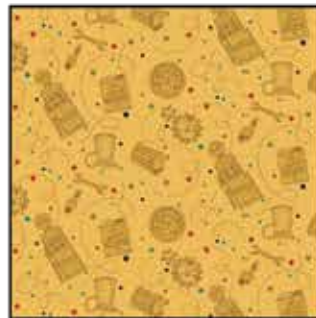

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted. Cutting instructions apply to both versions. Any differences between the two versions are listed separately.*

#### From the Banner Activity Panel - Stone (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strip, centered on the panel.

#### From the Tonal Tools - Red (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 41  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25  $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Black (C), cut:

- (2) 1  $\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1" x 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) 1" x 3  $\frac{1}{8}$ " strips.
- (5) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding (**Version #1**).
- (7) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding (**Version #2**).

#### From the Tonal Tools - Yellow (D), cut:

- (1) 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (16) 1  $\frac{3}{4}$ " squares.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 1" x 3  $\frac{1}{4}$ " strips.
- (1) 1" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (9) 1" x 3  $\frac{1}{8}$ " strips.

#### From the Word and Tire - Teal (E), cut:

- (2) 3" x 45  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- From the remaining fabric cut (2) 3" x 24  $\frac{1}{8}$ " WOF strips.

#### From the Truck Allover - Red (F), cut:

- (3) 3" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 3" x 45  $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 3" x 24  $\frac{1}{8}$ " strips.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - New Teal (G), cut:

- (2) 1  $\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF strips.

#### From the Starry Basics - Brown (H), cut:

- (2) 1  $\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF strips.

#### From the Houndstooth Basics - Brown (I), cut:

- (2) 1  $\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF strips.

#### From the Border Stripe - Teal (J), fussy cut (**Version #2**):

- (2) 10" x 78" LOF strips, each centered on (2) stripes of trucks.
- (2) 10" x 57" LOF strips, each centered on (2) stripes of trucks

#### Version #1 From the Truck Allover - Stone (Backing), cut:

- (1) 42" x 63" WOF strip for the backing.

#### Version #2 From the Truck Allover - Stone (Backing), cut:

- (2) 61" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 61" x 82" back.

### Block Assembly

**Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.**

1. Sew (1) 2" x 41  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 22  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 41  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A panel. Sew (1) 2  $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 25  $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A panel. **Trim the block to measure 23  $\frac{1}{8}$ " x 44  $\frac{1}{2}$ " to make the Center Block (Fig. 1).**

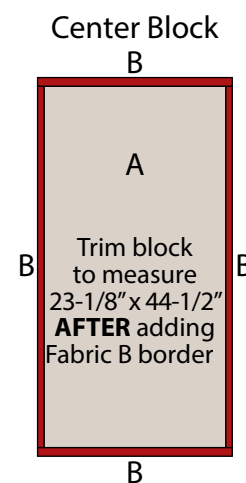

2. Sew (1)  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF Fabric G strip, (1)  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF Fabric H strip, (1)  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF Fabric I strip and (1)  $1\frac{1}{8}$ " x WOF Fabric C strip together lengthwise and in that order from left to right to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Strip Set 1.

3. Cut the Strip Set 1's into (16) 3" Unit 1 squares (Fig. 3).

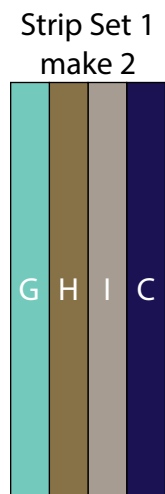

4. Place (1)  $1\frac{3}{4}$ " Fabric D square on the bottom right corner of (1) Unit 1 square, right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew across the diagonal of the smaller square from the upper right corner to the lower left corner (Fig. 4). Flip open the triangle formed and press. Trim away the excess fabric from behind the triangle  $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from the sewn seam to make (1) Unit 2 square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (16) Unit 2 squares total.

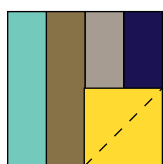

5. Sew (4) Unit 2 squares together into a 2 x 2 matrix, paying attention to the orientation of the blocks, to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block One squares total.

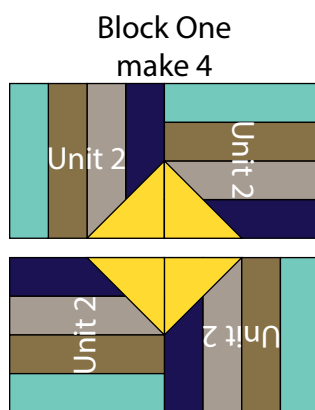

6. Sew together (8)  $1$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric D strips and (8)  $1$ " x  $3\frac{1}{4}$ " Fabric C strips end to end and alternating them to make (1) Side Border (Fig. 7). Repeat to make a second Side Border.

