$\frac{3}{8}$ yard (0.35 m)	Tossed Elephants - Yellow (E)	876-49

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 6 9.5 Inch Blocks - Turquoise (A):

- Fussy cut (6) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares, each centered on a block.

From the Folio Basics - Yellow (B), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Koalas on Trees - Light Blue (C), cut:

- (1) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Lions - Light Blue (D), cut:

- (1) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Elephants - Yellow (E), cut:

- (1) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (2) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Folio Basics - Orange (F), cut:

- (3) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Animal Scenic - Green (G), cut:

- (1) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (8) 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 4" strips.
- (2) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (9) 4" x 5 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Dots - Red (H), cut:

- (1) 4" x WOF strip. Sub-cut (6) 4" squares.
- (4) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 63" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Modern Melody Basics - Pigment White (I), cut:

- (4) 4" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (34) 4" squares.
- (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 59" strips.
- (3) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 47 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Tossed Tigers - Turquoise (J), cut:

- (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 66" strips.
- (3) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 50 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Balloons - White (K), cut:

- (1) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

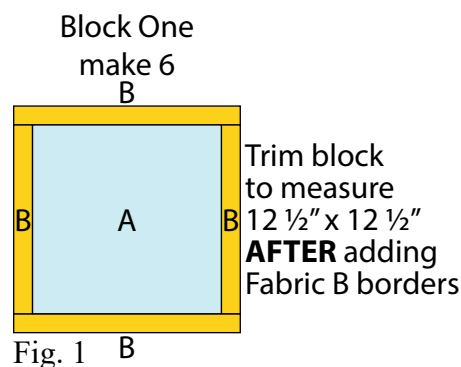
From the Tossed Lions - Light Blue (Backing), cut:

- (2) 86" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 70" x 86" back.

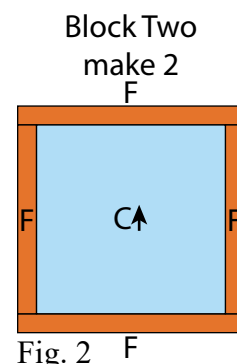
Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2" x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric A square. Sew (1) 2" x 13 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A square to make (1) Block One square (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".** Repeat to make (6) Block One squares total.



- Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 10 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make (1) 12 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block Two square (Fig. 2). Repeat to make a second Block Two square.



3. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" Fabric D square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric D square to make (1) 12 ½" Block Three square (Fig. 3). Repeat to make a second Block Three square.

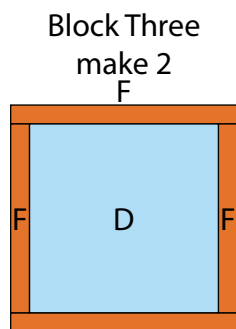

4. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 10 ½" Fabric F strip to each side of (1) 10 ½" Fabric E square. Sew (1) 1 ½" x 12 ½" Fabric F strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric E square to make (1) 12 ½" Block Four square (Fig. 4). Repeat to make a second Block Four square.

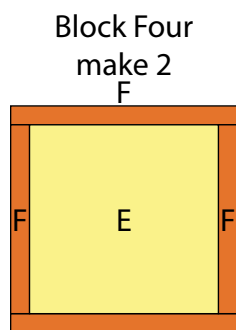

5. Sew (1) 4" Fabric I square to the top and to the bottom of (1) 5 ½" x 4 Fabric G strip to make (1) Block Five strip. Repeat to make (8) Block Five strips total.

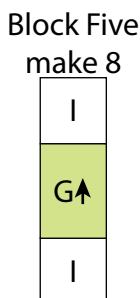

6. Sew (1) 4" Fabric I square to each end of (1) 4" x 5 ½" Fabric G strip to make (1) Block Six strip (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (9) Block Six strips total.

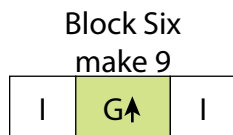

7. Sew together (1) Block One square, (1) Block Five strip, (1) Block Two square, (1) Block Five strip and (1) Block One square, in that order from left to right, to make Row One (Fig. 7).

