assembly (Both Colorways)

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a 1/4" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 6" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6" Fabric A square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 8" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig.1). **Trim the block to measure 7" x 7".** Repeat to make (15) Unit 1 squares total.



- 2. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 7" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 1 square lengthwise to make (1) 7" x 9" Block One rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Block One rectangles total.
- 3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 7" Fabric C strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 1 square lengthwise to make (1) 7" x 8" Block Two rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.
- 4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 7" Fabric C strip to the top of (1) Unit 1 square lengthwise to make (1) 7" x 8" Block Three rectangle (Fig. 4).



- 5. Sew together (1) 7" x 10 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric F strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column One (Fig. 5).
- 6. Sew together (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric G strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric H strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7" x 3" Fabric H strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Two (Fig. 5).
- 7. Sew together (1) 7" x 12 ¾" Fabric I strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric J strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7" x 14 ¼" Fabric D strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Three (Fig. 5).
- 8. Sew together (1) 7" x 3" Fabric H strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric D strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric G strip and (1) Block Three rectangle, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Four (Fig. 5).
- 9. Sew together (1) 7" x 12 ³/₄" Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ¹/₂" Fabric F strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7" x 14 ¹/₄" Fabric J strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Five (Fig. 5).
- 10. Sew together (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric H strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" x 16 ½" Fabric I strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7" x 3" Fabric H strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Six (Fig. 5).
- 11. Sew together the (6) Columns from Steps 3-8, lengthwise and in numerical order from left to right, to make the 44 ½"x 59 ½" Center Block (Fig. 5).



Small Quilt Assembly

(Follow the Small Quilt Layout in Figure 6 while assembling the small quilt top.)

- 10. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 11. Sew (1) 2" x 61 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 49 1/2" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Small Quilt top.
- 12. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 13. Sew the (6) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding for the Small Version. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 14. Bind as desired.




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Large Quilt Block Assembly (Both Colorways)


Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction.

Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.


- 15. Repeat Steps 1-11 to make the 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ "x 59 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Center Block (Fig. 5).
- 16. Sew (1) 1 1/8" Fabric H square to the left side of (1) 1 1/8" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1 1/8" x 2 3/4" Fabric C strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 2 3/4" Unit 2 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (8) Unit 2 squares total.
- 17. Sew (1) 1 %" Fabric C square to the left side of (1) 1 5%" Fabric H square. Sew (1) 1 5%" x 2 3/4" Fabric C strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) 2 3/4" Unit 3 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (8) Unit 3 squares total.




18. Place (1) 3 1/8" Fabric D square on top of (1) 3 1/8" Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 9). Sew 1/4" away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 10) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 3/4" square to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (16) Unit 4 squares total.



19. Repeat Step 18 and refer to Figures 12-15 for fabric identification and placement to make (16) Unit 5 squares, (16) Unit 6 squares, (16) Unit 7 squares and (16) Unit 8 squares. *Note: Due to the directional fabric only (8) of each unit square will be used..*



- 20. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 5" Unit 9 square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (8) Unit 9 squares total.
- 21. Repeat Step 20 and refer to Figure 17 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (8) Unit 10 squares.



- 22. Sew together (1) Unit 9 square, (1) 1 ½" x 5" Fabric C strip and (1) Unit 10 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 18).
- 23. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 5" Fabric C strip to each side of (1) 1 ½" Fabric H square to make the middle row (Fig. 18).
- 24. Sew together (1) Unit 10 square, (1) 1 ½" x 5" Fabric C strip and (1) Unit 9 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 18).
- 25. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 22-24 lengthwise to make (1) 10 ½" Block Four square (Fig. 18).
- 26. Repeat Steps 22-25 to make(4) Block Four squares total.



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27. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric D strip to the top of (1) 9 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric K strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block Four square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Top Border (Fig. 19).




28. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric D strip to the bottom of (1) 9 ½" x 49 ½" Fabric K strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block Four square to each end of the newly sewn strip to make the Bottom Border (Fig.20).



Large Quilt Top Assembly (Follow the Large Quilt Layout in Figure 21 while assembling the large quilt top.)

- 29. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 59 ½" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 46 ½" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
- 30. Sew (1) 2" x 61 ½" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 49 ½" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Small Quilt top.
- 31. Sew the (1) 9 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 32. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 64 ½" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block.
- 33. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Large Quilt top.

- 34. Layer and quilt as desired.
- 35. Sew the (8) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding for the Large Version. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
- 36. Bind as desired.


