(2) $2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ WOF strips, piece as needed.

From the Border Stripe - Teal (K), cut:

- (2) $91 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ LOF strips.
- (2) $91 / 2 " \times 491 / 2 "$ LOF strips.

From the Tossed Llamas - White (Backing), cut:

- (2) $92 " \times$ WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 77 " x 92 " back.

Block Assembly (Both Colorways)
Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $1 / 4 "$ seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 6 "$ Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 6 " Fabric A square. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1 / 2 " x}{} 8^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Unit 1 square (Fig.1). Trim the block to measure 7 " $\mathbf{x} 7$ ". Repeat to make (15) Unit 1 squares total.

2. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 7 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of (1) Unit 1 square lengthwise to make (1) 7 "x 9 " Block One rectangle (Fig. 2). Repeat to make (12) Block One rectangles total.
3. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 7$ " Fabric C strip to the bottom of (1) Unit 1 square lengthwise to make (1) 7" x 8 " Block Two rectangle (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Two rectangle.

5. Sew together (1) 7 " $\times 101 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $7 " \times 16^{1 / 2 "}$ Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7 " $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric F strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column One (Fig. 5).
6. Sew together (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 7 " $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric H strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7" x 3" Fabric H strip, lengthwise and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Two (Fig. 5).
7. Sew together (1) $7 " \times 123 / 4 "$ Fabric I strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) $7 " \times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7 " $\times 14^{1 / 4}$ " Fabric D strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Three (Fig. 5).
8. Sew together (1) 7" x 3 " Fabric H strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7 " $\times 16^{1 / 2}$ " Fabric D strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7 " $\times 161 / 2 "$ Fabric G strip and (1) Block Three rectangle, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Four (Fig. 5).
9. Sew together (1) 7 " $\times 123 / 4$ "Fabric E strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7 " $\times 16^{1 / 2} / 2$ Fabric F strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7 " $\times 141 / 4 "$ Fabric J strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Five (Fig. 5).
10. Sew together (1) Block Two rectangle, (1) 7 " $\times 16 \frac{1 / 2 "}{}$ Fabric H strip, (1) Block One rectangle, (1) 7" $\times 16 \frac{1 / 2 "}{2}$ Fabric I strip, (1) Block One rectangle and (1) 7 " x 3 " Fabric H strip, end to end and in that order from top to bottom, to make Column Six (Fig. 5).
11. Sew together the (6) Columns from Steps 3-8, lengthwise and in numerical order from left to right, to make the $441 / 2$ "x $591 / 2 "$ Center Block (Fig. 5).

10. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime}$ " $\times 591 / 2^{\prime \prime}$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2} /{ }^{\prime \prime} \times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 611 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $491 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Small Quilt top.
12. Layer and quilt as desired.
13. Sew the (6) $21 / 2 " x$ WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45 -degree seams, to make the binding for the Small Version. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
14. Bind as desired.

15. Repeat Steps $1-11$ to make the $441 / 2$ "x $591 / 2$ " Center Block (Fig. 5).
16. Sew (1) $15 / 8 "$ Fabric H square to the left side of (1) $15 / 8 "$ Fabric C square. Sew (1) $15 / 8 " \times 23 / 4 "$ Fabric C strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) $23 / 4$ " Unit 2 square (Fig. 7). Repeat to make (8) Unit 2 squares total.
17. Sew (1) $15 / 8 "$ Fabric C square to the left side of (1) $15 / 8 "$ Fabric H square. Sew (1) $15 / 8 " \times 23 / 4 "$ Fabric C strip to the bottom of the newly sewn strip lengthwise to make (1) $23 / 4$ " Unit 3 square (Fig. 8). Repeat to make (8) Unit 3 squares total.

18. Place (1) $31 / 8$ " Fabric D square on top of (1) $31 / 8$ " Fabric C square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 9). Sew $1 / 4 "$ away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 9). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 10) to make (2) halfsquare triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure $23 / 4 "$ square to make (2) Unit 4 squares (Fig. 11). Repeat to make (16) Unit 4 squares total.

20. Sew (1) Unit 2 square to the left side of (1) Unit 4 square to make the top row. Sew (1) Unit 5 square to the left side of (1) Unit 7 square to make the bottom row. Sew together the (2) rows lengthwise to make (1) 5" Unit 9 square (Fig. 16). Repeat to make (8) Unit 9 squares total.
21. Repeat Step 20 and refer to Figure 17 for component identification, placement and orientation to make (8) Unit 10 squares.

22. Sew together (1) Unit 9 square, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 5 "$ Fabric C strip and (1) Unit 10 square, in that order from left to right, to make the top row (Fig. 18).
23. Sew (1) $1 \frac{1}{2 \prime \prime} \times 5 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of (1) $11 / 2 "$ Fabric H square to make the middle row (Fig. 18).
24. Sew together (1) Unit 10 square, (1) $11 / 2 " \times 5 "$ Fabric C strip and (1) Unit 9 square, in that order from left to right, to make the bottom row (Fig. 18).
25. Sew together the (3) rows from Steps 22-24 lengthwise to make (1) $101 / 2$ " Block Four square (Fig. 18).
26. Repeat Steps 22-25 to make
(4) Block Four squares total.

 29. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 591 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 461 / 2 "$ Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.30. Sew (1) 2 " $\times 611 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x $491 / 2 "$ Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Small Quilt top.
31. Sew the (1) $9^{1 / 2 "} \times 64^{1 / 2 "}$ " Fabric K strip to each side of the Center Block.
32. Sew (1) $11 / 2 " \times 641 / 2 "$ Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block.
33. Sew the Top Border and the Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the Large Quilt top.
