



Materials

1 panel24 inch Bunting Panel - Cream (A)846P-083/8 yardStars - Cream (B)838-081/4 yardRedwork Motifs in Circles - Cream (C)837-08

You will also need:

- 2 yards of braided cord
- (8) 1 ¹/₂" buttons
- Size 5 Red Pearl Cotton thread
- Tapestry Needle
- Wonder Clips

Cutting Instructions

Please note: All strips are cut across the width of fabric (WOF) from selvage to selvage edge unless otherwise noted.

From the 24 Inch Bunting Panel - Cream (A):
Fussy cut (8) Stocking Fronts ¹/₄" outside the drawn lines.

From the Stars - Cream (B), cut: • (3) 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (16) 5" x 7" strips.


From the Redwork Motifs in Circles - Cream (C), cut:

• (2) 5" x WOF strips. Sub-cut (8) 5" x 7" strips.

Garland Assembly


Note: Pay attention to the unit orientations when assembling the various components. Use a ¼" seam allowance with right sides together (RST) unless otherwise noted.

1. Place (1) Fabric A Stocking Front onto (1) 5" x 7" Fabric C strip wrong sides together. Trace the stocking shape onto the Fabric C strip and cut on out the drawn lines to make (1) Outer Stocking Back piece (Fig. 1). Repeat to cut (8) Outer Stocking Back pieces total.




2. Repeat Step 1 with (8) 5" x 7" Fabric B strips to make(8) Lining Back pieces (Fig. 2).



3. Place (1) Fabric C Stocking Back onto (1) 5" x 7" Fabric B strip wrong sides together. Trace the stocking shape onto the Fabric B strip and cut out on the drawn lines to make (1) Lining Front piece (Fig. 3). Repeat to cut (8) Lining Front pieces total.




4. Place (1) Fabric C Outer Stocking Back piece and (1) Fabric A Outer Stocking Front piece right sides together (Fig. 4). Sew together the (2) pieces leaving the top edge open for turning. Turn the piece right sides out to make (1) Outer Stocking (Fig. 4). Repeat to make (8) Outer Stockings total.

5. Place (1) Fabric B Lining Back piece and (1) Fabric B Lining Front piece right sides together. Sew together the (2) pieces leaving a 2"-3" opening in the side seam for turning and leave the top edge open to make (1) Lining (Fig. 5). **Do not turn right side out.** Repeat to make (8) Linings total.



6. Slide (1) Lining piece over (1) Stocking, right sides together and align the top edges. Pin the (2) pieces together and sew them together around the top edge.

7. Turn the Stocking right side out through the opening in the lining. Top stitch the side opening in the Lining closed.

8. Push the Lining into the Stocking and press to make (1) Stocking.

9. Repeat Steps 6-8 to make (8) Stockings total.

10. Measure and mark the center of the Braided Cord.Position (4) Stockings left of the center point on the cord as desired and clip in place. Position and clip the remaining (4) stockings right of the center point on the cord as desired.

11. Place (1) 1 ¹/₂" Button on the top left corner of the first Stocking. Use the pearl cotton and tapestry needle to attach the Stocking to the braided cord through the button. Repeat with the remaining Stockings and Buttons to complete the Garland.
