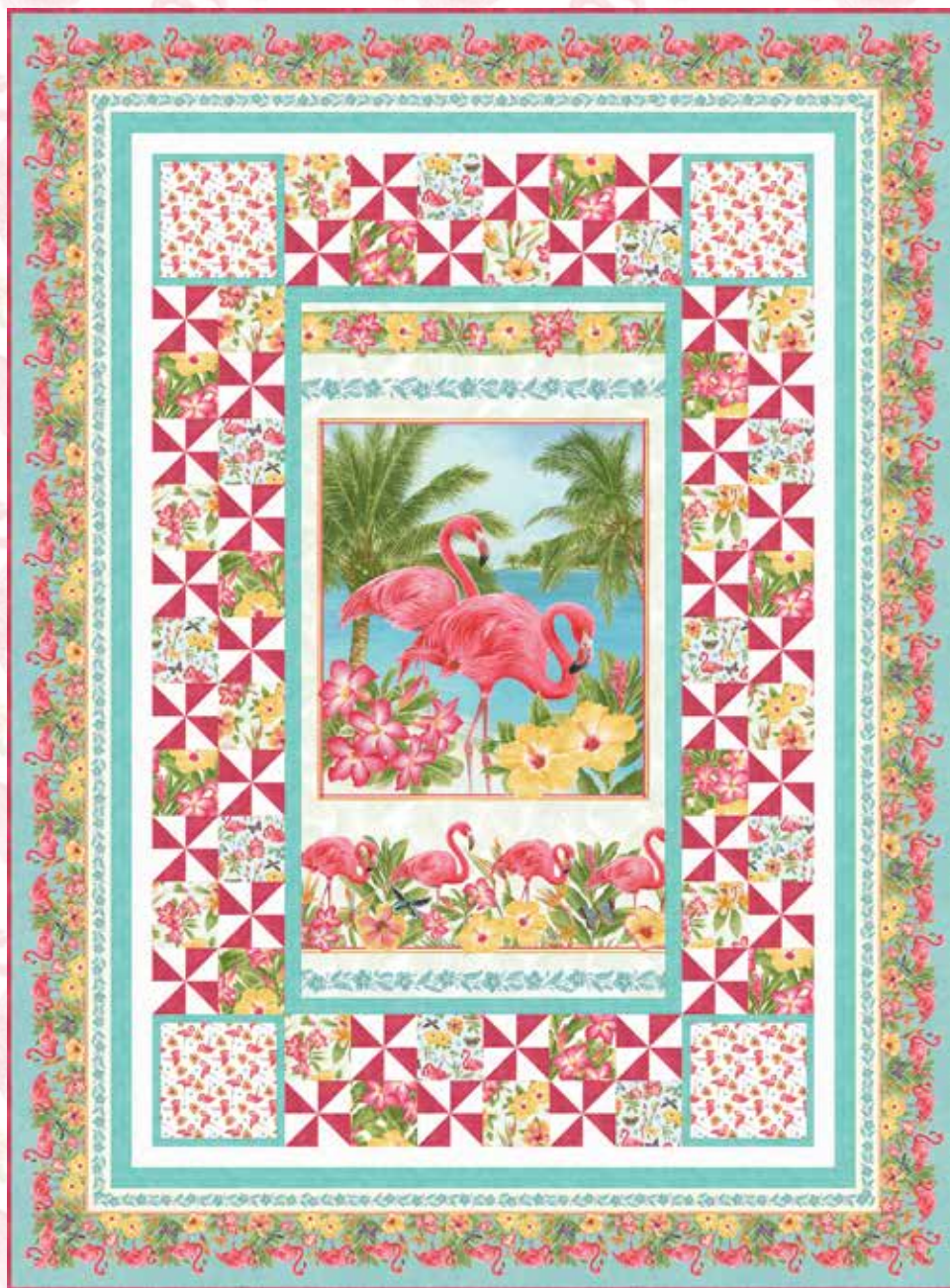

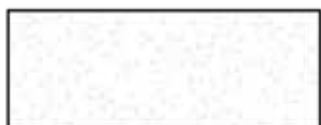

$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Tossed Tropical Flowers - Multi (D)	9863-84
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Tropical Flowers - Multi (E)	9861-84
$\frac{3}{8}$ yard	Tossed Flamingos and Flowers - Multi (F)	9864-78
1 yard	Folio Basic - Rose (G)	7755-23*
$\frac{7}{8}$ yard	Folio Basic - White on White (H)	7755-01
2 $\frac{1}{3}$ yards	Border Stripe - Multi (I)	9868-78
4 $\frac{3}{4}$ yards	Large Leaves - Green (Backing)	9862-67

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the Panel 24in x 44in - Multi (A):

- Fussy cut (1) 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle, centered on the panel.

From the Calligraphy - Blue (B), cut:

- (2) 2" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips, piece as needed.
- (2) 2" x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " WOF strips.
- (4) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 63" strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 45 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (2) 1" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 1" x 8 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.

