



### Materials

1 ¾ yards	Abstract Texture with Ants - Red (A)	9510-88
1 ¾ yards	Tossed Food Motifs - Multi (B)	9506-8
½ yard	Monotone BBQ Motifs - Gold (C)	9512-44
1 ¼ yards	Word/BBQ Motifs Print - Gray (D)	9511-90
⅝ yard	Modern Melody Basics - Black (E)	1063-99*
4 ⅛ yards	Words and Arrows - Black/Red (Backing)	9507-98

\*Includes binding

### Cutting Instructions

*Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage unless otherwise noted.*

#### From the Abstract Texture with Ants - Red (A), cut:

- (13) 4 ½" x WOF strips.

#### From the Tossed Food Motifs - Multi (B), cut:

- (13) 4 ½" x WOF strips.

#### From the Monotone BBQ Motifs - Gold (C), cut:

- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 52 ½" strips.
- (3) 2" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 2" x 55 ½" strips.

#### From the Word/BBQ Motifs Print - Gray (D), cut:

- (3) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 55 ½" strips.
- (4) 5 ½" x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 5 ½" x 65 ½" strips.

#### From the Modern Melody Basics - Black (E), cut:

- (7) 2 ½" x WOF strips for the binding.

#### From the Words and Arrows - Black/Red (Backing), cut:

- (2) 73" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 73" x 73" back.

### Block Assembly

*Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components.*

- Sew (7) 4 ½" x WOF Fabric A strips and (6) 4 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips together lengthwise and alternating them from left to right to make (1) Strip Set 1 (Fig. 1).



- Cut the Strip Set 1 into (7) 4 ½" x 52 ½" Unit 1 strips (Fig. 2).



- Sew (7) 4 ½" x WOF Fabric B strips and (6) 4 ½" x WOF Fabric A strips together lengthwise and alternating them from left to right to make (1) Strip Set 2 (Fig. 3).



- Cut the Strip Set 2 into (6) 4 ½" x 52 ½" Unit 2 strips (Fig. 4).



5. Sew together the (7) Unit 1 strips and (6) Unit 2 strips, lengthwise and alternating them from top to bottom, to make the Center Block (Fig. 5).

### Quilt Top Assembly

*(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)*

6. Sew (1) 2" x 52 1/2" Fabric C strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 2" x 55 1/2" Fabric C strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.

7. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 55 1/2" Fabric D strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 5 1/2" x 65 1/2" Fabric D strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block to make the quilt top.

8. Layer and quilt as desired.

9. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric E strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.

10. Bind as desired.