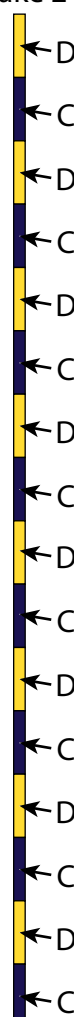

7. Sew together (5)  $1$ " x  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric C strips and (4)  $1$ " x  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric D strips end to end and alternating them to make the Top Border (Fig. 8).

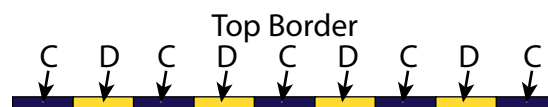

8. Sew together (5)  $1$ " x  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric D strips and (4)  $1$ " x  $3\frac{1}{8}$ " Fabric C strips end to end and alternating them to make the Bottom Border (Fig. 9).

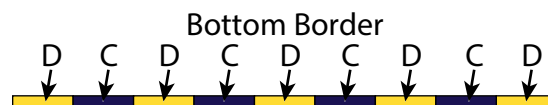

### Quilt Top Assembly Version #1

*(Follow the Version 1 Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

9. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 3" x 45 ½" Fabric F strip to the right side of (1) 3" x 45 ½" Fabric E strip lengthwise. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 3" x 24 ½" Fabric F strip to the top of (1) 3" x 24 ½" Fabric E strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Layer and quilt as desired.

13. Sew the (5) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

14. Bind as desired.

### Quilt Top Assembly Version #2

*(Follow the Version 2 Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

9. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

10. Sew (1) 3" x 45 ½" Fabric F strip to the right side of (1) 3" x 45 ½" Fabric E strip lengthwise. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew (1) newly sewn strip to each side of the Center Block.

11. Sew (1) 3" x 24 ½" Fabric F strip to the top of (1) 3" x 24 ½" Fabric E strip lengthwise. Sew (1) Block One square to each end of the newly sewn strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

12. Center (1) 10" x 78" Fabric J strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a ¼" from the top edge of the block and stop a ¼" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.

13. Repeat Step 12 to sew (1) 10" x 57" Fabric J strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start ¼" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 10).

14. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 10), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a ¼" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

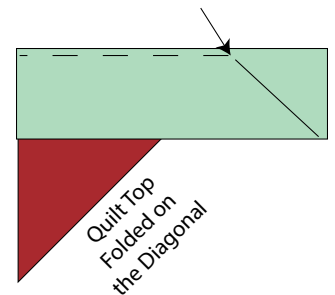

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

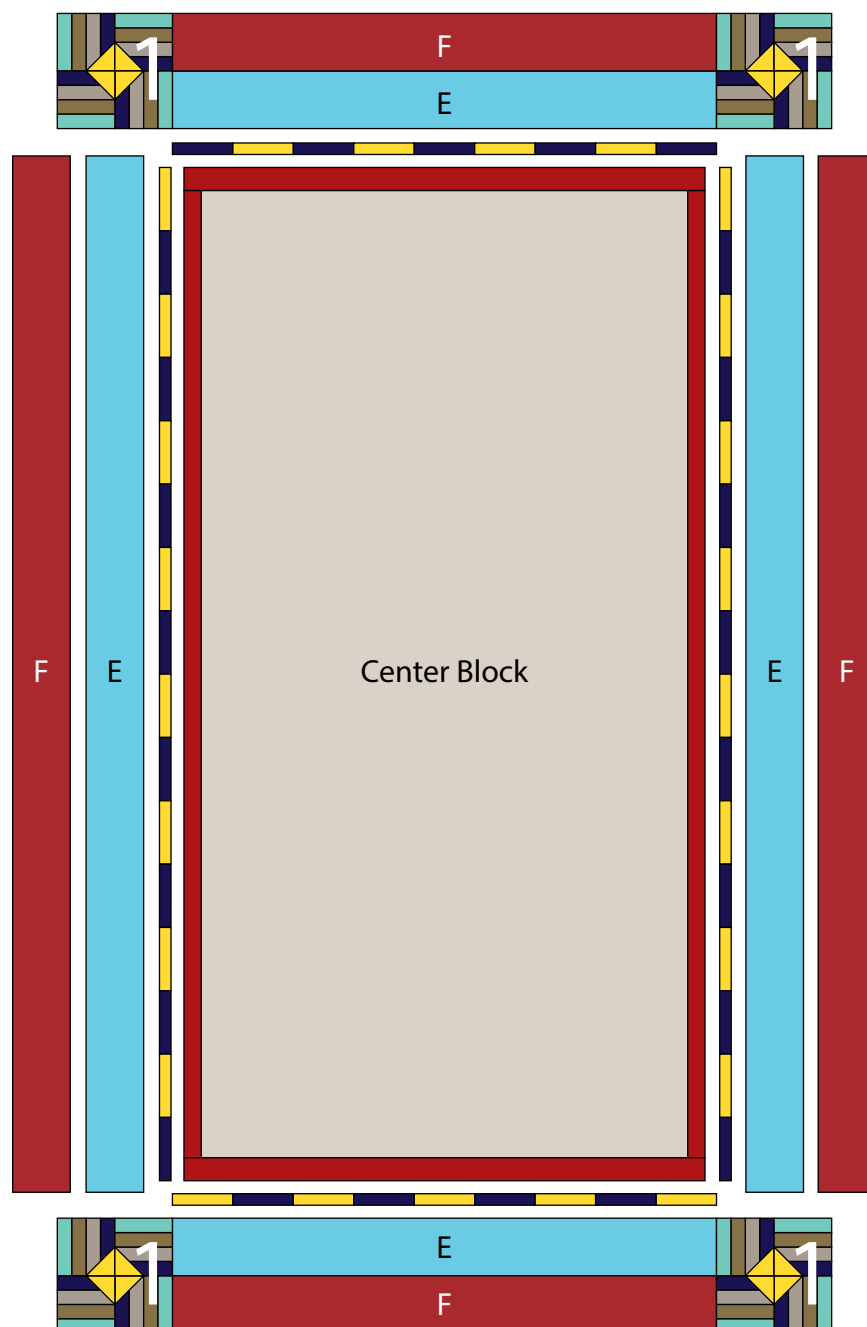
16. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric C strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.