From the Small Tossed Flamingos - Pink (C), cut:

- (1) 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strip. Sub-cut (4) 7 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Tropical Flowers - Multi (D), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Tropical Flowers - Multi (E), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (12) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Tossed Flamingos and Flowers - Multi (F), cut:

- (2) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (10) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " squares.

From the Folio Basic - Rose (G), cut:

- (5) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (68) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- (7) 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x WOF strips for the binding.

From the Folio Basic - White on White (H), cut:

- (5) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " x WOF strips. Sub-cut (68) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " squares.
- (3) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 60 $\frac{1}{2}$ " strips.
- (3) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x WOF strips. Sew the strips together end to end with diagonal seams and cut (2) 1 $\frac{3}{4}$ " x 43" strips.

From the Border Stripe - Multi (I), cut:

- (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 81" Length of Fabric (LOF) strips.
- (2) 6 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 61" LOF strips.

From the Large Leaves - Green (Backing), cut:

- (2) 85" x WOF strips for the backing. Sew the strips together and trim to make the 65" x 85" back.

Block Assembly

Note: The arrows in figures represent the fabric print direction. Pay attention to the fabric and unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a $\frac{1}{4}$ " seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

- Sew (1) 2" x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to each side of the 22 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 42 $\frac{1}{2}$ " rectangle. Sew (1) 2" x 25 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric A rectangle to make the Center Block (Fig. 1). **Trim the block to measure 24 $\frac{1}{2}$ " x 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ ".**

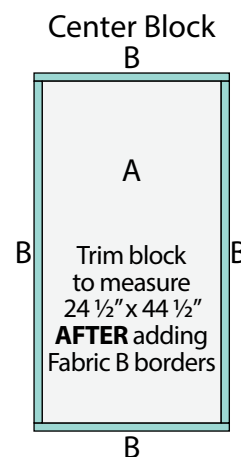

- Place (1) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric H square on top of (1) 2 $\frac{7}{8}$ " Fabric G square, right sides together. Draw a line across the diagonal of the top square (Fig. 2). Sew $\frac{1}{4}$ " away from each side of the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 2). Cut the (2) squares apart on the drawn diagonal line (Fig. 3) to make (2) half-square triangles. Trim the half-square triangles to measure 2 $\frac{1}{2}$ " square to make (2) Unit 1 squares (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (136) Unit 1 squares total.

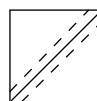

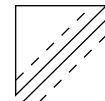

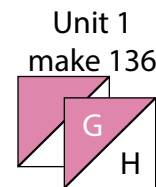

- Sew together (4) Unit 1 squares into a 2 x 2 matrix to make (1) 4 $\frac{1}{2}$ " Block One square (Fig. 5). Repeat to make (34) Block One squares total.

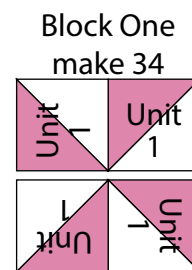

4. Sew (1) 1" x 7 1/2" Fabric B strip to each side of (1) 7 1/2" Fabric C square. Sew (1) 1" x 8 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Fabric C square to make 8 1/2" (1) Block Two square (Fig. 6). Repeat to make (4) Block Two squares total.

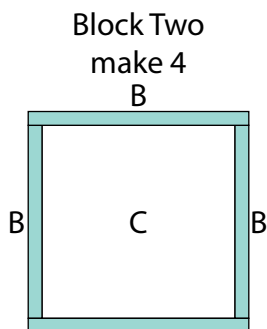

5. Follow Figure 7 and sew together (11) Block One squares, (4) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares, (4) 4 1/2" Fabric E squares and (3) 4 1/2" Fabric F squares into a 2 x 11 matrix to make (1) Side Border. Repeat to make a second Side Border.

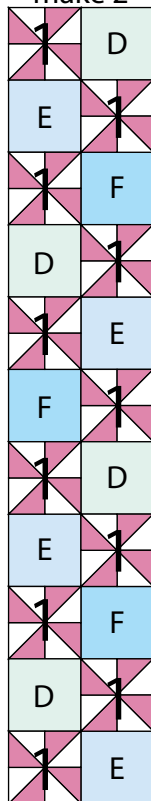

6. Follow Figure 8 and sew together (2) Block Two squares, (6) Block One squares, (2) 4 1/2" Fabric D squares, (2) 4 1/2" Fabric E squares and (2) 4 1/2" Fabric F squares to make the Top Border. Repeat to make the Bottom Border.

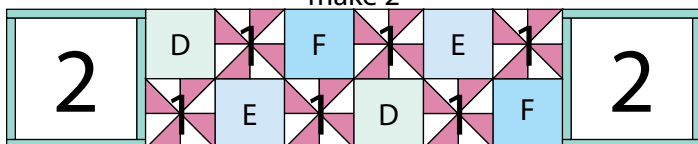

Quilt Top Assembly

(Follow the Quilt Layout while assembling the quilt top.)