8. Repeat Step 7 and refer to Figure 7 for component identification, placement and orientation to make Row Three, Row Five and Row Seven.

9. Sew together (3) Block Six strips and (2) 4" Fabric H squares, end to end and alternating them from left to right, to make Row Two (Fig. 7). Repeat to make Row Four and Row Six.

10. Sew together the (7) Rows from Steps 7-9, lengthwise and in numerical order from top to bottom, to make the 43 ½" x 59" Center Block.

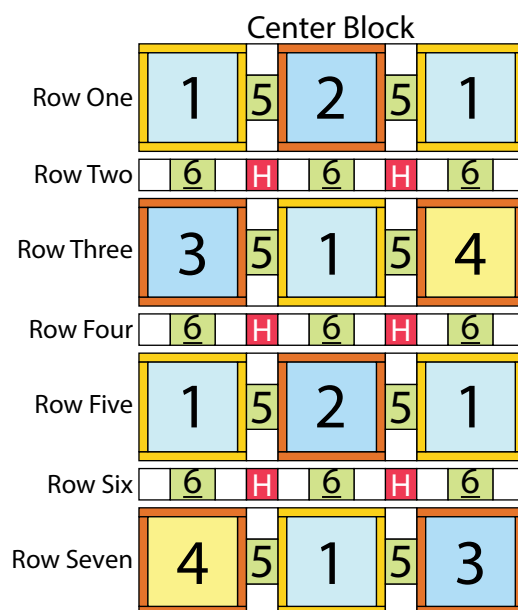

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Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

11. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 59" Fabric I strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2 ½" x 47 ½" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

12. Sew 2" x 63" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 50 ½" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

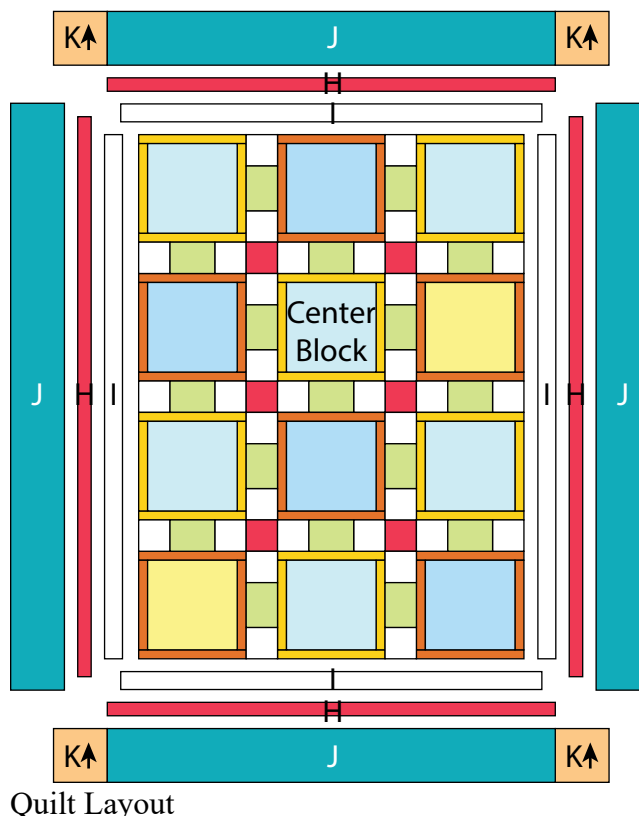
13. Sew (1) 6 ½" x 66" Fabric J strip to each side of the Center Block.

14. Sew (1) 6 ½" Fabric K square to each end of (1) 6 ½" x 50 ½" Fabric J strip. Repeat to make a second strip. Sew the strips to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

15. Layer and quilt as desired.

16. Sew the (7) 2 ½" x WOF Fabric H strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

17. Bind as desired.



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