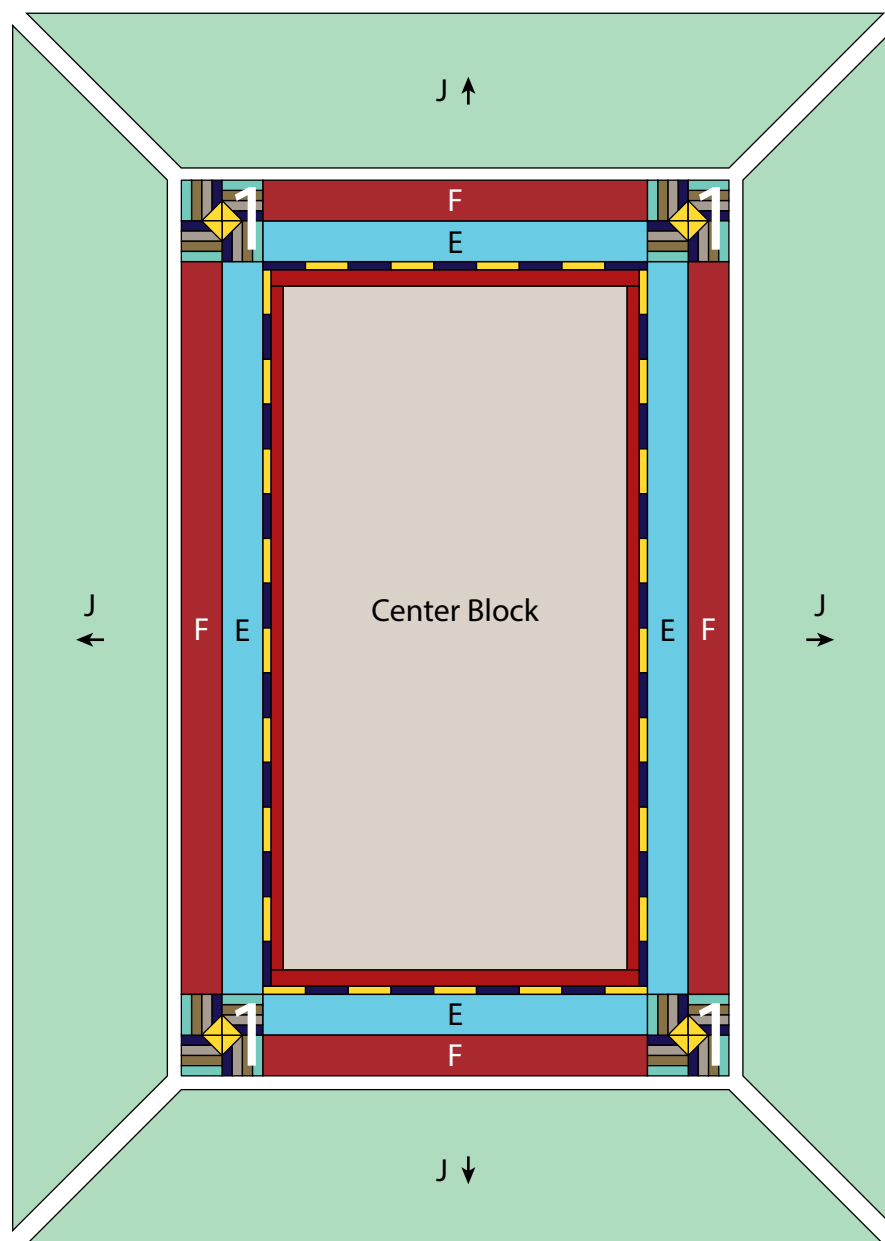
Version #1 Quilt Layout