7. Sew (1) Side Border to each side of the Center Block.
8. Sew the Top Border and Bottom Border to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
9. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 60 1/2" Fabric H strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 43" Fabric H strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
10. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 63" Fabric B strip to each side of the Center Block. Sew (1) 1 3/4" x 45 1/2" Fabric B strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block.
11. Center (1) 6 1/2" x 81" Fabric I strip on (1) side of the Center Block and pin in place. Start sewing the strip a 1/4" from the top edge of the block and stop a 1/4" from the bottom edge. **DO NOT TRIM THE EXCESS.** Repeat with the opposite side.
12. Repeat Step 11 to sew (1) 6 1/2" x 61" Fabric I strip to the top and to the bottom of the Center Block, making sure to stop and start 1/4" away from each end of the block. To miter each corner, fold the Center Block on a diagonal, wrong side together. This should line up the strips from adjacent sides (Fig. 9).
13. Starting at the sewn seam (represented by the arrow in Figure 9), draw a 45-degree line to the edge of the fabric. Sew on the drawn line. Trim the excess fabric leaving a 1/4" seam. Repeat this step with the remaining corners to make the quilt top.

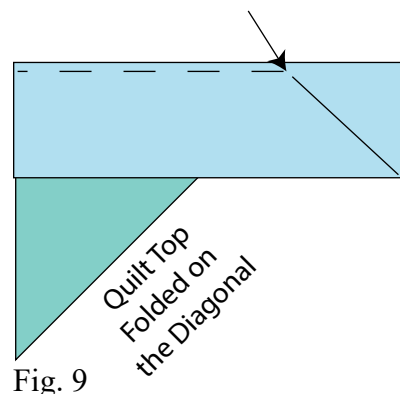
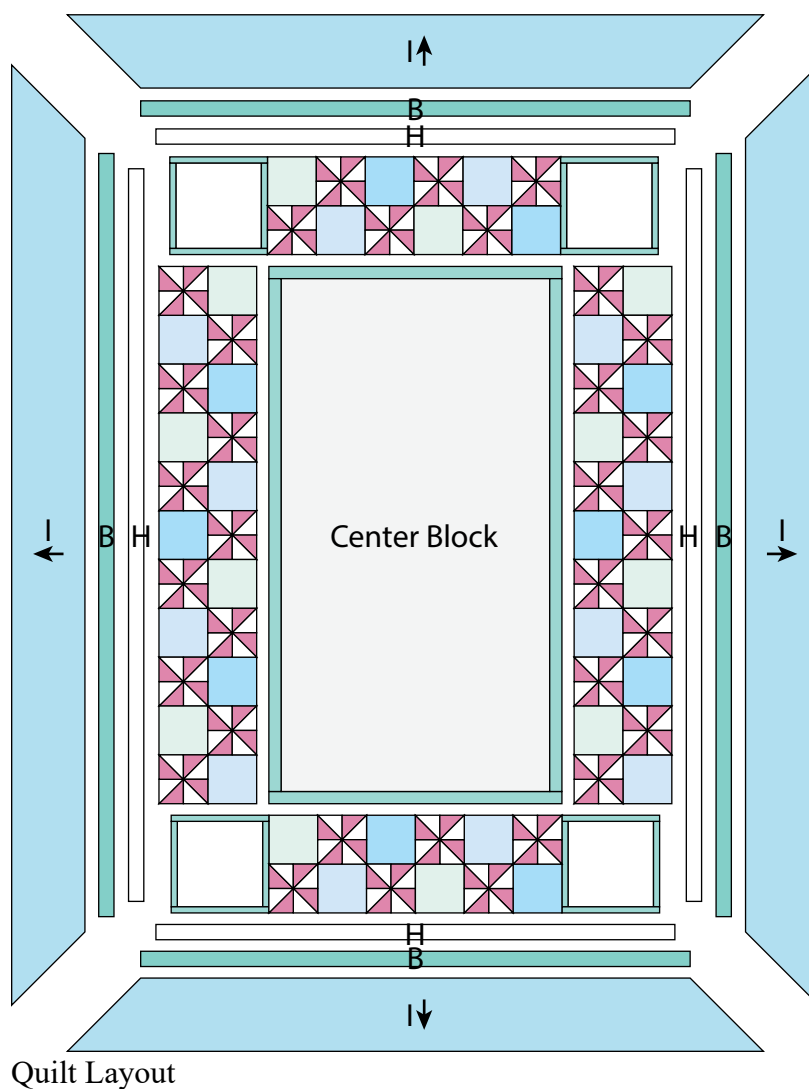

14. Layer and quilt as desired.
15. Sew the (7) 2 1/2" x WOF Fabric G strips together, end to end with 45-degree seams, to make the binding. Fold this long strip in half lengthwise with wrong sides together and press.
16. Bind as desired.



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
